The purpose of this meeting is to provide the community with an opportunity to learn about the proposed project and allow an open discussion of any views and comments concerning the proposed improvements. A Q&A session will immediately follow the presentation.

These upgrades will enhance safety at several traffic signals for both pedestrians and vehicles.

Right-of-way impacts are expected to be minimal at some project intersections.

Construction is expected to start in 2028, depending on funding, right-of-way acquisition, and permits. The estimated cost is approximately \$6 million, with 90% federal funds and 10% state funds.
