APPLICATION OF LAND JET, INC., HOLDER OF LIVERY PERMIT NO. 2261, TO TRANSFER BOTH HEADQUARTERS IN DANBURY AND WATERBURY TO WATERTOWN

#### I. APPLICANT'S PROPOSAL

By application 2401-TH-9-L filed on January 25, 2024, pursuant to Section 13b-103 of the Connecticut General Statutes (CGS), Land Jet, Inc. (hereinafter "applicant"), holder of Livery Permit Number 2261, seeks authorization from the Connecticut Department of Transportation (hereinafter "Department"), to transfer its Danbury and Waterbury headquarters to Watertown, and close the Danbury and Waterbury headquarters. Specifically, to transfer:

- 1. The authority to operate motor vehicles of a bus type in general livery service to all points in Connecticut from a headquarters in Danbury to a headquarters in Watertown.
- 2. The authority to operate motor vehicles of a bus type in general livery service to all points in Connecticut from a headquarters in Waterbury to a headquarters in Waterbury.
- 3. The authority to operate motor vehicles of a bus type as a common carrier of passengers, in charter and special operations, in interstate commerce under such authorization as issued or amended by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration in the issuance of Certificate No. MC-00167321-C.

#### II. DEPARTMENT ANALYSIS

A legal notice was mailed to registered livery companies in the headquarters town and towns contiguous to its headquarters town. No opposition was filed within the thirty (30) days as allowed by statute. The Department's staff has analyzed the evidence presented in this instant application and finds that it should be granted without a hearing.

#### III. <u>FINDINGS OF FACT</u>

- 1. The applicant has submitted the proper application before this Department.
- 2. The Department finds that the applicant's records indicate all its authorized vehicles have been in use and are available for transfer.
- 3. No opposition was filed by existing operators in the headquarters town.

## IV. CONCLUSION AND ORDER

Based on the above and pursuant to Sections 13b-102 and 13b-103, the instant application, given Application Number 2401-TH-9-L, filed by Land Jet, Inc. is approved, and Livery Permit Number 2261 is amended and reissued as follows:

### <u>LIVERY PERMIT NUMBER 2261</u> FOR THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN LIVERY SERVICE

Land Jet, Inc. is hereby permitted and authorized to operate motor vehicles of a bus type in general livery service to all points in Connecticut from a headquarters in Watertown.

Land Jet, Inc. is further permitted and authorized to operate motor vehicles as a common carrier of passengers, in charter and special operations, in interstate commerce under such authorization as issued or amended by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration in the issuance of Certificate No. MC-00167321-C.

This permit shall remain in effect until it is amended, suspended, or revoked by the Department. Failure of the permit holder to maintain proper insurance and/or to comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other State statutes and/or the rules, regulations, and orders of the Department, shall be considered sufficient cause to amend, suspend, or revoke this permit. This permit is transferrable only with the approval of the Department.
