APPLICATION 2311-RE-145-L RE-ENTITLEMENT OF AUTHORITY OF ALLIED REHABILITATION CENTERS, INC TO ALLIED COMMUNITY PROGRAMS, INC

INTRODUCTION

By application filed on November 30th, 2023, with the Department of Transportation (hereinafter "Department"), Allied Rehabilitation Centers, Inc. (hereinafter "applicant") has re-entitled its authority to Allied Community Programs, Inc. Therefore, Livery Permit Number 2695 is amended and re-issued as follows:

<u>LIVERY PERMIT NO. 2695</u> FOR THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN LIVERY SERVICE

Allied Community Programs, Inc is hereby permitted and authorized, in accordance with and under the provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended, to operate Elderly & Handicapped Livery Service between all points in Connecticut from a headquarters in Enfield with authority for nine (9) vehicles approved in the following manner:

- 1. Five (5) motor vehicles, each having a seating capacity of ten (10) passengers or less.
- 2. Four (4) van type motor vehicles, each having a seating capacity of ten (10) passengers or less one of which shall be wheelchair accessible.

Allied Community Programs, Inc is also permitted and authorized to operate motor vehicles as a common carrier of passengers, in charter and special operations, in interstate commerce under such authorization as issued or amended by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration in the issuance of Certificate Number: MC-978985-C.

RESTRICTIONS:

This permit shall remain in effect until it is amended, suspended, or revoked by the Department. Failure of the permit holder to maintain proper insurance and/or to comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other State statutes and/ or the rules, regulations and orders of the Department shall be considered sufficient cause to amend, suspend, or revoke this permit. This permit is transferrable only with the approval of the Department.
