The purpose of this meeting is to provide the community with an opportunity to learn about the proposed project and allow an open discussion of any views and comments concerning the proposed improvements. A Q&A session will immediately follow the presentation.

The purpose of this project is to replace the temporary structure that was built after the August 2024 flooding event with a new bridge that will ease traffic impacts and improve safety for all roadway users.

Temporary right-of-way acquisitions will include easements to accommodate temporary construction activities.

Construction is expected to start spring 2027 depending on funding, right-of-way acquisition, and permits. The estimated cost is \$8 million, with 80% federal funds and 20% state funds.
