







ADT: 25,000 vpd

Posted Speed: 45 mph

## SR 693 – Freeway Ramp


ADT: 11,000 vpd

ADT: 200 vpd

Posted Speed: 30 mph





# Purpose & Need

- **Reduce congestion**
  - Existing queue extends 2400' in the right-most lane on Route 32 northbound
- **Reduce congestion-related crashes**
  - 88 crashes with 20 injuries in the last 3 years



## Crash History

---

- 69% of total crashes were recorded in the right-most northbound travel lane on Route 32
  - 61 rear-end crashes with 13 injuries




