I. INTRODUCTION

It came to the Department of Transportation's (hereinafter "Department") attention today, April 17, 2025, the last Final Decision written for this certificate did not include all the authorized vehicles and territories granted previously by hearing for this certificate and gave no explanation for the change. Furthermore, the last Final Decision was poorly written and incomplete. By revising and rewriting this certificate the department is adding all the authorized vehicles and territories back and correcting the wording.

By application filed on August 27, 2013, with the Department, pursuant to Section 13b-97 of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended, and Section 13b-96-8 of the Connecticut State Agency Regulations, as amended, Ace Taxi Service, Inc. dba Ace Taxi (hereinafter "applicant") seeks authorization to operate one (1) additional motor vehicle in taxicab service within and to and from the town of Hartford.

The applicant, holder of Certificate Number 1066, is currently authorized to operate the following:

1. Ten (10) motor vehicles in taxicab service within and to and from the towns of Bloomfield, East Hartford, East Hartford, East Windsor, Enfield, Farmington, Granby, Hartford, Manchester, Newington, Rocky Hill, Simsbury, South Windsor, Vernon, West Hartford, Wethersfield, Willington, and Windsor.
2. Six (6) motor vehicles in taxicab service within and to and from the towns of Ellington, Tolland, and Stafford.
3. Two (2) motor vehicles in taxicab service within and to and from the towns of Somers and Suffield.
4. Two (2) motor vehicles in taxicab service within and to and from the town of Windsor Locks.
5. Two (2) motor vehicles in taxicab service within and to and from the town of Willington.
6. Eight (8) motor vehicles in taxicab service within and to and from the towns of Andover, Columbia, Coventry, Mansfield and Windham.

II. DEPARTMENT ANALYSIS

1. The applicant has submitted the proper application before the Department.
2. The applicant has held Certificate Number 1066 for at least one year.
3. The Department records indicate that all the existing plates held by the applicant are registered and in use.
4. The Department records further indicate that there are no outstanding violations or matters pending adjudication against the applicant.

III. CONCLUSION AND ORDER

Based on the above and pursuant to Section 13b-97, certificate 1066 is hereby amended and reissued as follows:

CERTIFICATE NUMBER 1066
FOR THE OPERATION OF VEHICLES IN TAXICAB SERVICE

Ace Taxi Service, Inc. dba Ace Taxi is hereby permitted and authorized, in accordance with and under the provisions of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended, to operate the following:

1. Ten (10) motor vehicles in taxicab service within and to and from the towns of Bloomfield, East Hartford, East Hartford, East Windsor, Enfield, Farmington, Granby, Hartford, Manchester, Newington, Rocky Hill, Simsbury, South Windsor, Vernon, West Hartford, Wethersfield, Willington, and Windsor.
2. Six (6) motor vehicles in taxicab service within and to and from the towns of Ellington, Tolland, and Stafford.
3. Two (2) motor vehicles in taxicab service within and to and from the towns of Somers and Suffield.
4. Two (2) motor vehicles in taxicab service within and to and from the town of Windsor Locks.
5. Two (2) motor vehicles in taxicab service within and to and from the town of Willington.
6. Eight (8) motor vehicles in taxicab service within and to and from the towns of Andover, Columbia, Coventry, Mansfield and Windham.
7. One (1) motor vehicle in taxicab service within and to and from the town of Hartford.

The authority granted in application 1308-EXP-319-T may not be sold or transferred until it has been in operation, i.e., a vehicle registered with taxicab plates thereunder, for no less than twenty-four (24) consecutive months from the date of issue. If during the twenty-four (24) month period the applicant enters into a contract for the full sale or transfer of any of the vehicles authorized herein, the authority granted in application 1308-EXP-319-T will be revoked.

This certificate shall remain in effect until revoked by the Department. Failure of the certificate holder to maintain proper insurance and/or comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other state statutes and/or the rules, regulations, and orders of the Department shall be considered sufficient cause to revoke said certificate.

This certificate is transferable only with the approval of the Department and is issued subject to compliance by the holder hereof with all motor vehicle laws of the State of Connecticut, and with such rules, regulations, and orders as this Department may from time to time prescribe thereunder.
