The purpose of this meeting is to provide the community with an opportunity to learn about the proposed project and allow an open discussion of any views and comments concerning the proposed improvements. A Q&A session will immediately follow the presentation.

[Centerline](#) rumble strips are a low-cost, proven safety countermeasure that alerts drivers when they drift out of a lane, reducing head-on collisions and roadway departure crashes.

Right-of-way impacts are not anticipated.

Construction is expected to start in 2027, depending on funding, right-of-way acquisition, and permits.
The estimated cost is \$5,000, with 100% state funds.
