I. INTRODUCTION

By application 2502-AVWO-24-L, filed with the Connecticut Department of Transportation (hereinafter "Department") on February 25th, 2025, Kaybella Transportation, LLC (hereinafter "applicant") made application for two (2) additional motor vehicles in general livery service from a headquarters in Guilford, under the provisions of Connecticut General Statutes, Section 13b-103(a)(4).

Kaybella Transportation LLC is currently permitted and authorized to operate seven (7) motor vehicles, each having each having a seating capacity of ten (10) passengers or less, in general livery service from a headquarters in Guilford.

Kaybella Transportation LLC is currently permitted and authorized to operate four (4) motor vehicles, each having each having a seating capacity of eleven (11) passengers or less in elderly and handicapped livery service from a headquarters in Guilford.

Kaybella Transportation LLC is currently permitted and authorized to operate two (2) motor vehicles each having a seating capacity of eleven (11) passengers or less, for the provisions of transportation for hire by virtue of a contract with Medical Transportation Management, Inc. dba Veyo from a headquarters in Guilford.

II. DEPARTMENT ANALYSIS

1. The applicant has submitted the proper application before the Department.
2. It has been at least one calendar year since the applicant last applied for additional vehicles.
3. Department records indicate that all the existing vehicles authorized are registered and in use.
4. Department records further indicate that there are no outstanding violations or matters pending adjudication against the applicant.

III. CONCLUSION AND ORDER

Based on the above and pursuant to Section 13b-103(a), the application is hereby approved and therefore Livery Permit Number 3506 is amended and reissued as follows:

LIVERY PERMIT NUMBER 3506 **FOR THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES IN LIVERY SERVICE**

Kaybella Transportation LLC is hereby permitted and authorized to operate NINE (9) motor vehicles, each having each having a seating capacity of eleven (11) passengers or less, in general livery service to all points in Connecticut from a headquarters in Guilford.

Kaybella Transportation LLC is also permitted and authorized to operate four (4) motor vehicles, each having each having a seating capacity of eleven (11) passengers or less in elderly and handicapped livery service to all points in Connecticut from a headquarters in Guilford.

RESTRICTIONS:

This permit may not be sold or transferred until it has been operational, i.e., a vehicle registered with livery plates thereunder, for not less than twenty-four (24) consecutive months from the date of this final decision. If at any time during the twenty-four (24) month period the applicant enters into a contract for sale and transfer of any of the vehicles authorized under application 2502-AVWO-24-L, the authority granted herein will be revoked.

This permit shall remain in effect until it is amended, suspended, or revoked by the Department. Failure of the permit holder to maintain proper insurance and/or to comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other State statutes and/or the rules, regulations, and orders of the Department, shall be considered sufficient cause to amend, suspend, or revoke this permit. This permit is transferrable only with the approval of the Department. **Vehicles authorized herein must be registered within thirty (30) days of the date of this decision.**

Kaybella Transportation, LLC is authorized to operate two (2) motor vehicles, each having a seating capacity of eleven (11) adults or less, for the provision of transportation for hire by virtue of a contract with Medical Transportation Management, Inc. dba Veyo from a headquarters in Guilford.

RESTRICTIONS:

The applicant must submit an executed contract with Medical Transportation Management, Inc. dba Veyo within sixty (60) days of the date of this final decision or the authority contained herein will be automatically revoked. This decision constitutes notice pursuant to Connecticut General Statute Section 4-182.

The applicant must register and insure all of the motor vehicles granted in this docket within sixty (60) days from the date of this final decision. Any vehicles not registered or insured within the sixty (60) day period will be revoked automatically.

The authority for the two (2) vehicles granted in Docket No. 1502-NGOV-15-L, shall be durational in nature and shall exist only for the period of time that the permit holder has a current and continuing contract in effect for the provision of service with the Medical Transportation Management, Inc. dba Veyo.

The permit holder shall notify the Department of any termination of its contract with Medical Transportation Management, Inc. dba Veyo or the cessation of the active provision of service thereunder. The permit holder shall file with the Department on an annual basis, upon registration or re-registration of the motor vehicles authorized in this decision, a current, executed copy of the extension of said contract. Failure to file an extension of the contract, or a new executed contract shall void the authority for the vehicles authorized pursuant to this contract.

This permit is not transferable and shall remain in effect until revoked by the Department or until the contract under which this authority is granted has expired. Failure of the permit holder to maintain

proper insurance and/or comply with all pertinent motor vehicle laws and other State statutes and/or rules, regulations and orders of the department shall be considered sufficient cause to amend, suspend or revoke said permit.
