**Rehabilitation of Bridge No. 07102 carrying Route 216 over unnamed brook
in North Stonington**

The purpose of this meeting is to provide the community with an opportunity to learn about the proposed project and allow an open discussion of any views and comments concerning the proposed improvements. A Q&A session will immediately follow the presentation.

This project is to address the existing bridge's structural deficiencies by installing a box concrete culvert that will meet CTDOT and Federal Highway Administration design and safety standards. Construction will also include a wrong way detection system installed at the I-95 southbound Exit 93 off-ramp.

Right-of-way impacts are not anticipated.

Construction is expected to start in summer 2029, depending on funding, right-of-way acquisition, and permits. The estimated cost is \$2 million, with 80% federal funds and 20% state funds.
