The purpose of this meeting is to provide the community with an opportunity to learn about the proposed project and allow an open discussion of any views and comments concerning the proposed improvements.

The purpose of this project is to reduce peak hour congestion and improve safety at the intersections of Route 175 and Route 9 On/Off Ramps (Exit 38). Additional sidewalks are included in the planned work.

Right-of-way impacts are anticipated with the proposed improvements.

Construction is expected to start winter 2029, depending on funding, right(s)-of-way acquisition, and permits. The estimated cost is \$9.5 million, with 80% federal funds and 20% state funds.
