



- Partial Replacements 13 Signals along U.S. Route 44 in Avon and Simsbury












### "District Various" Projects

- State owns and maintains 2,799 traffic signals
- Goal is to keep signal components in good working order
- Signals are categorized as having a State of Good Repair (SOGR) Good, Fair, or Poor based on condition
- SOGR is a factor to identifying traffic signals to receive upgrades in projects
- Factors that are considered:
  - Age of Equipment
  - Structure Rating
  - Maintenance Calls/Local Input
  - Existing Pedestrian Treatment
     Existing Hardware/Detection





### **Project Overview**

- Purpose & Need
  - Replace Aging Signal Infrastructure with new signal equipment to achieve a state of good repair
- Improvements
  - New Signal Equipment at Intersections
  - Pedestrian Accommodation Improvements, including installation of new sidewalk
  - Potential Flashing Yellow Arrow
  - New Vehicle Detection at Intersections
  - Transit Stops (Improved Access)
  - Illumination of Crosswalks









Typical signal plan & field example showing detection location









#### Int. 130-214 – U.S. Route 6 & Route 67 (Main St N) at I-84 WB Ramps- Southbury









## Int. 004-205 - U.S. Routes 44 & 202 (W Main St) at Walmart and Goodwill Drives - Avon






# Int. 004-209 – U.S. Routes 44 & 202 (W Main St) at Driveways to Nod Brook Mall and Westridge Shops - Avon






