The purpose of this meeting is to provide the community with an opportunity to learn about the proposed project and allow an open discussion of any views and comments concerning the proposed improvements. A Q&A session will immediately follow the presentation.

This project is to replace a temporary bridge and currently closed bridge on Brook Road that both collapsed during significant rainfall in September 2023. We encourage the public to attend this meeting to share their feedback with the CTDOT project team to incorporate into the design of these two bridges to meet current design standards, improving resiliency.

Right-of-way impacts associated with the proposed improvements include private, town, and state property and will consist of temporary construction easements for access, grading, and water handling, as well as a partial take for replacement of existing structures.

Construction is anticipated to begin spring 2027, based on the availability of funding, acquisition of rights of way, and approval of permit(s). The estimated construction cost for this project is approximately \$5.6 million with 80% federal funds and 20% state funds.
