**0911-EXP-79-T**  
**EXECUTIVE 2000 TRANSPORTATION, LLC**  
**DBA EXECUTIVE 2000 TAXI**

**I. INTRODUCTION**

On March 4, 2024, it was discovered the Final Decision for application 0911-EXP-79-T, originally granted on June 8, 2011, was missing most of the taxi territories authorized in this certificate. This revision is correcting the certificate by adding the authorized territories back in.

By application filed on November 9, 2011 with the Department of Transportation (hereinafter "Department"), pursuant to Section 13b-97 of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended, and Section 13b-96-8 of the Connecticut State Agency Regulations, as amended, Executive 2000 Transportation, Inc. dba Executive 2000 Taxi (hereinafter "applicant") seeks authorization to operate one (1) additional motor vehicle in taxicab service within and to and from the towns of Cromwell, Durham, Haddam, Middlefield, Middletown, Portland, Colchester, East Haddam, Hebron, Lebanon, Marlborough, Salem, East Hampton, Bloomfield, East Hartford, East Windsor, Enfield, Farmington, Granby, Hartford, Manchester, Newington, Rocky Hill, Simsbury, Somers, South Windsor, Suffield, Vernon, West Hartford, Wethersfield, Windsor, Killingworth, Berlin, New Britain, Chester, Essex, Old Saybrook, Deep River, and Westbrook.

The applicant, holder of Certificate Number 1097, is currently authorized to operate twenty (20) motor vehicles in taxicab service as follows:

1. Ten (10) motor vehicles within and to and from the towns of Haddam, Durham, Middlefield, Middletown, Portland, and Cromwell to all points in Connecticut, five (5) of which may be used within and to and from said territory and Killingworth.
2. Three (3) motor vehicles within and to and from Colchester, Hebron, Lebanon, Marlborough, Salem, and East Hampton.
3. Two (2) motor vehicles within and to and from East Hampton.
4. One (1) motor vehicle within and to and from Bloomfield, East Hartford, East Windsor, Enfield, Farmington, Granby, Hartford, Manchester, Newington, Rocky Hill, Simsbury, Somers, South Windsor, Suffield, Vernon, West Hartford, Wethersfield, and Windsor.
5. One (1) motor vehicle within and to and from Berlin and New Britain.
6. Three (3) motor vehicles within and to and from Chester, Deep River, Essex, Old Saybrook, and Westbrook.

## II. DEPARTMENT ANALYSIS

1. The applicant has submitted the proper application before the Department.
2. The applicant has held Certificate Number 1097 for at least one year.
3. The Department records indicate that all the existing plates held by the applicant are registered and in use.
4. The Department records further indicate that there are no outstanding violations or matters pending adjudication against the applicant.

## III. CONCLUSION AND ORDER

Based on the above and pursuant to Section 13b-97, certificate 1097 is hereby amended and reissued as follows:

### **CERTIFICATE NUMBER 1097** **FOR THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN TAXICAB SERVICE**

Executive 2000 Transportation, LLC dba Executive 2000 Taxi is hereby certified and authorized to operate twenty-one (21) vehicles in taxicab service as follows:

1. Ten (10) motor vehicles within and to and from the towns of Haddam, Durham, Middlefield, Middletown, Portland, and Cromwell to all points in Connecticut, five (5) of which may be used within and to and from said territory and Killingworth.
2. Three (3) motor vehicles within and to and from Colchester, Hebron, Lebanon, Marlborough, Salem, and East Hampton.
3. Two (2) motor vehicles within and to and from East Hampton.
4. One (1) motor vehicle within and to and from Bloomfield, East Hartford, East Windsor, Enfield, Farmington, Granby, Hartford, Manchester, Newington, Rocky Hill, Simsbury, Somers, South Windsor, Suffield, Vernon, West Hartford, Wethersfield, and Windsor.
5. One (1) motor vehicle within and to and from Berlin and New Britain.
6. Three (3) motor vehicles within and to and from Chester, Deep River, Essex, Old Saybrook, and Westbrook.
7. One (1) motor vehicle within and to and from the towns of Cromwell, Durham, Haddam, Middlefield, Middletown, Portland, Colchester, East Haddam, Hebron, Lebanon, Marlborough, Salem, East Hampton, Bloomfield, East Hartford, East Windsor, Enfield, Farmington, Granby, Hartford, Manchester, Newington, Rocky Hill, Simsbury, Somers, South Windsor, Suffield, Vernon, West Hartford, Wethersfield, Windsor, Killingworth, Berlin, New Britain, Chester, Essex, Old Saybrook, Deep River, and Westbrook.

## **RESTRICTIONS:**

**The applicant must register all authorized vehicles granted under this certificate within sixty (60) days from the date of this decision. Failure to do so may result in revocation of this authority.**

The authority granted in application 0911-EXP-79-T may not be sold or transferred until it has been in operation, i.e., a vehicle registered with taxicab plates thereunder, for no less than twenty-four (24) consecutive months from June 8, 2011. If during the twenty-four (24) month period the applicant enters into a contract for the full sale or transfer of any of the vehicles authorized herein, the authority granted in application 0911-EXP-79-T will be revoked.

This certificate shall remain in effect until revoked by the Department. Failure of the certificate holder to maintain proper insurance and/or comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other state statutes and/or the rules, regulations, and orders of the Department shall be considered sufficient cause to revoke said certificate.

This certificate is transferable only with the approval of the Department and is issued subject to compliance by the holder hereof with all motor vehicle laws of the State of Connecticut, and with such rules, regulations, and orders as this Department may from time to time prescribe thereunder.
