I. APPLICANT'S PROPOSAL

By application 2403-TH-20-L filed on March 7th, 2024, pursuant to Section 13b-103 of the Connecticut General Statutes (CGS), Sky Transportation, LLC DBA Safe Transportation (hereinafter "applicant"), holder of Livery Permit Number 3304, seeks authorization from the Connecticut Department of Transportation (hereinafter "Department"), to transfer its Newington headquarters to Farmington and to close the Newington headquarters. This includes the transfer of the following vehicles:

1. Thirteen (13) motor vehicles with a passenger capacity of less than eleven (11) passengers in general livery service.
2. Three (3) motor vehicles with a passenger capacity of less than eleven (11) passengers for the provision of livery service under contract with Medical Transportation Management, Inc dba Veyo.

II. DEPARTMENT ANALYSIS

A legal notice was mailed to registered livery companies in the headquarters towns and towns contiguous to its headquarters town and was not opposed within the thirty (30) days as allowed by statute. The Department's staff has analyzed the evidence presented in this instant application and finds that it should be granted without a hearing.

III. FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The applicant has submitted the proper application before this Department.
2. The Department finds that the applicant's records indicate all its vehicles have been in use and are available for transfer.
3. No opposition was filed by existing operators in the headquarters town.

IV. CONCLUSION AND ORDER

Based on the above and pursuant to Sections 13b-102 and 13b-103, the instant application, given Application Number 2403-TH-20-L, filed by Sky Transportation, LLC DBA Safe Transportation, is approved and Livery Permit Number 3304 is amended and reissued as follows:

LIVERY PERMIT NUMBER 3304 **FOR THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN LIVERY SERVICE**

Sky Transportation, LLC dba Safe Transportation is authorized to operate thirteen (13) motor vehicles, each having a seating capacity of less than eleven (11) passengers, in general livery service to all points in Connecticut from a headquarters in Farmington.

RESTRICTIONS:

This permit shall remain in effect until it is amended, suspended, or revoked by the Department. Failure of the permit holder to maintain proper insurance and/or to comply with all pertinent motor vehicle

laws and other State statutes and/or the rules, regulations, and orders of the Department, shall be considered sufficient cause to amend, suspend, or revoke this permit.

DURATIONAL LIVERY SERVICE
FOR THE PROVISION OF DURATIONAL TRANSPORTATION OF PASSENGERS FOR HIRE
BY VIRTUE OF A CONTRACT WITH MEDICAL TRANSPORTATION MANAGEMENT, INC
DBA VEYO GRANTED IN DOCKET NO. 1307-GOV-303-L ON DECEMBER 16, 2013

Sky Transportation, LLC dba Safe Transportation is hereby permitted and authorized to operate three (3) motor vehicles, each having a seating capacity of less than eleven (11) passengers for the provision of livery service under contract with Medical Transportation Management, Inc dba Veyo to all points in Connecticut from a headquarters in Farmington, Connecticut. The authority granted in Docket Number 1703-GOV-303-L shall be durational in nature and shall exist only for the period of time that the permit holder has a current and continuing contract in effect for the provision of service with Medical Transportation Management, Inc dba Veyo.

The permit holder shall notify the department of any termination of its contract with Medical Transportation Management, Inc dba Veyo or the cessation of the active provision of service thereunder. The permit holder shall file with the Department on an annual basis, upon registration or re-registration of the motor vehicles authorized in this decision, a current, executed contract of said contract. Failure to file an extension of the contract or a new executed contract with Medical Transportation Management, Inc dba Veyo shall void the authority for the vehicles authorized pursuant to that contract.

This permit is nontransferable and shall remain in effect until revoked by the Department or until the contract under which this authority is granted has expired. Failure of the permit holder to maintain proper insurance and/or comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other state statues and/or rules, regulations and orders of the Department shall be considered sufficient cause to amend, suspend or revoke said permit.
