





Towns will assume ownership and maintenance of signs and pavement markings following installation

 Implementation of Federal Highway Administration Proven Safety Countermeasure



Project Overview

- Purpose & Need
 - Implement Signing and pavement marking improvements at Unsignalized Municipally Owned and Maintained Intersections as needed to improve compliance and visibility
- Improvements include:
 - Replace Existing Stop Signs (varying sizes)
 - Reinstall Pavement Markings (Stop Bars & Double Yellow Center Lines)
 - Installing Stop Ahead and Intersection Ahead Warning Signs where appropriate






















Home Street at Kings Highway Cutoff, Fairfield







Project Coordination

 Received a link to online maps in addition to standard drawing to review and provide comments October 4, 2024.




