


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Intersection 050-216: US Route 1 SB at Meadowbrook Rd



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
Intersection 050-233: US Route 1 NB at Meadowbrook Rd



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


Intersection 050-217: US Route 1 at Grasmere Ave



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
Intersection 050-260: US Route 1 at New England Ave



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

Intersection 050-257: US Route 1 at I-95 NB Off-Ramp



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








Division of Rights of Way

- Function
 - Acquire all property/property rights necessary for the project.
- Statutory References
 - State of Connecticut: C.G.S. Section 13a-73 & 13a-98e
 - Federal: Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970, as Amended.



Division of Rights of Way

- ROW Process
 - Letter of Intent to Acquire
 - Valuation
 - Offer of Compensation
 - Negotiation
 - Acquisition
 - Agreement
 - Condemnation

Project Cost & Design Schedule

Project Cost

- Federal (80%) / State (20%) Funding
- Project Budget - \$11.8 Million

Design Schedule

- Preliminary Engineering → Completed
- Preliminary Design → Completed
- Semi-Final Design (SFD) → 10/30/2024
- Final Design Plans (FDP) → 5/21/2025
- Advertising Date → 7/30/2025
- Construction Start Date → Fall 2025

 - Incorporate Public Feedback
 - Coordination with Town Officials
 - Continue Traffic Signal Design
 - Finalize ROW Needs
 - Utility Company Coordination
 - Identify Potential Conflicts
 - Meet with Utility Companies
