Right-of-way impacts associated with the project includes impacts on four abutting private properties, which will consist of temporary construction easements for access, grading, water handling, and an easement to install guiderail. All other construction will occur on town-owned property.

Construction is expected to start spring 2027 depending on funding, right-of-way acquisition, and permits. The estimated cost is \$2 million, with 80% federal funds and 20% state funds.
