The purpose of this meeting is to provide the community with an opportunity to learn about the proposed project and allow an open discussion of any views and comments concerning the proposed improvements. A Q&A session will immediately follow the presentation.

The project involves installing a new canopy platform system that will provide full coverage for passengers while on the platforms. Supporting rail, power, and station utility improvements will be included, as well as supplementary improvements to the pedestrian tunnel, stairs, and elevators.

Right-of-way impacts are not anticipated.

Construction is expected to start spring 2029, depending on funding and permits. The estimated cost is approximately \$402 million, with federal funds and state funds.
