The purpose of this project is to address deficiencies in the bridge, identified by recent inspections. Replacing the existing structure, that was originally constructed in 1958 and rehabilitated in 2002, will improve safety, and extend the service life of the structure.

Anticipated right-of-way associated with the prosed project will include one partial take, three permanent slope easements, one temporary construction easement, three right to construct driveways, and three right to install sedimentation control systems.

Construction is expected to start spring 2027, depending on funding, right-of-way acquisition, and permits. The estimated cost is \$3.515 Million, with 80% federal funds and 20% state funds.
