The purpose of this meeting is to provide the community with an opportunity to learn about the proposed project and allow an open discussion of any views and comments concerning the proposed improvements. A Q&A session will immediately follow the presentation.

The purpose of this project is to calm vehicle traffic while improving bike and pedestrian facilities by converting the dual travel lanes to single lanes and inserting a central turn and bike lanes. This will enhance safety and access for all road users by reducing crashes and mitigating conflicts associated with left-turning vehicles.

Right-of-way impacts are not anticipated.

Construction is expected to start in spring 2027, depending on funding, right-of-way acquisition, and permits. The estimated cost is \$3 million, with 90% federal funds and 10% state funds.
