This will provide a connection between the future Phase 3 of the Beeline Trail and downtown Plainville.

Right-of-way impacts anticipated include partial acquisitions and easements to accommodate the proposed trail.

Construction is expected to start spring 2027, depending on funding, right-of-way acquisition, and permits. The estimated cost is \$9 million, with 100% state funds.
