The purpose of this meeting is to provide the community with an opportunity to learn about the proposed project and allow an open discussion of any views and comments concerning the proposed improvements. A Q&A session will immediately follow the presentation.

The purpose of this replacement is to remove the current weight restriction and scour that has occurred over time, offering users a safer passage across the brook.

Right-of-way impacts are anticipated to include partial takes, slope easements, temporary construction easements, guiderail end anchorage easements, and a drainage right-of-way easement.

Construction is expected to start spring 2029 based on the availability of funding, right-of-way acquisitions, and permit acquisitions. The estimated construction cost is \$3 million, with 80% federal funds and 20% state funds.
