Funding for Project

Traditional Fed. Local Program:

80% Federal and 20% Town for Design, ROW, and CN

DMS:


- Design, ROW, and CN Phases are funded with 80% Federal and 20% State Funds
- Design is at <u>zero</u> cost to the Towns
- Design is "Full Partnership" and Coordination with the Town

Goals of DMS

- Provide a "Streamlined approach to Design" using full DOT resources
- Aid the Towns to Keep their bridges in "State of Good Repair" by effective use of funds
- Decrease typical design time
- Utilize Accelerated Bridge Construction (ABC) techniques to shorten construction duration
- Increase the number of municipal projects delivered to construction each year




Aerial Map


- Light to Heavy Laminar Rust with Pitting and Thinning
- Scattered Perforations
- Bottom Plates Exhibit Significant Distortion
- Round Steel Pipe Exhibits Inward Dents
- Perched Outlet; Flow Observed Beneath 30" Steel Round Pipe








Proposed Bridge Replacement | Plan View






Proposed Bridge Replacement | Section View






Proposed Bridge Replacement | Elevation View



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
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
