The purpose of this meeting is to provide the community with an opportunity to learn about the proposed project and allow an open discussion of any views and comments concerning the proposed improvements. A Q&A session will immediately follow the presentation.

Originally constructed in 1928, the bridge has exceeded its design lifespan and will be replaced with a precast concrete box culvert that will meet CTDOT and Federal Highway Administration design and safety standards.

Right-of-way impacts are anticipated as part of this project.

Construction is anticipated to start in spring 2030, depending on funding, right-of-way acquisitions, and permits. The estimated cost is \$3 million with 80% federal funds and 20% state funds.
