

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

State Project No. 093-251 Route 175 Sidewalk Town of Newington

Location: This project is located on Route 175 (East Street/Cedar Street) and Route 505 (Fenn Road) in the Town of Newington. The project area is approximately 3,500 feet long and extends east from the Route 175 intersection with Route 505 to where Route 175 intersects Maple Hill Avenue.

Description: The project includes the construction of sidewalk along north side of Route 175 to improve pedestrian accommodations and provide a continuous sidewalk network between pedestrian traffic generators and various transit, retail, and education facilities within and nearby the project area. The project also includes, illumination, bus stop amenities, crosswalks, pedestrian traffic signal equipment and pavement markings.

Rights of Way: Permanent easements for the construction of the sidewalk are anticipated to be required.

Environmental Impact: The project is not in an area of NDDDB concern, The project crosses over the floodway associated with Piper Brook, there are no locations listed on the historic register within the project limits.

Utilities: Utility poles may require relocation depending on more detailed field survey and design of the proposed improvements.
