The purpose of this meeting is to provide the community with an opportunity to learn about the proposed project and allow an open discussion of any views and comments concerning the proposed improvements. A Q&A session will immediately follow the presentation.

This project will remove the temporary bridge and install a permanent structure that will improve safety for all roadway users by addressing sight line concerns, widen shoulders, and improve the flow of traffic by eliminating the existing traffic signal.

The right-of-way impacts associated with the proposed improvements are temporary to town owned property to allow for channel reconstruction and construction staging.

Construction is expected to start summer 2027, depending on funding, right-of-way acquisition, and permits. The estimated cost is \$7 million, with 80% federal funds and 20% state funds.
