The purpose of this project is to successfully rehabilitate the bridge by replacing aging infrastructure with new components that will ensure longevity and safety for all roadway users.

Right-of-way impacts are not anticipated.

Construction is anticipated to begin in 2028 based on the availability of funding and approval of permits. The estimated construction cost for this project is \$2 million. This project is anticipated to be undertaken with 80% federal funds and 20% state funds.
