The purpose of this meeting is to provide the community with an opportunity to learn about the proposed project and allow an open discussion of any views and comments concerning the proposed improvements. This meeting will begin as an open house at 5:00 p.m. where individuals can view project related renderings and discuss any questions for the CT DOT project staff. A formal design presentation will begin at 7:00 p.m.

The purpose of this project is to close the remaining gap in the Connecticut section of the Farmington Canal Heritage Trail by constructing a multi-use trail through Plainville that will provide users a continuous and safe transportation network through Connecticut.

Right-of-way impacts will affect Norton Park for the construction of the Farmington Canal Heritage Trail.

Construction is anticipated to begin spring 2028 based on the availability of funding, acquisition of rights of way, and approval of permit(s). The estimated construction cost for this project is approximately \$28 million. This project is anticipated to be undertaken with 80% federal funds and 20% state funds.
