The purpose of this meeting is to provide the community with an opportunity to learn about the proposed project and allow an open discussion of any views and comments concerning the proposed improvements. A Q&A session will immediately follow the presentation.

The purpose of this project is to construct a segment of a road-separated multi-use trail, along with streetscape and complete street improvements along East Main Street, Pine Street, and Woodford/White Oak Avenue. This will provide a connection between the future Phase 3 of the Beeline Trail and downtown Plainville.

Right-of-way impacts anticipated include partial acquisitions and easements to accommodate the proposed trail.

Construction is expected to start spring 2027, depending on funding, right-of-way acquisition, and permits. The estimated cost is \$9 million, with 100% state funds.
