The purpose of this meeting is to provide the community with an opportunity to learn about the proposed project and allow an open discussion of any views and comments concerning the proposed improvements. A Q&A session will immediately follow the presentation.

This project will convert the Court Street Bridge to pedestrian only and add a connection to State Street Station to enhance station accessibility and replace and extend the existing island platform at State Street Station.

Right-of-way impacts are expected to occur at several properties in the project area.

Construction is expected to start in spring 2027 for the Court Street Bridge and spring 2029 for State Street Station, depending on funding, right-of-way acquisition, and permits. The estimated cost is \$16 million for Court Street and \$74 million for State Street Station. The project design is being funded with 100% state funds and opportunities will be explored to include federal funding for the construction of Court Street.
