The purpose of this meeting is to provide the community with an opportunity to learn about the proposed project and allow an open discussion of any views and comments concerning the proposed improvements. A Q&A session will immediately follow the presentation.

The project involves installing and upgrading RRFB assemblies, sidewalk landing areas, ramps, and signage, enhancing safety at several pedestrian crossings across central Connecticut.

Right-of-way impacts should be limited; however, construction and/or permanent easements may be needed for RRFB appurtenances and/or sidewalk ramps.

Construction is expected to start spring 2028, depending on funding, right-of-way acquisition, and permits. The estimated cost is \$2 million, with 90% federal funds and 10% state funds.
