in Granby**

The purpose of this meeting is to provide the community with an opportunity to learn about the proposed project and allow an open discussion of any views and comments concerning the proposed improvements. A Q&A session will immediately follow the presentation.

The project upgrades the bridge with a new box culvert, headwalls, and wingwalls—improving fish passage and better controlling water flow.

Right-of-way impacts associated with the proposed project include temporary construction easements on the properties to the north and south of the bridge. A drainage right of way is anticipated on the south abutting property. Both properties are owned by the State of Connecticut.

Construction is expected to start in spring 2027. The estimated cost is \$2.1 million, with 80% Federal funds and 20% percent State funds.
