The purpose of this meeting is to provide the community with an opportunity to learn about the proposed project and allow an open discussion of any views and comments concerning the proposed improvements.

A Q&A session will immediately follow the presentation.

The purpose of this project is to replace an existing deteriorated twin corrugated metal pipe culvert that conveys Ashwillet Brook under Route 201. The culvert has experienced section loss, joint separation, associated washouts, and void formation. The project also includes improvements to roadway drainage structures.

Right-of-way impacts associated with the proposed improvements include partial acquisitions, slope easements, and rights.

Construction is anticipated to begin spring 2029 based on the availability of funding, acquisition of rights of way, and approval of permit(s). The estimated construction cost for this project is approximately \$5 million. This project is anticipated to be undertaken with 80% federal funds and 20% state funds.
