The purpose of this meeting is to provide the community with an opportunity to learn about the proposed project and allow an open discussion of any views and comments concerning the proposed improvements. A Q&A session will immediately follow the presentation.

The purpose of this project is to upgrade crosswalk signals to provide tools for crossing streets and encourage walking and other non-motorized transportation options at key traffic control signals in the Central Connecticut area.

There is potential for right-of-way impacts around new signal equipment and newly installed sidewalks at some project intersections.

Construction is expected to start summer 2027, depending on funding, right-of-way acquisition, and permits. The estimated cost is \$7 million, using 90% federal funds and 10% state funds.
