The purpose of this meeting is to provide the community with an opportunity to learn about the proposed project and allow an open discussion of any views and comments concerning the proposed improvements. A Q&A session will immediately follow the presentation.

Originally constructed in 1971, the bridges have exceeded their original design lifespan and will undergo superstructure replacements to extend their service life and improve safety for all roadway users.

Right-of-way impacts are not anticipated.

Construction is expected to start spring 2029, depending on funding, right-of-way acquisition, and permits. The estimated cost is \$16 million, with 80% federal funds and 20% state funds.
