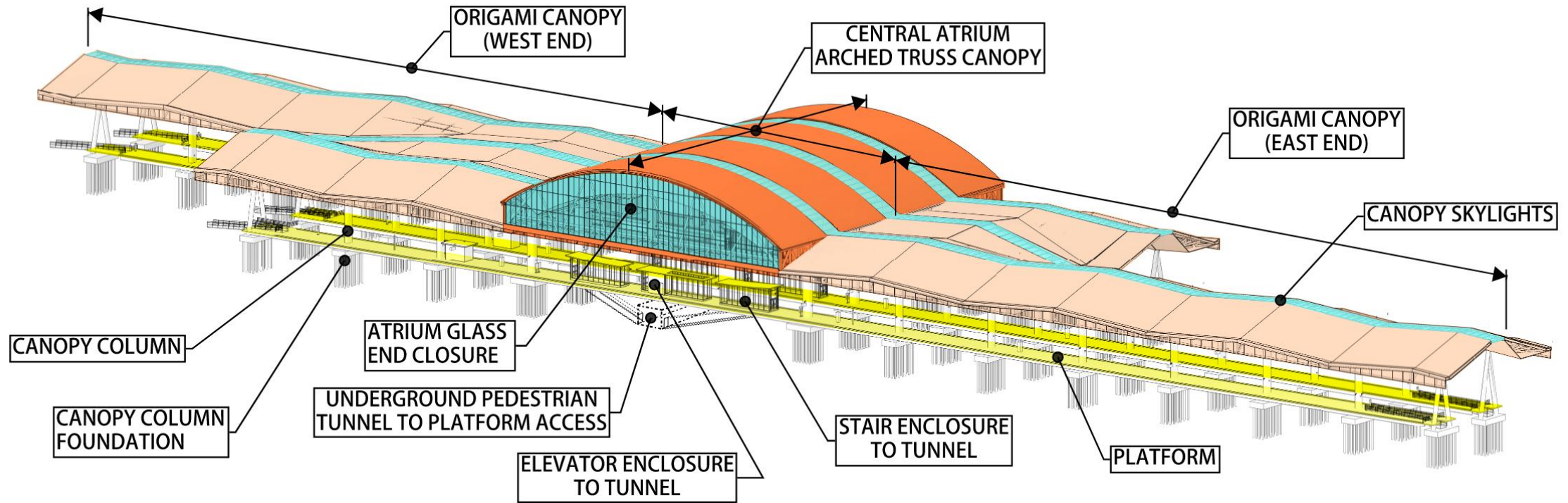
FULL CATENARY PORTAL STRUCTURE

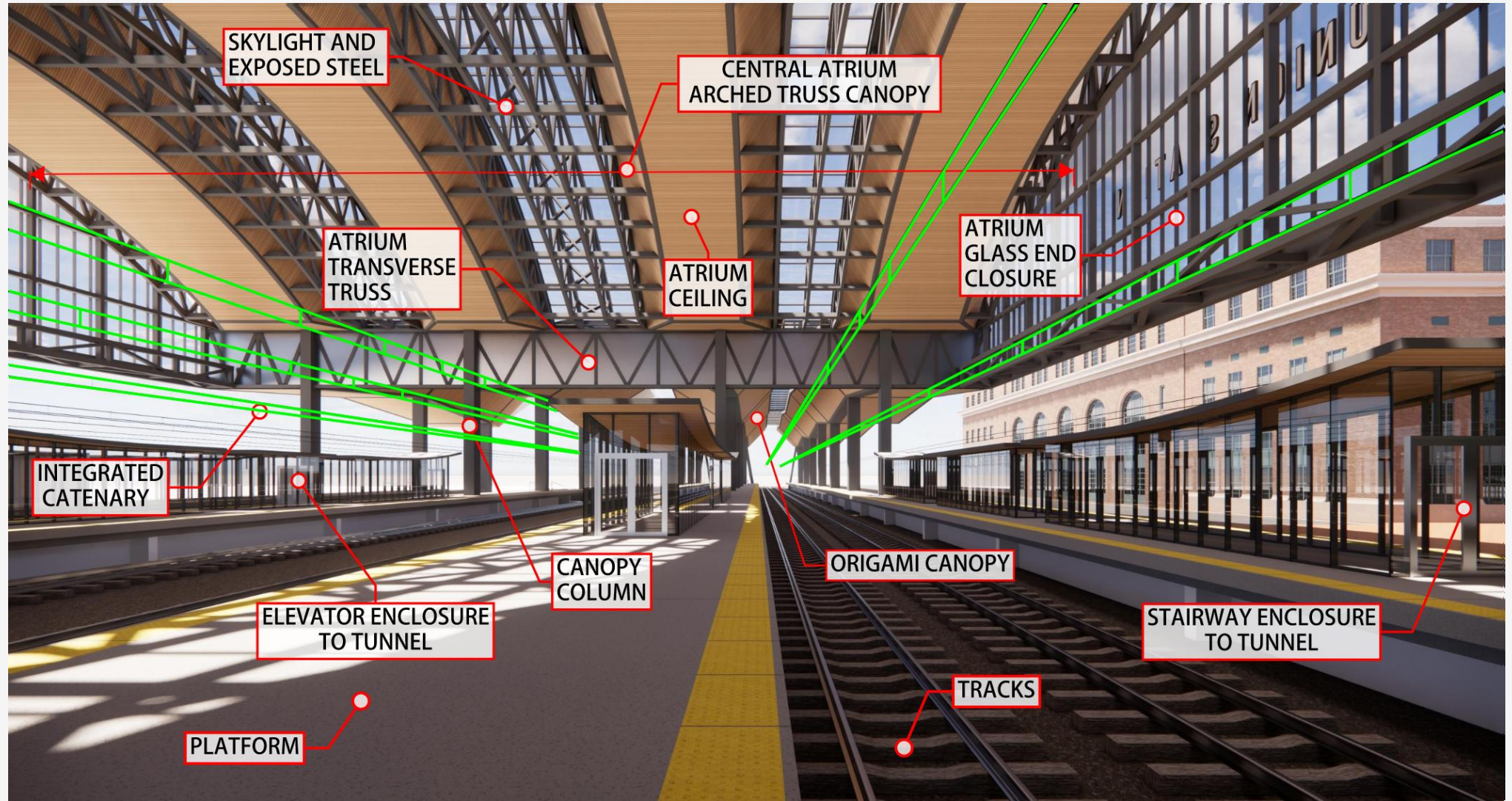

About the New Haven Union Rail Station Platforms & Canopy

Purpose:

- Replace existing aging platforms at Union Station with new lengthened platforms
- Replace existing platform canopies with a single full coverage canopy system (eliminates need for heated platforms)
- Upgrade of the Union Station Tunnel pedestrian passageway

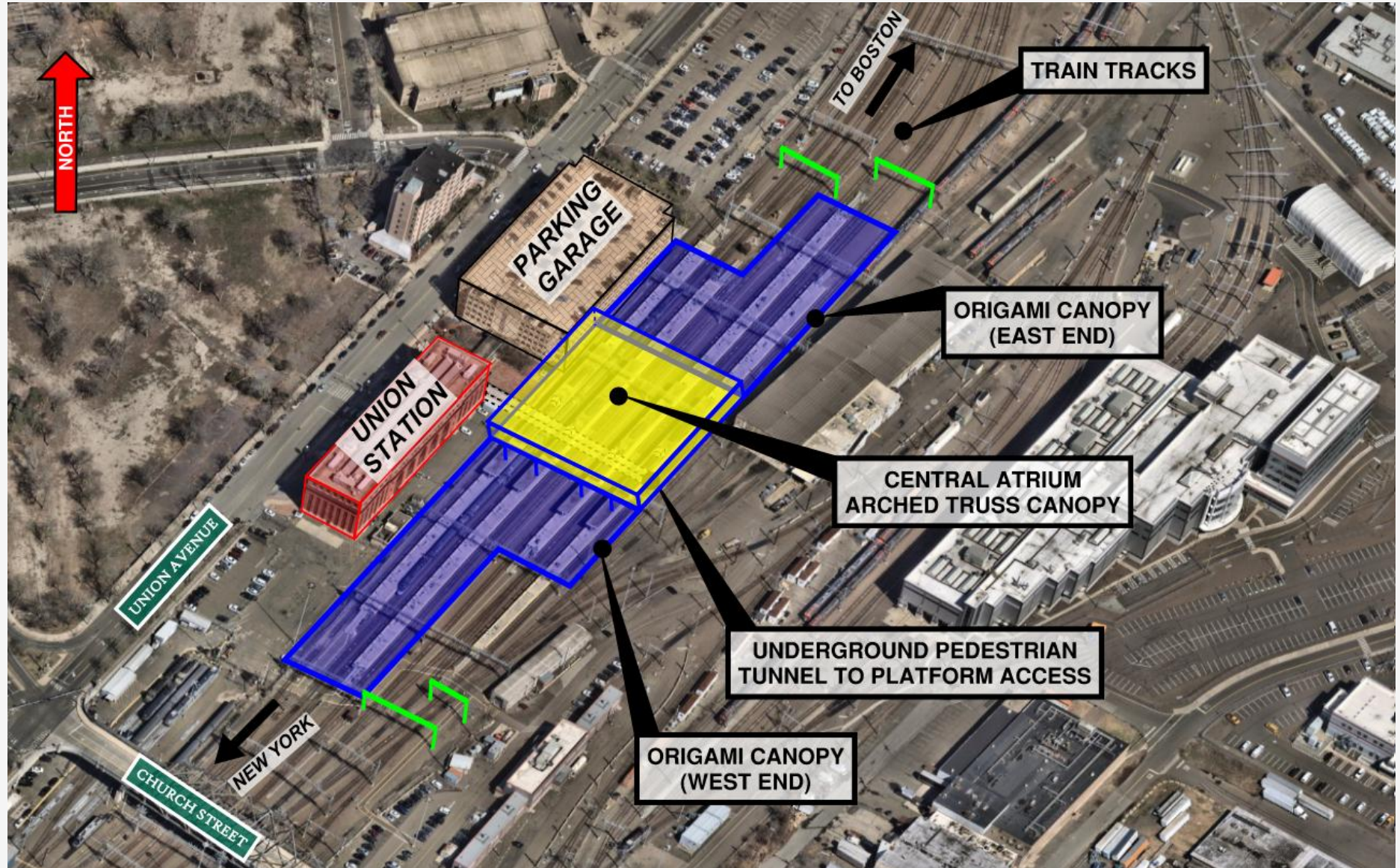
Other Benefits:

- Enhance pedestrian access and safety
- Protect passengers on platform from the elements
- Build an iconic structure serving as a City landmark
- Support increased intercity rail service on New Haven Main Line
- Position the area for future economic growth

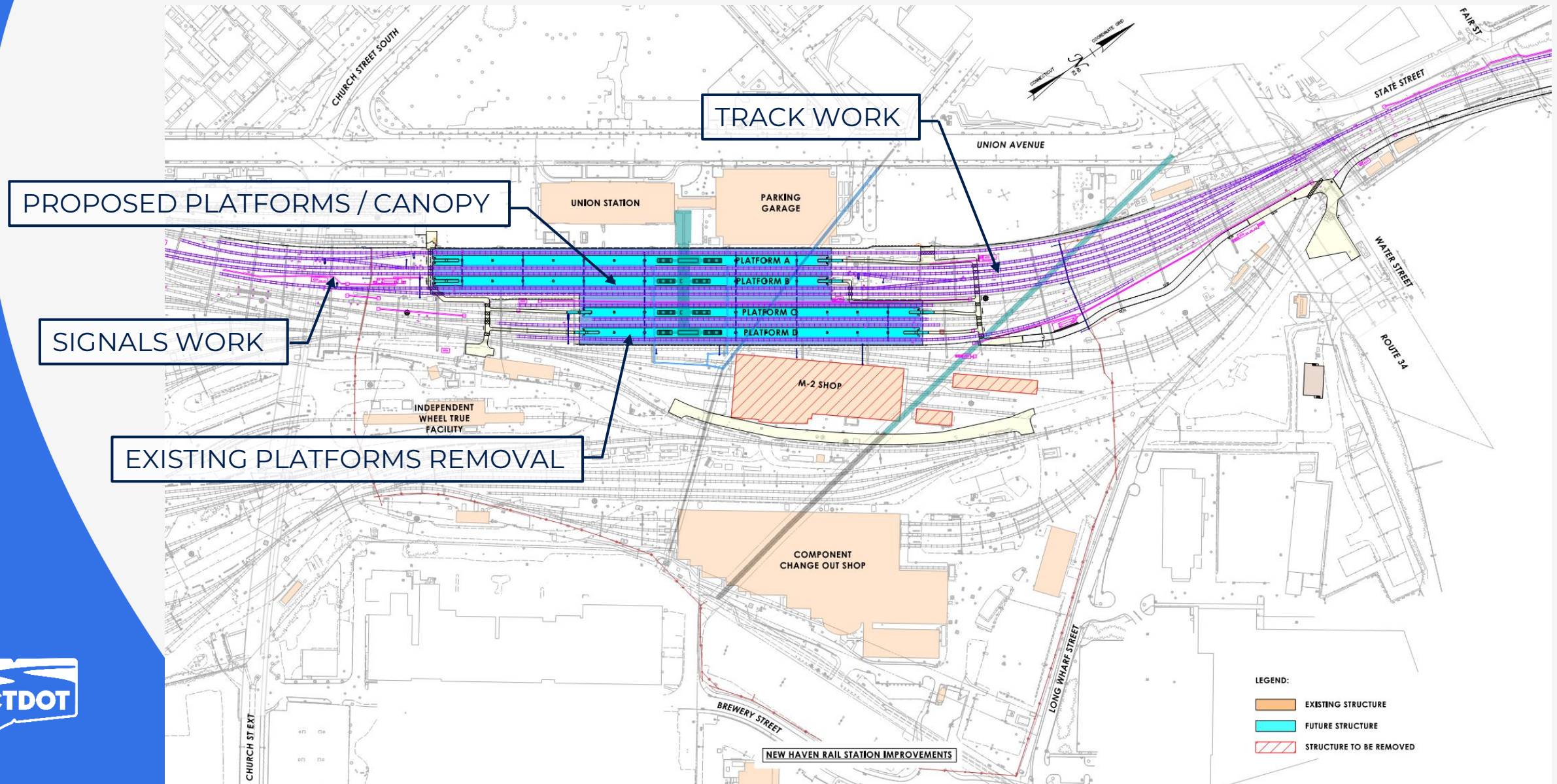
Project Design

New Haven Union Rail Station Platforms & Canopy

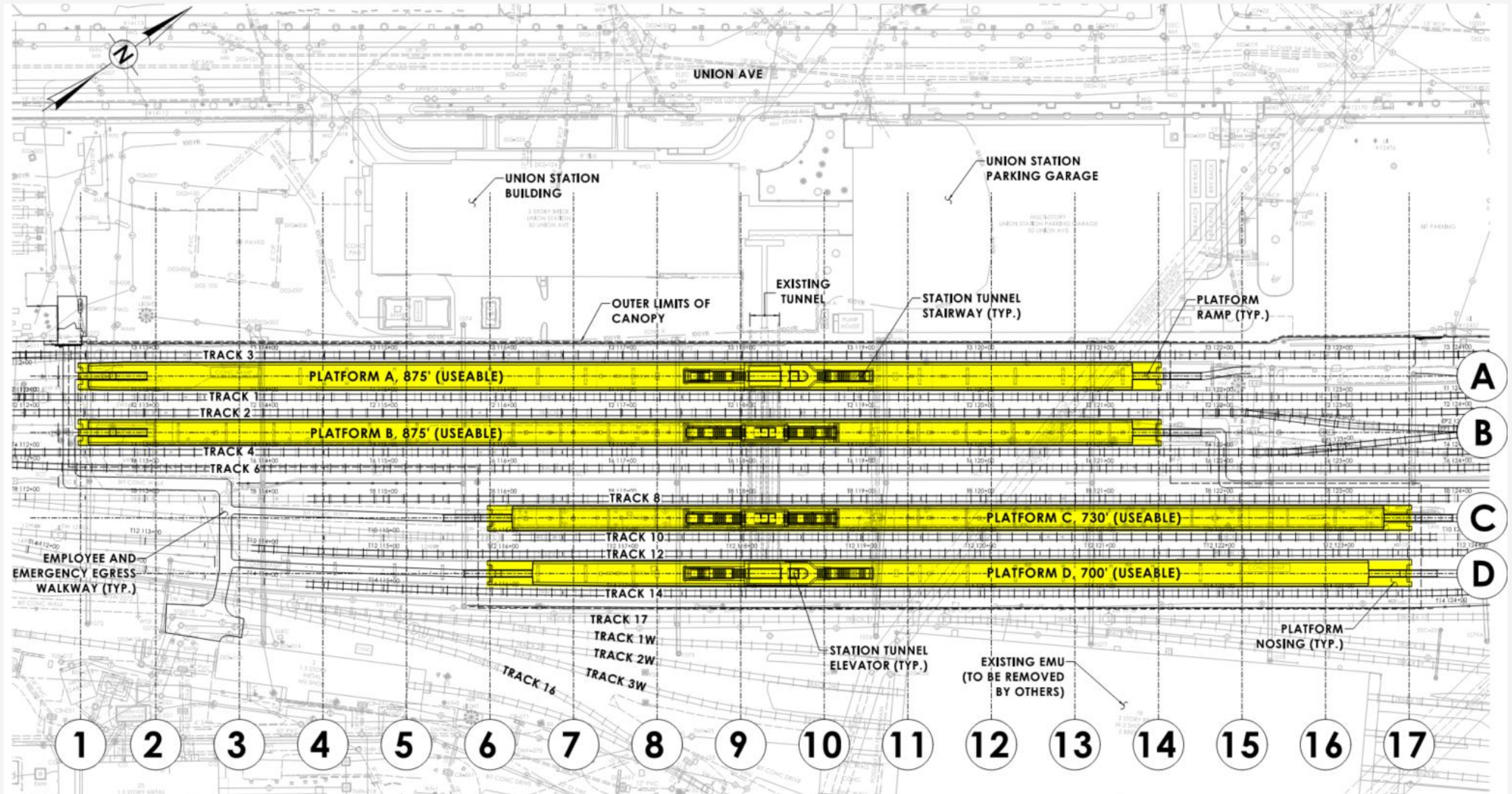
- Complete replacement of platforms, shelters, and stair connections
- Complete replacement of platform canopies with a single full coverage canopy system:
 - A centralized raised atrium “arch” canopy
 - Lower “origami” approach canopies on either side of centralized atrium
- Union Station Tunnel Improvements
 - Waterproofing improvements
 - Interior aesthetics and code-compliance improvements
 - Elevator improvements

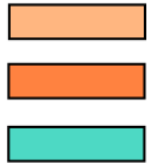

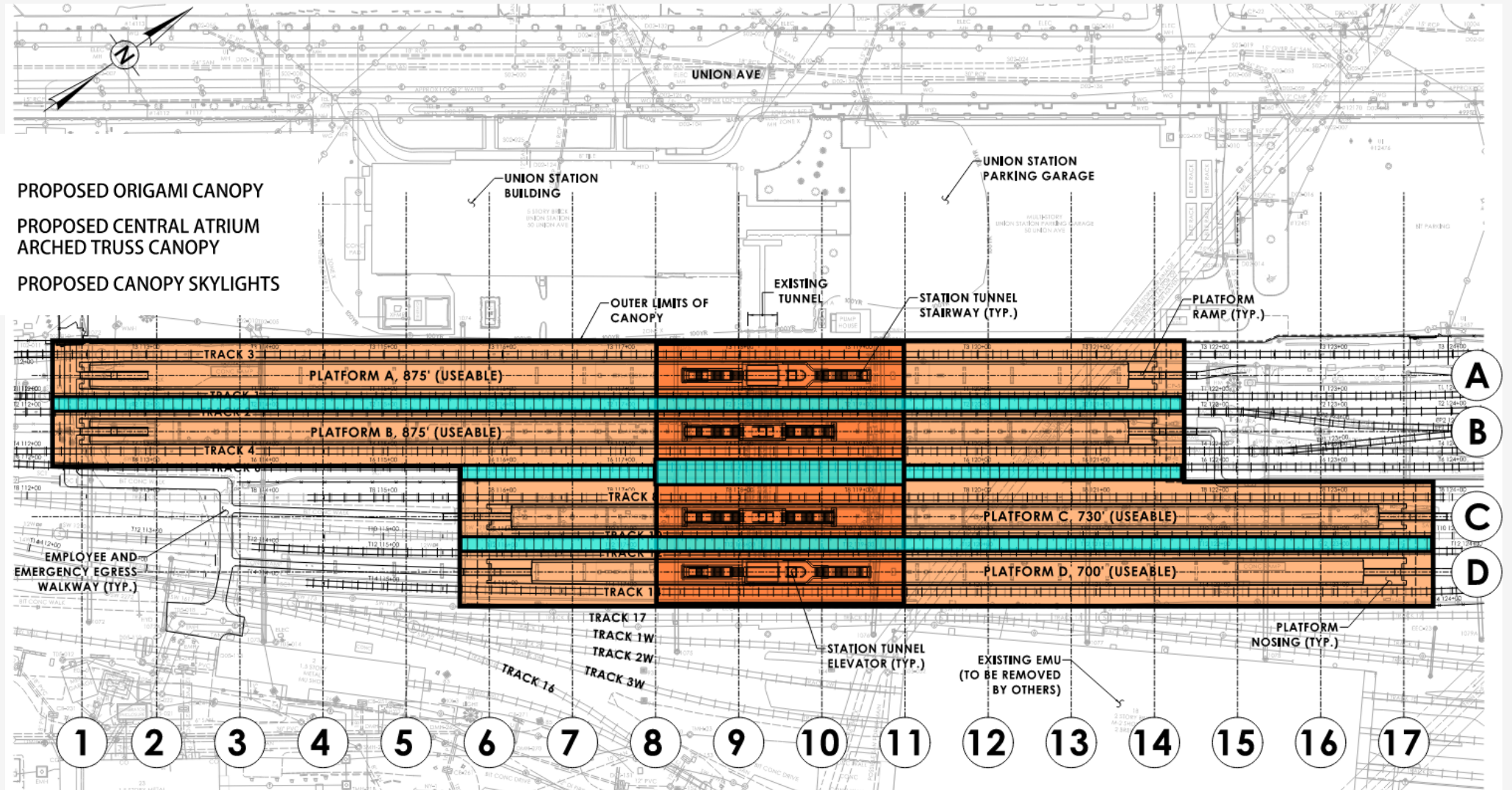

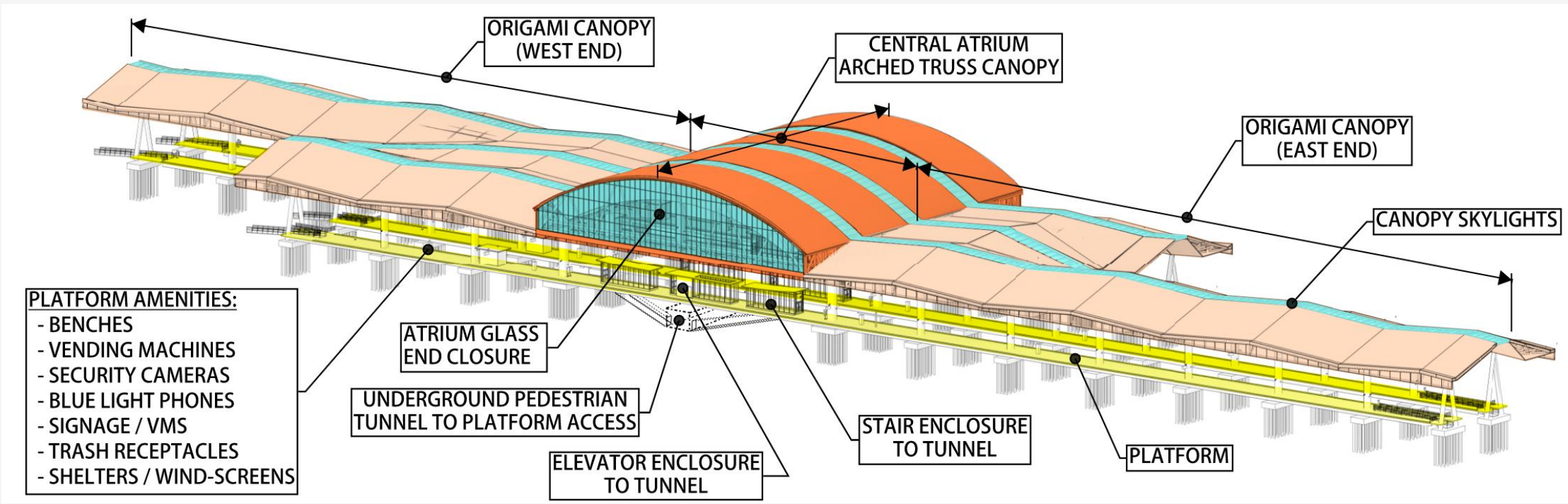

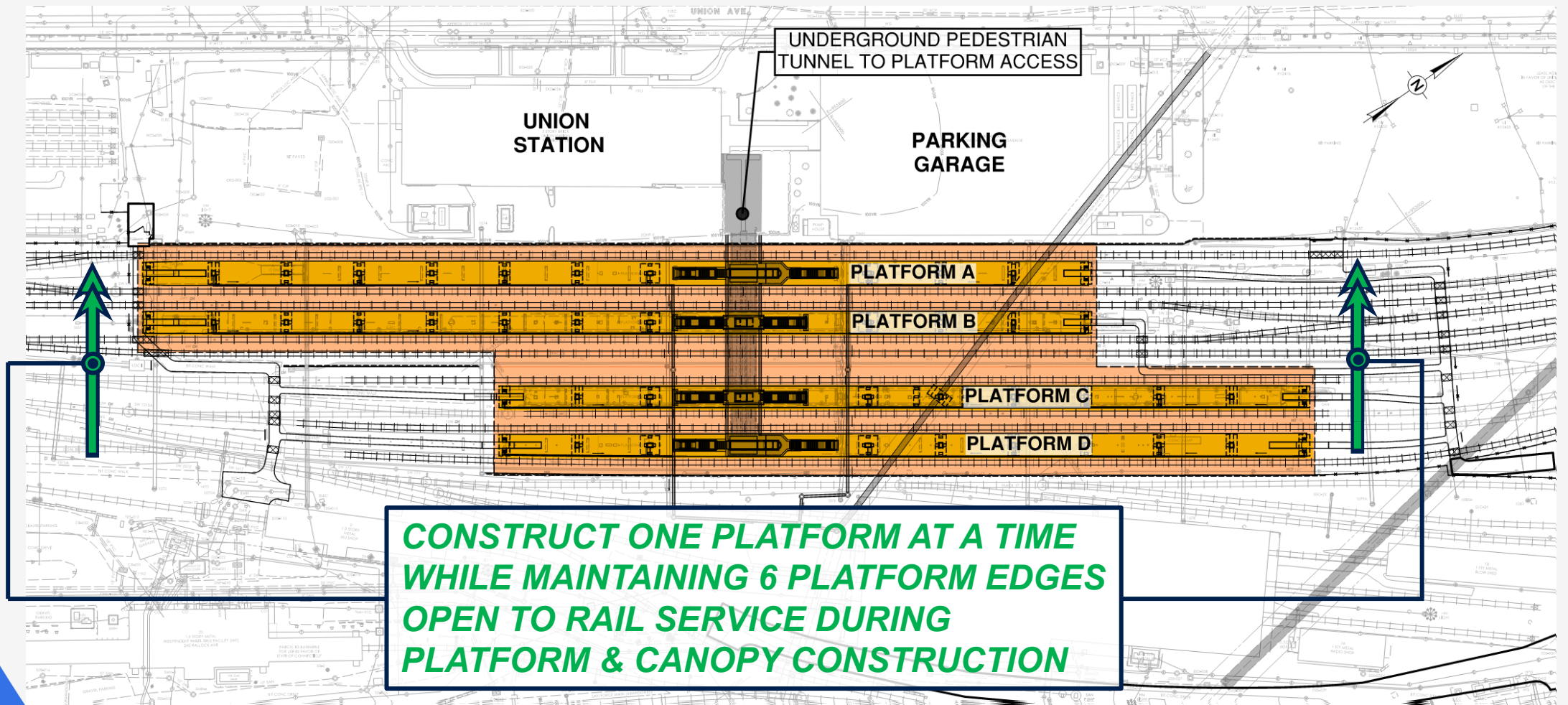

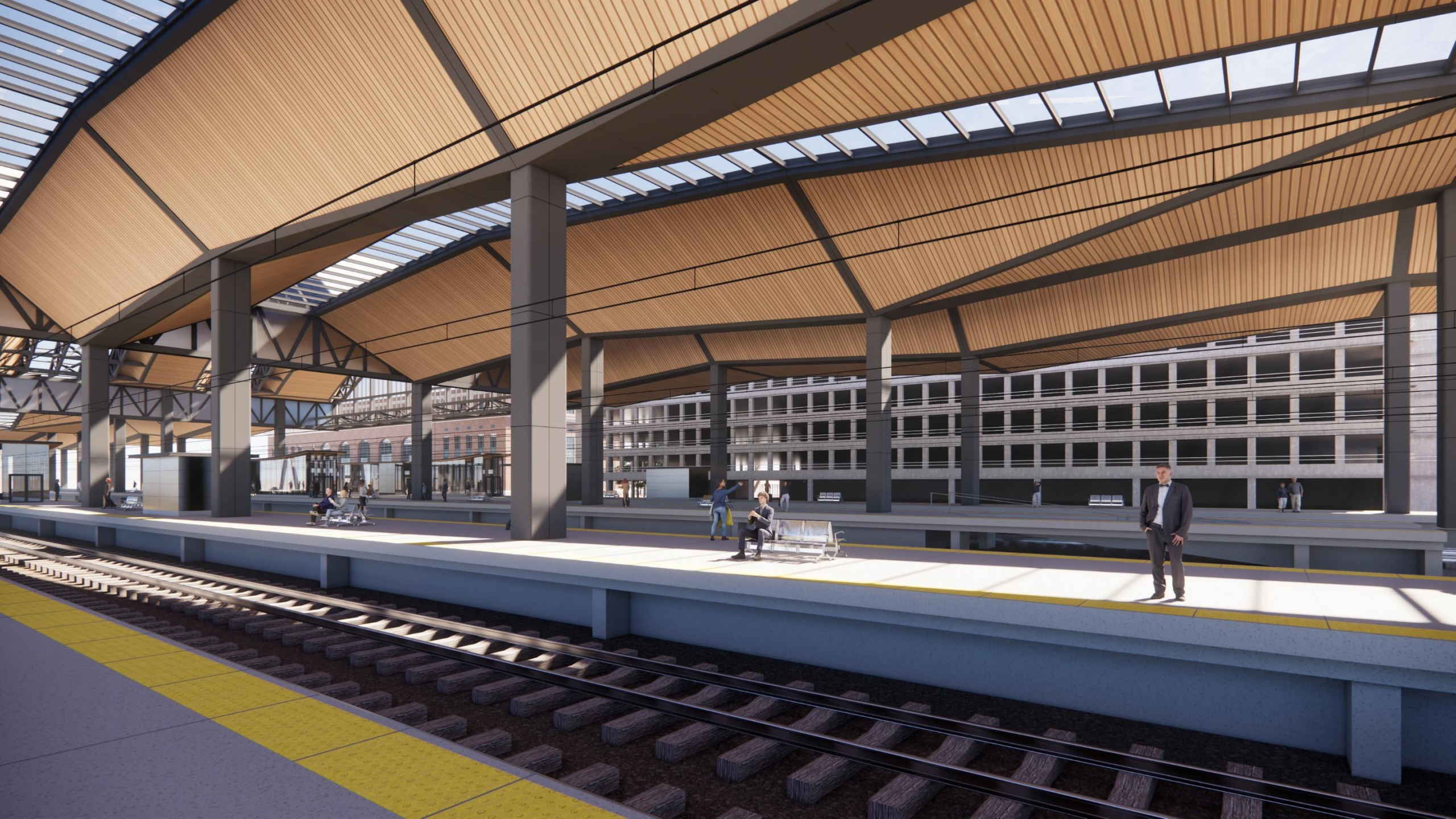
