REVISION AND REISSUANCE

INTRODUCTION

On October 25, 2023, Mark Dichiara, owner of Gateway Limousine, Inc., requested to increase the passenger capacity of his motor vehicles in general livery service from ten (10) passengers or less to fourteen (14) passengers or less. Valerie Seery, License & Applications Supervisor, approved his request. Therefore, livery permit number 2492 is hereby amended and reissued in the following form:

LIVERY PERMIT NUMBER 2492

FOR THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN LIVERY SERVICE

Gateway Limousine, Inc. is hereby permitted and authorized to operate sixteen (16) motor vehicles, each having a seating capacity of fourteen (14) passengers or less, in general livery service from a headquarters in Waterbury.

Furthermore, Gateway Limousine, Inc. is permitted and authorized to operate motor vehicles as a common carrier of passengers, in charter and special operations, in interstate commerce under such authorization as issued or amended by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration in the issuance of Certificate Number MC-219474-C.

This permit may not be sold or transferred until it has been operational, i.e., a vehicle registered with livery plates thereunder, for not less than twenty-four (24) consecutive months from the date of this final decision. If at any time during the twenty-four (24) month period the applicant enters into a contract for sale and transfer of any of the vehicles authorized under application 0802-AVWO-44-L, the authority granted herein will be revoked.

This permit shall remain in effect until it is amended, suspended, or revoked by the Department. Failure of the permit holder to maintain proper insurance and/or to comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other State statutes and/or the rules, regulations, and orders of the Department, shall be considered sufficient cause to amend, suspend, or revoke this permit. This permit is transferrable only with the approval of the Department. **Vehicles authorized herein must be registered within thirty (30) days of the date of this decision.**
