Dear CVP/CVFA providers,

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) has informed the Connecticut Department of Public Health (DPH) that due to federal holidays in mid-June and early July, as well as the planned VTrckS (Vaccine Tracking System) downtime, there may be a longer-than-normal delivery times for vaccine orders placed in late June/early July. As a result, for deliveries needed in early July, CDC recommends placing orders, in CT WiZ, no later than June 20, 2025.

Key dates

- Thursday, June 19 Juneteenth holiday. No vaccine delivery.
- Wednesday, June 25, from 9 p.m. ET to Monday, June 30, at 8 a.m. ET VTrckS will be down.
 - Orders can continue to be placed in CT WiZ but will not be uploaded to VTrckS.
 - All orders placed during this downtime will be placed on Monday, June 30 at 8 a.m.
- Friday, July 4 Independence Day holiday. No vaccine delivery.

In addition, with the upcoming holidays, please ensure your delivery hours in CT WiZ accurately reflect when your clinic is open.
