# APPLICATION NO. 2409-I-80-B REGISTRATION OF A FEDERAL MOTOR CARRIER SAFETY ADMINISTRATION INTERSTATE CHARTER BUS AUTHORITY

#### **INTRODUCTION**

By application 2409-I-80-B, filed with the Connecticut Department of Transportation (hereinafter "Department") on September 4, 2024, Shuttlebus Solutions, Inc. (hereinafter "applicant") of 8 Candlelight Place, Greenwich, CT seeks approval to register its Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration authority, as authorized and contained in Certificate No. MC-1524583-C issued on March 17, 2023.

Shuttlebus Solutions, Inc. is currently permitted and authorized to operate bus type motor vehicles in intrastate charter bus transportation in accordance with the Connecticut General Statutes, Section 13b-94a, between all points in Connecticut from a headquarters in Greenwich.

After consideration by the Department, the instant application is hereby approved in accordance with Connecticut General Statutes, Sections 13b-88 and 13b-89, and Charter Bus Permit No. 577 is revised and re-issued in the following form:

### BUS PERMIT NO. 577 FOR THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN CHARTER BUS OPERATIONS

Shuttlebus Solutions, Inc. is permitted and authorized to operate motor vehicles as a common carrier of passengers, in charter bus operations, in interstate commerce under such authorization as issued or amended by the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration in the issuance of Certificate No. MC-1524583-C.

Furthermore, Shuttlebus Solutions, Inc. is also permitted and authorized to operate bus type motor vehicles in intrastate charter bus transportation in accordance with the Connecticut General Statutes, Section 13b-94a, between all points in Connecticut from a headquarters in Greenwich.

This permit shall remain in effect until it is amended, suspended, or revoked by the Department. Failure of the permit holder to maintain proper insurance and/or comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other State Statutes and/or the rules, regulations and orders of the Department shall be considered sufficient cause to amend, suspend or revoke the permit. This permit is transferrable only with the approval of the Department. Vehicles authorized herein must be registered within sixty (30) days of the date on this decision.
