The purpose of this meeting is to provide the community with an opportunity to learn about the proposed project and allow an open discussion of any views and comments concerning the proposed improvements. A Q&A session will immediately follow the presentation.

The purpose of this project is to address the structural condition of the existing bridge and replace it with a new two-span continuous steel multi-girder bridge.

Right-of-way impacts will be determined following further evaluation and coordination.

Construction is anticipated to begin spring 2029. The estimated construction cost for this project is approximately \$14.2 million. This project is anticipated to be undertaken with 80% federal funds and 20% state funds.
