The purpose of this meeting is to provide the community with an opportunity to learn about the proposed project and allow an open discussion of any views and comments concerning the proposed improvements. A Q&A session will immediately follow the presentation.

The purpose of this project is to replace aging and outdated traffic control signal infrastructure with new equipment to current standards in order to maintain reliable operation at project intersections throughout Southwestern Connecticut.

Right-of-way impacts are expected to be minimal around new signal equipment and newly installed sidewalks at some project intersections.

Construction is expected to start spring 2028, depending on funding, right-of-way acquisition, and permits. The estimated cost is \$18 million with 100% state funds.
