The purpose of this meeting is to provide the community with an opportunity to learn about the proposed project and allow an open discussion of any views and comments concerning the proposed improvements. A Q&A session will immediately follow the presentation.

This replacement will improve safety for drivers by installing a new structure that meets current design standards and removes load restrictions. The improvement may also accommodate potential future roadway adjustments for increased mobility.

Right-of-way impacts are anticipated to be minimal.

Construction is expected to start spring 2028, depending on funding, right-of-way acquisition, and permits. The estimated cost is \$5 million, with 80% federal funds and 20% state funds.
