The purpose of this meeting is to provide the community with an opportunity to learn about the proposed project and allow an open discussion of any views and comments concerning the proposed improvements. A Q&A session will immediately follow the presentation.

The purpose of this project is to complete a multi-use trail segment that will improve recreational opportunities and enhance non-motorized mobility for both local and regional residents.

Right-of-way impacts associated with the proposed improvements are not expected to impact private property.

Construction is anticipated to begin in 2027 based on the availability of funding, acquisition of rights of way, and approval of permit(s). The estimated construction cost for this project is approximately \$1-\$2 million. This project is anticipated to be undertaken with 80% federal funds and 20% state funds.
