



What is Design-Build?

Alternative Project Delivery Method

CTDOT provides a Base Technical Concept (BTC) and Project Requirements

Design-Build Team

- Contractor and Designer Team Selected Based on Best Value
- Best Value = Qualifications + Price + Technical Approach


Selected Team

- Completes Final Design
- Constructs the Project Based on Accepted Design






How is Design-Build Different from Design-Bid-Build Delivery?






Proposed Base Technical Concept (BTC) – East Center Street






Proposed Base Technical Concept (BTC) – New Rock Hill Road

- Northern Long Eared Bat (endangered) and Monarch Butterfly (threatened)
- Consultation Ongoing No Adverse Effects Anticipated

Wetland and Watercourses

- Minor Temporary and Permanent Impacts
 Anticipated; Exact Areas Currently Unknown
- Anticipated Regulatory Permits Include:
 - US Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) Section 404
 General Permit (GP) 18 & 19
 - CT Department of Energy & Environmental Protection (CTDEEP) Water Resource Construction Activities
 General Permit








Historical and Archaeological Resources

State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) Section 106 – Coordination is Ongoing

- Potentially Eligible Resources Adjacent to North Airline Road (near New Rock Hill Road) and Durham Road
- No Adverse Effect Anticipated

Tribal Historic Preservation Office (THPO) Section 106 – Consultation is Required



Potential Traffic Staging


Staged Construction

Signalized Alternating One-Way Traffic

Allow Full Bridge Closure with Detour

 New Rock Hill Road and Durham Road bridges <u>NOT</u> allowed to be closed at the same time





Utility Impacts

Utilities

- Attached to All Three Bridges
 - Wallingford Water & Sewer Division (water line)
 - Frontier Communications
- Utility Pole Relocations
 - Wallingford Electric
 - Frontier Communications
- Public Drinking Watershed
 - Coordination with Wallingford Water & Sewer Division will occur









Rights-of-Way

Minor Property Impacts are Anticipated

- At East Center Street and Tamarac Road
- Along New Rock Hill Road

Impacts to be Finalized

 Impacts finalized and property maps prepared once final concept has been approved





Replacement of Bridge Nos. 03129, 03130, & 03131 // State Project No. 0148-0215

Project Budget

Estimated Construction Costs

- Between \$60 and \$90 million (Scope Code "N")
- Anticipated 80% federal funds and 20% state funds


