The purpose of this meeting is to provide the community with an opportunity to learn about the proposed project and allow an open discussion of any views and comments concerning the proposed improvements. A Q&A session will immediately follow the presentation.

The purpose of the project is to address the bridge's deficiencies by replacing the structure with an upgraded design that will improve driver safety.

Right-of-way impacts include slope easements, right to grade, guiderail easements, right to construct driveway, and temporary construction easements.

Construction is expected to start summer 2028, depending on funding, right-of-way acquisition, and permits. The estimated cost is \$19 million, with 80% federal funds and 20% state funds.
