The purpose of this meeting is to provide the community with an opportunity to learn about the proposed project and allow an open discussion of any views and comments concerning the proposed improvements. A Q&A session will immediately follow the presentation.

The purpose of the project is to improve safety and reduce congestion on the I-95 southbound Exit 38 off-ramp leading to the Milford Parkway. The existing off-ramp has a deficient deceleration length, which directly contributes to congestion and crash rates higher than adjacent sections of freeway.

Right-of-way impacts are not associated with the proposed project.

Construction is anticipated to begin fall 2027, based on the availability of funding and approval of permits. The estimated construction cost is approximately \$7.2 million, using 90% federal funds and 10% state funds.
