The purpose of the project is to address the bridge's deficiencies and low structure rating by replacing the bridge with one that meets current design standards. The new structure will better align with the roadway and accommodate the speed limit.

Right-of-way impacts are anticipated with the proposed improvements, these impacts are on private property adjacent to the bridge, classified as commercial residential and farm properties.

Construction is expected to start spring 2028, depending on funding, right-of-way acquisition, and permits. The estimated cost is \$27.5 million, with 80% federal funds and 20% state funds.
