## I. INTRODUCTION

Executive 2000 Transportation, LLC dba Executive 2000 Taxi, hereinafter “transferor”, is the holder of Certificate Number 1097 for the operation of motor vehicles in taxicab service, last issued by the Department of Transportation, hereinafter “Department”, on March 6, 2024, authorizing the operation of a total of twenty-one (21) motor vehicles in taxicab service as follows:

1. Ten (10) motor vehicles within and to and from the towns of Haddam, Durham, Middlefield, Middletown, Portland, and Cromwell to all points in Connecticut, five (5) of which may be used within and to and from said territory and Killingworth.
2. Three (3) motor vehicles within and to and from Colchester, Hebron, Lebanon, Marlborough, Salem, and East Hampton.
3. Two (2) motor vehicles within and to and from East Hampton.
4. One (1) motor vehicle within and to and from Bloomfield, East Hartford, East Windsor, Enfield, Farmington, Granby, Hartford, Manchester, Newington, Rocky Hill, Simsbury, Somers, South Windsor, Suffield, Vernon, West Hartford, Wethersfield, and Windsor.
5. One (1) motor vehicle within and to and from Berlin and New Britain.
6. Three (3) motor vehicles within and to and from Chester, Deep River, Essex, Old Saybrook, and Westbrook.
7. One (1) motor vehicle within and to and from the towns of Cromwell, Durham, Haddam, Middlefield, Middletown, Portland, Colchester, East Haddam, Hebron, Lebanon, Marlborough, Salem, East Hampton, Bloomfield, East Hartford, East Windsor, Enfield, Farmington, Granby, Hartford, Manchester, Newington, Rocky Hill, Simsbury, Somers, South Windsor, Suffield, Vernon, West Hartford, Wethersfield, Windsor, Killingworth, Berlin, New Britain, Chester, Essex, Old Saybrook, Deep River, and Westbrook.

## II. APPLICANTS' PROPOSAL

By joint application filed on April 2, 2024, with the Department, pursuant to section 13b-96 and 13b-97(c) of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended, the applicants seek Department approval of the sale and transfer of the authority granted under Certificate Number 1097 for the operation of motor vehicles in taxicab service from the transferor, to Allride, LLC dba M7, hereinafter “transferee”.

## III. FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The applicants have submitted the proper application before the Department.
2. After a review of the transferor's records, it was determined that the transferor only had three (3) of the twenty-one (21) authorized vehicles registered and in operation, making the remaining authority noncompliant and ineligible for sale or transfer.

3. The applicants both requested sale and transfer of only the portion of the certificate which is compliant which consists of 3 (three) vehicles in taxicab service within the territories of Haddam, Durham, Middlefield, Middletown, Portland, Cromwell, Killingworth, Chester, Deep River, Essex, Old Saybrook and Westbrook. The remaining authority under Certificate 1097 will be revoked upon completion of the sale.

4. The transferee's financial statement indicates they are financially able to staff, equip and operate the motor vehicles in taxicab service sold herein.

5. The required Connecticut State Police Criminal History Information Reports were filed with the application.

6. A copy of the purchase agreement was submitted with the application.

7. Proof of sufficient insurance coverage for the transferee was submitted with the application.

#### IV. CONCLUSION

Therefore, based upon the facts stated above, and pursuant to Section 13b-96 and 13b-97(c) of the Connecticut General Statutes, the Department hereby approves the sale and transfer of the authority granted under Certificate Number 1097 for the operation of motor vehicles in taxicab service, as proposed, to Allride, LLC dba M7.

Following the approval of this sale and transfer, the transferee will retain no rights to the authority transferred and Certificate 1097 is hereby amended and reissued in the following form:

#### **CERTIFICATE NUMBER 1097** **FOR THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN TAXICAB SERVICE**

Allride, LLC dba M7 is hereby permitted and authorized to operate a total of **THREE (3)** motor vehicles in taxicab service, within, to and from the towns of Haddam, Durham, Middlefield, Middletown, Portland, Cromwell, Killingworth, Chester, Deep River, Essex, Old Saybrook and Westbrook to all points in Connecticut.

The authority granted in application 2404-S-31-T may not be sold or transferred until it has been in operation, i.e., a vehicle registered with taxi plates thereunder, for not less than twenty-four (24) consecutive months. If during the twenty-four (24) month period the applicant enters into a contract for the full sale or transfer of any of the vehicles authorized herein, the authority granted in application 2404-S-31-T will be revoked.

This certificate shall remain in effect until revoked by the Department. Failure of the certificate holder to maintain proper insurance and/or comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other State statutes and/or the rules, regulations, and orders of the Department shall be considered sufficient cause to revoke said certificate.

This certificate is transferable only with the approval of the Department and is issued subject to compliance by the holder hereof with all motor vehicle laws of the State of Connecticut, and with such rules, regulations, and orders as this Department may from time to time prescribe thereunder.
