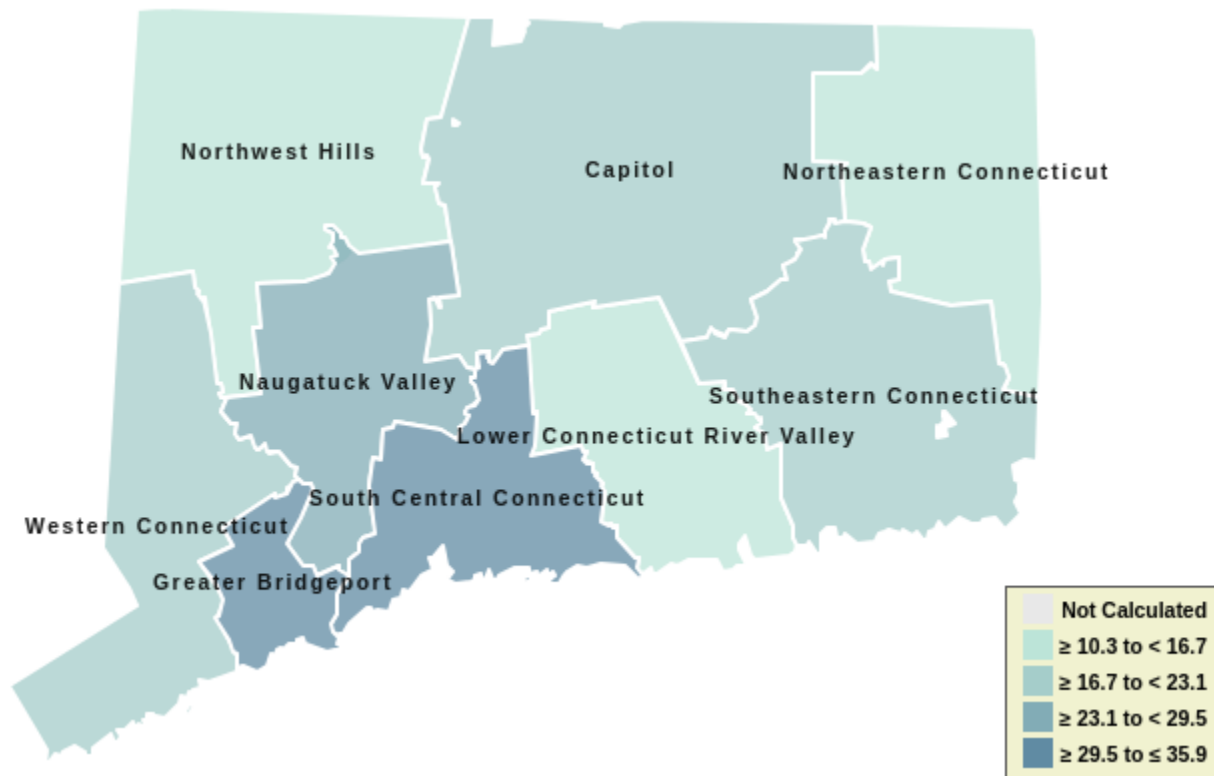

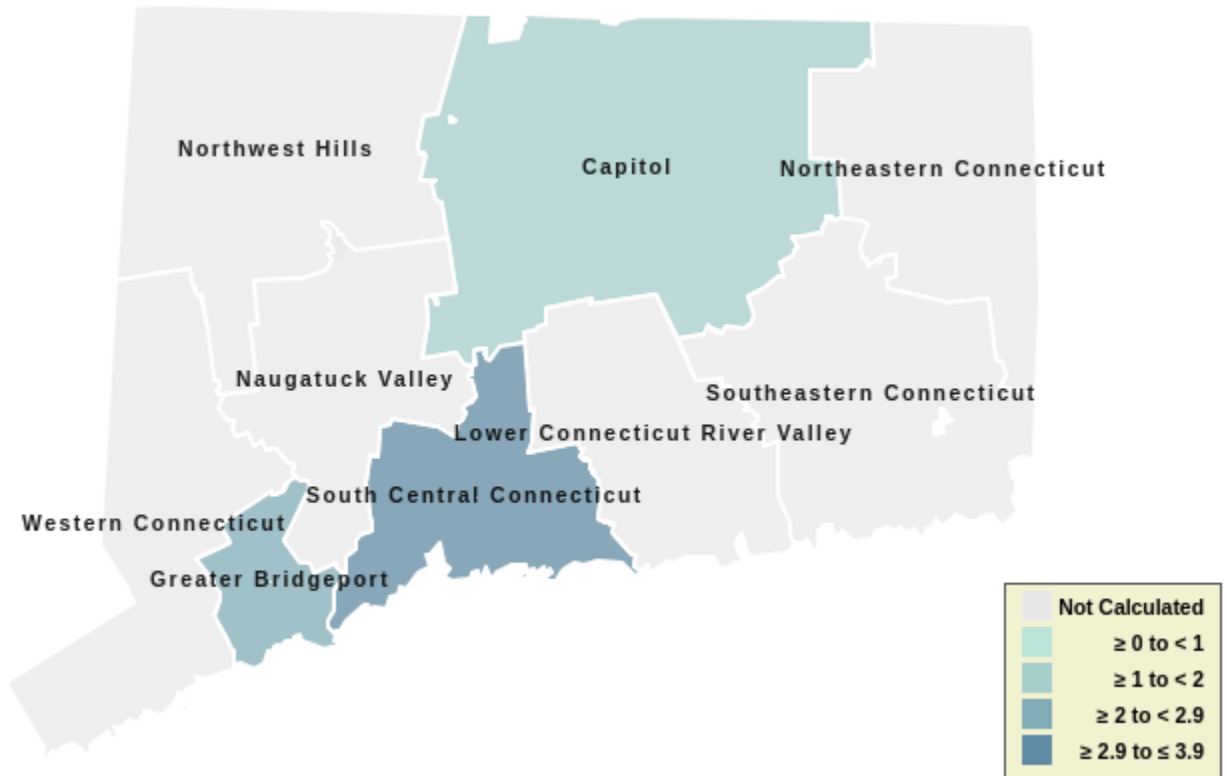

Rates of Gunshot in Connecticut per 100,000 Population, July 1, 2024 - December 31, 2024

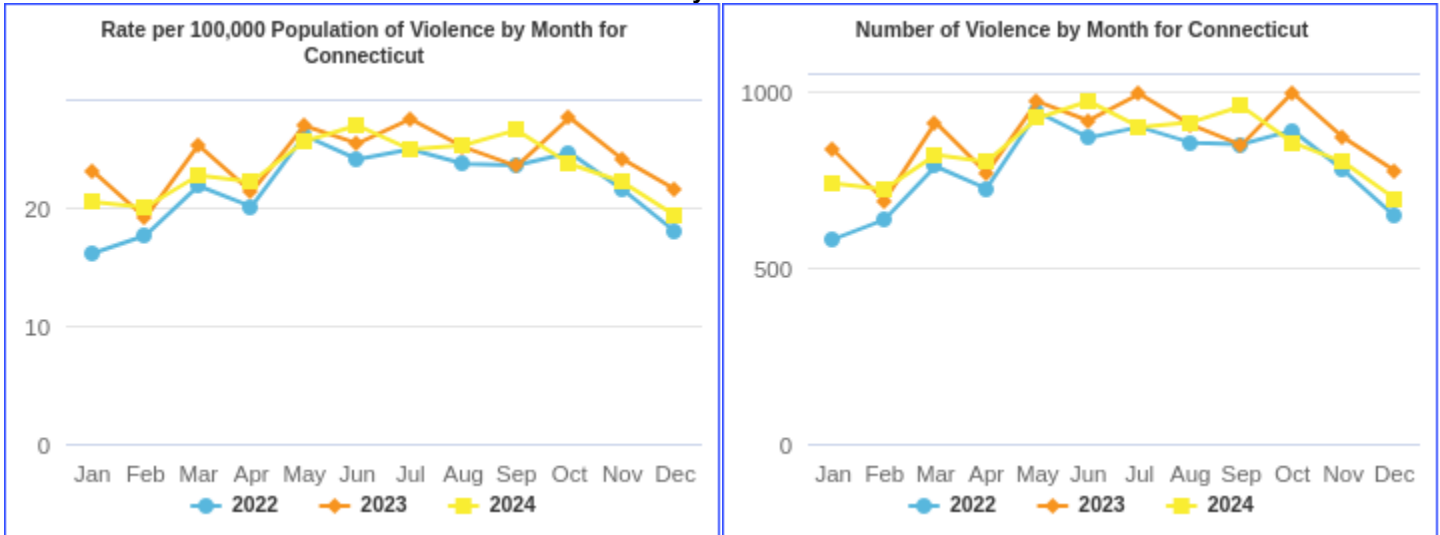

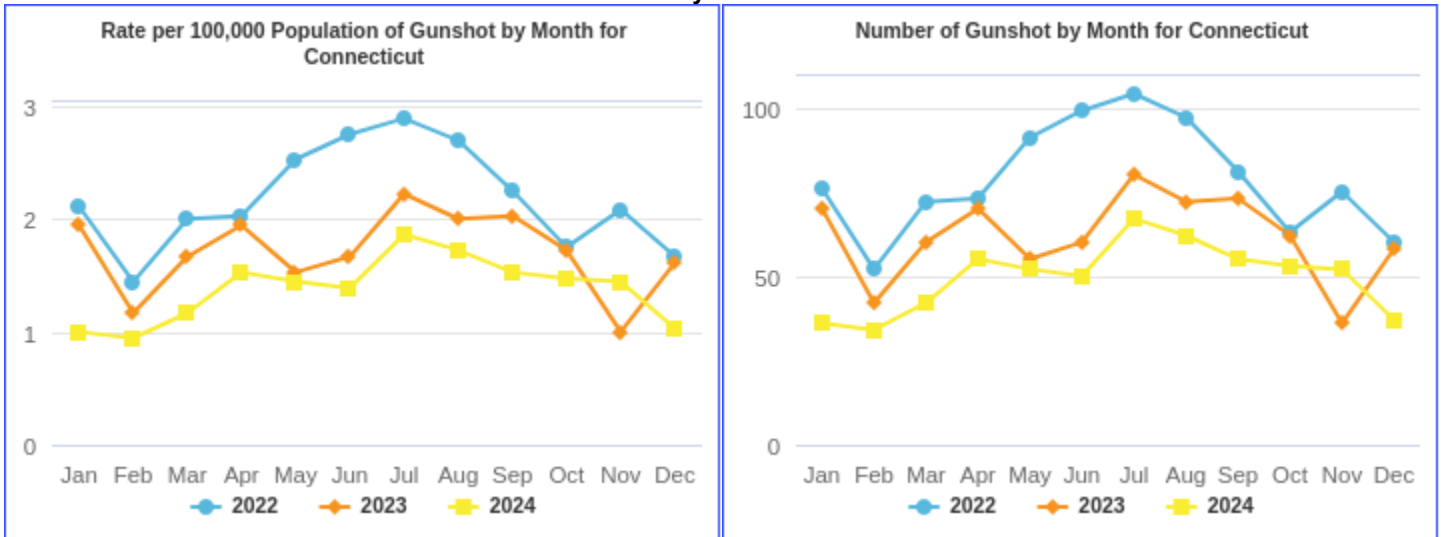

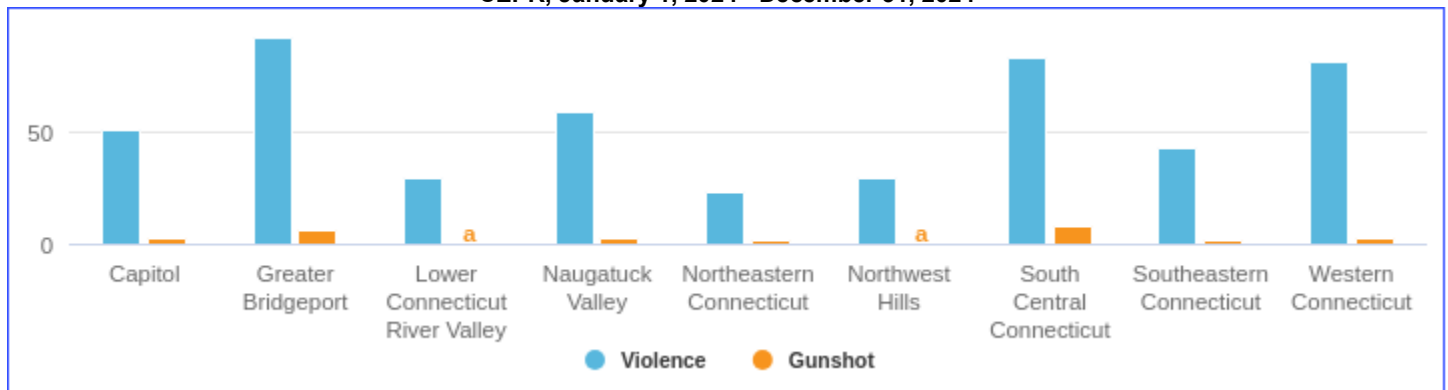

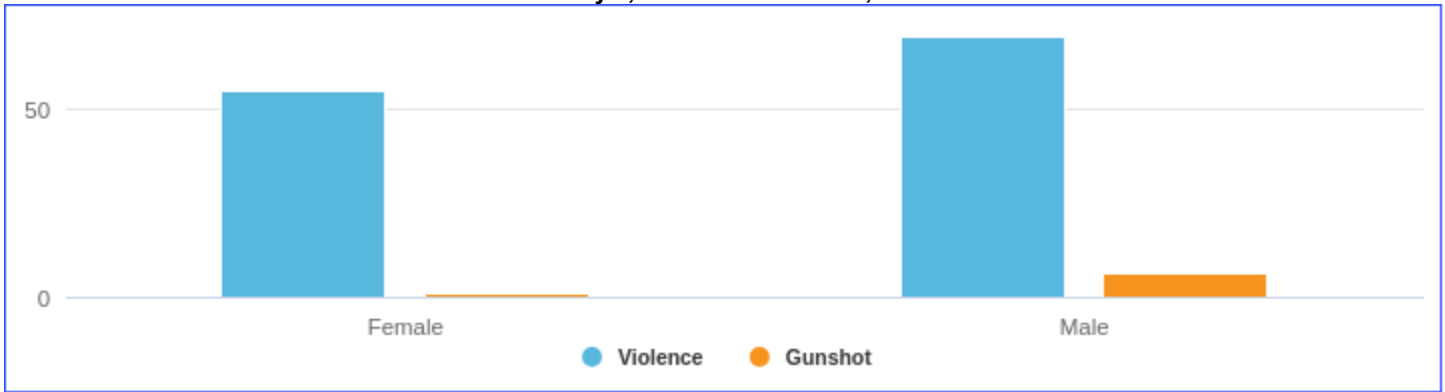

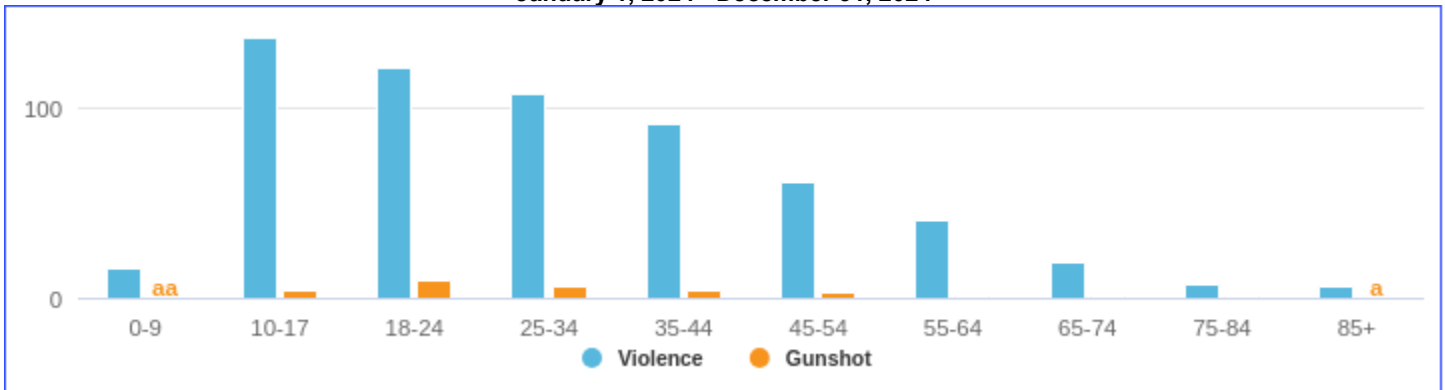

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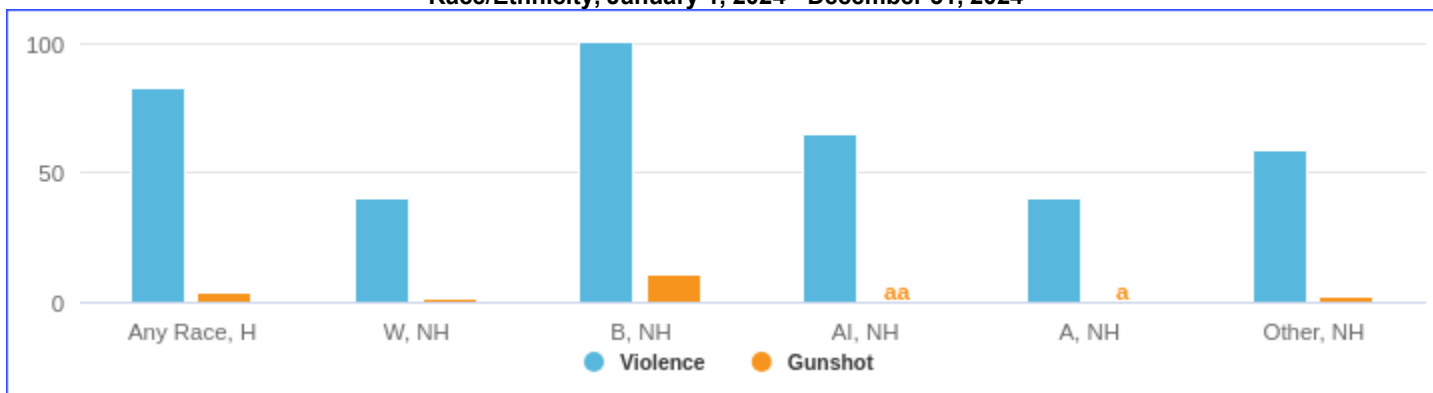

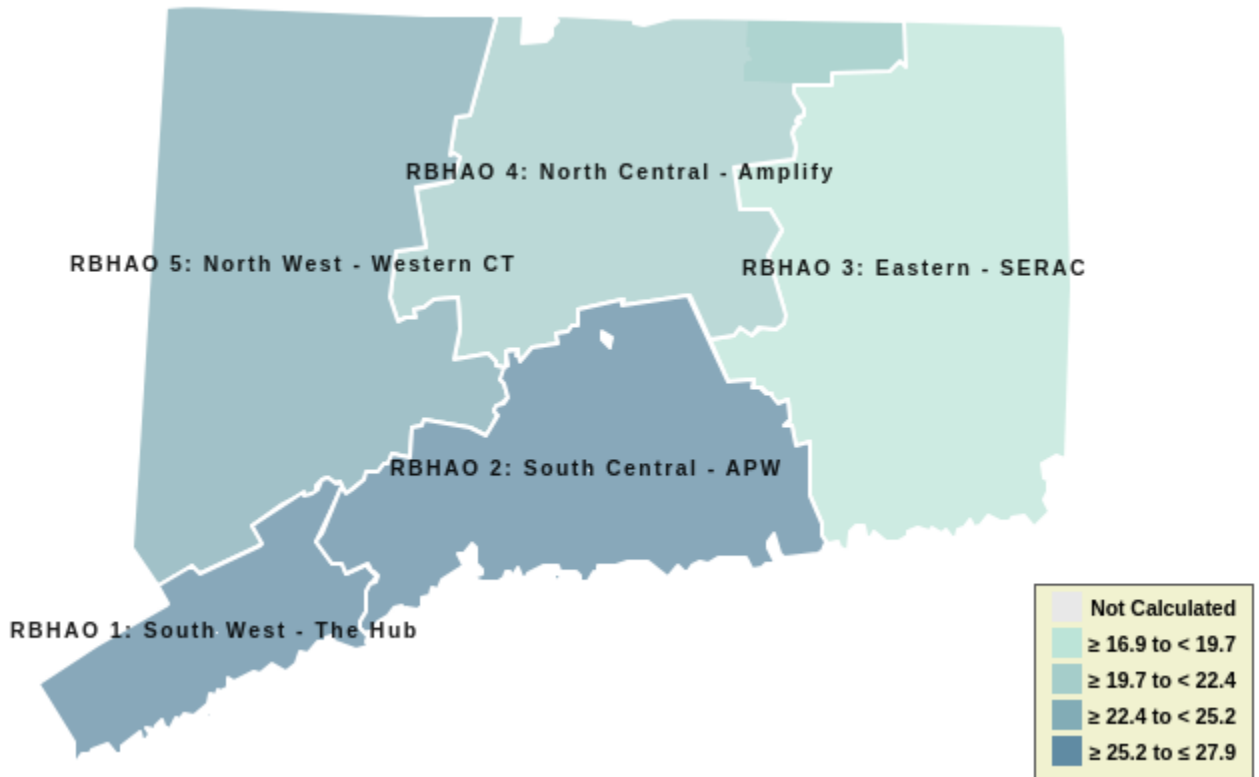

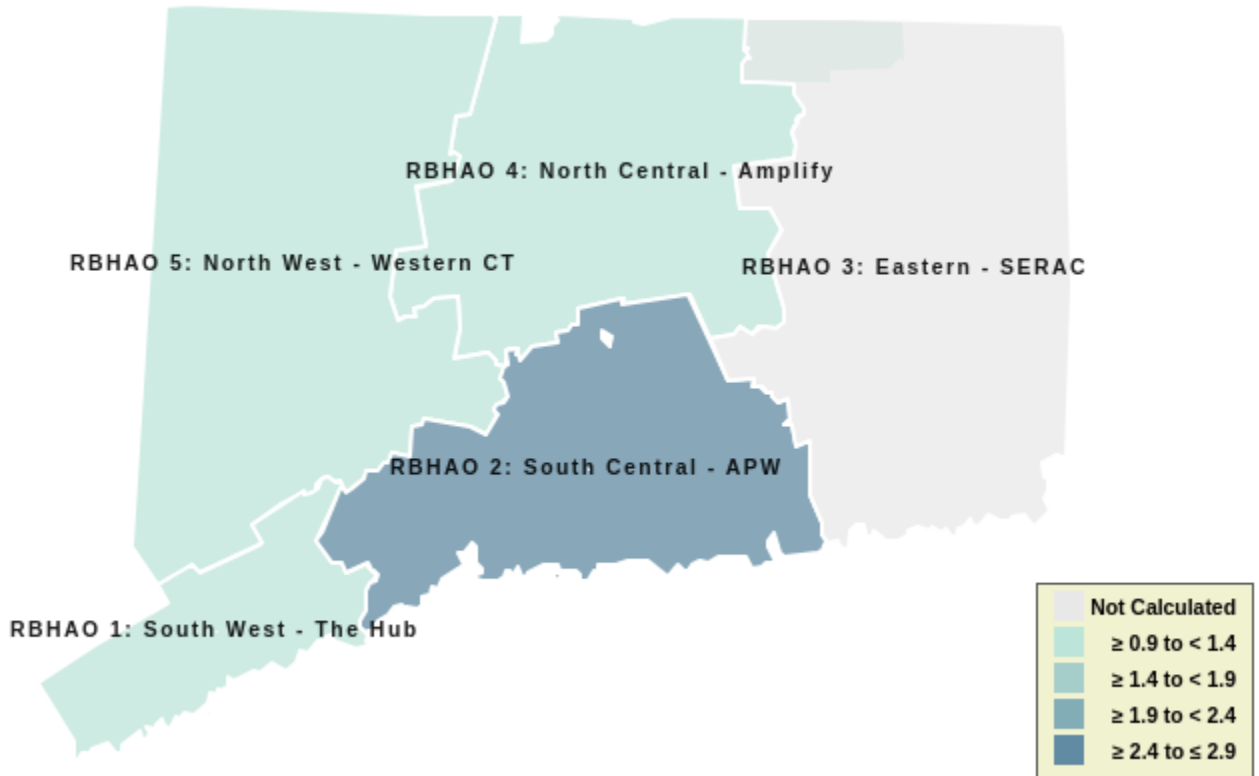

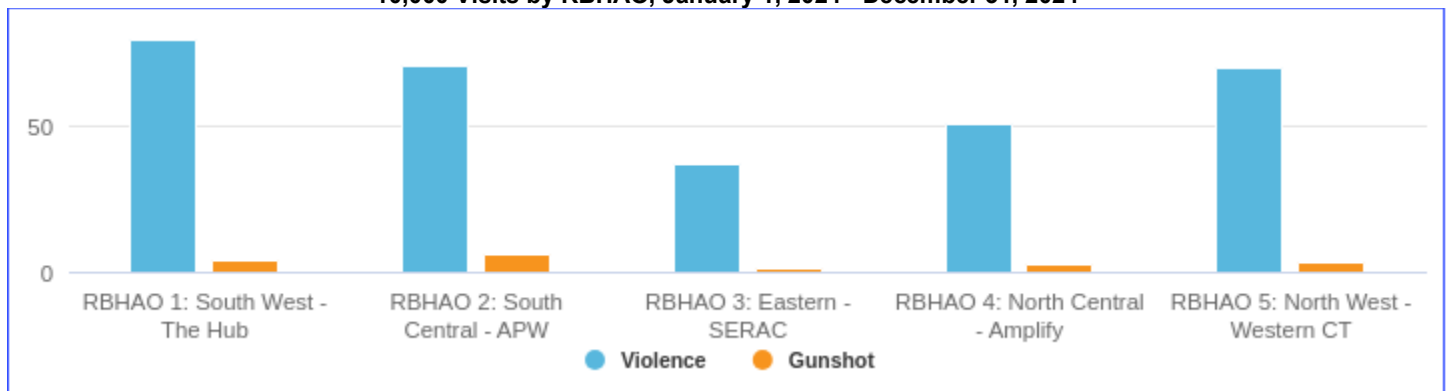

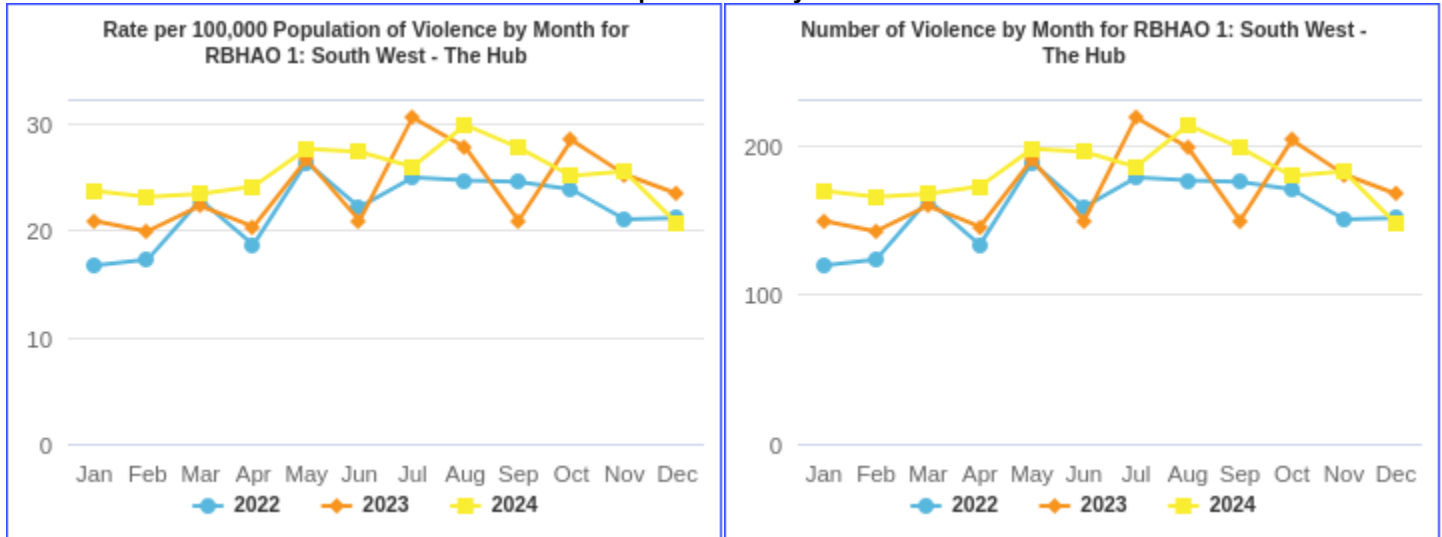

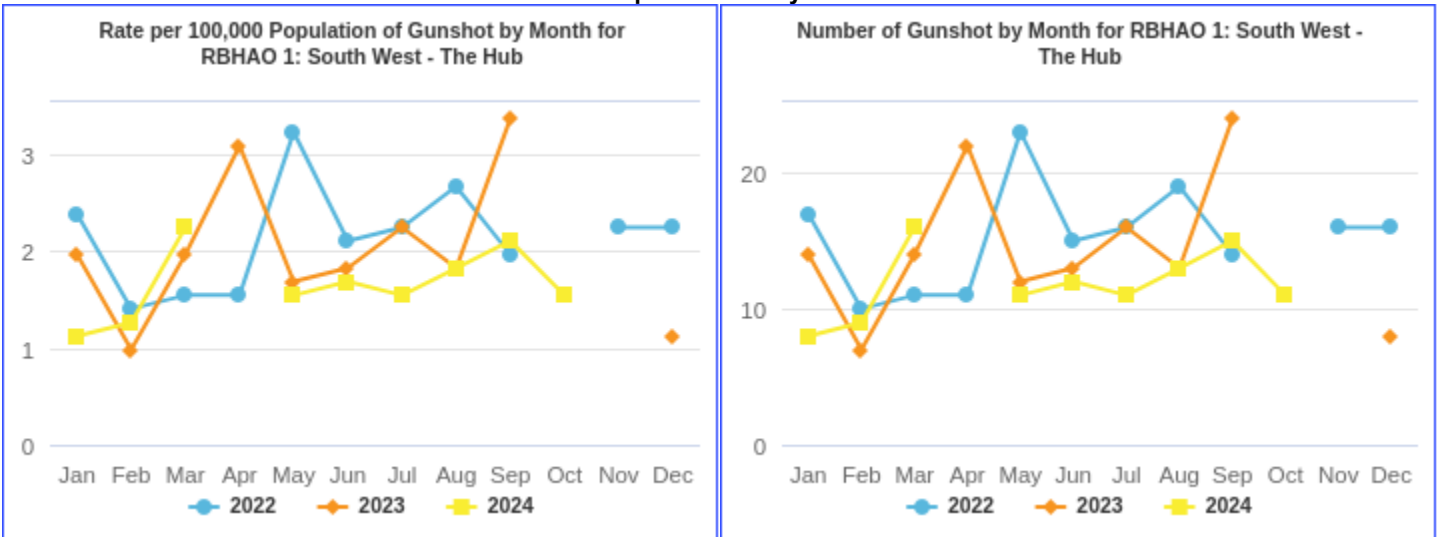

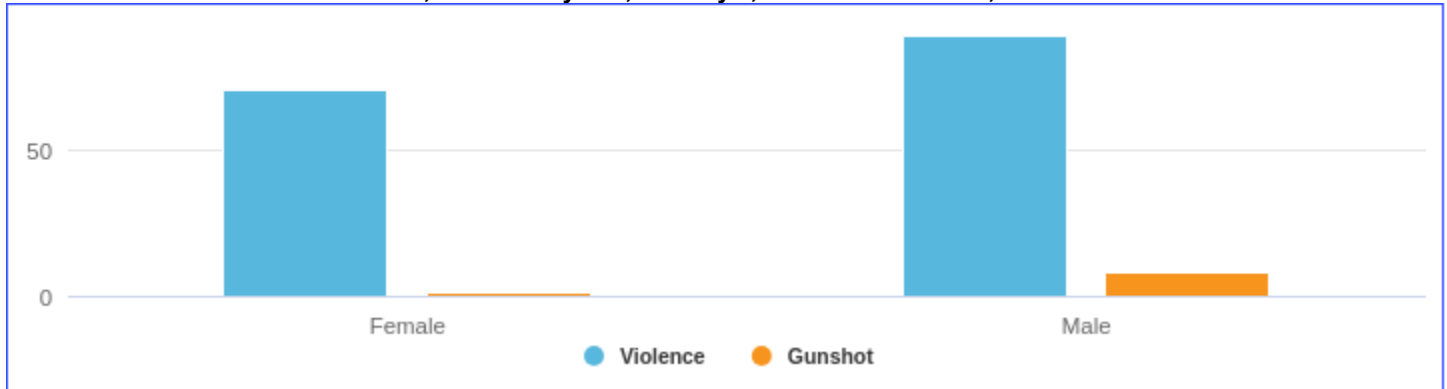

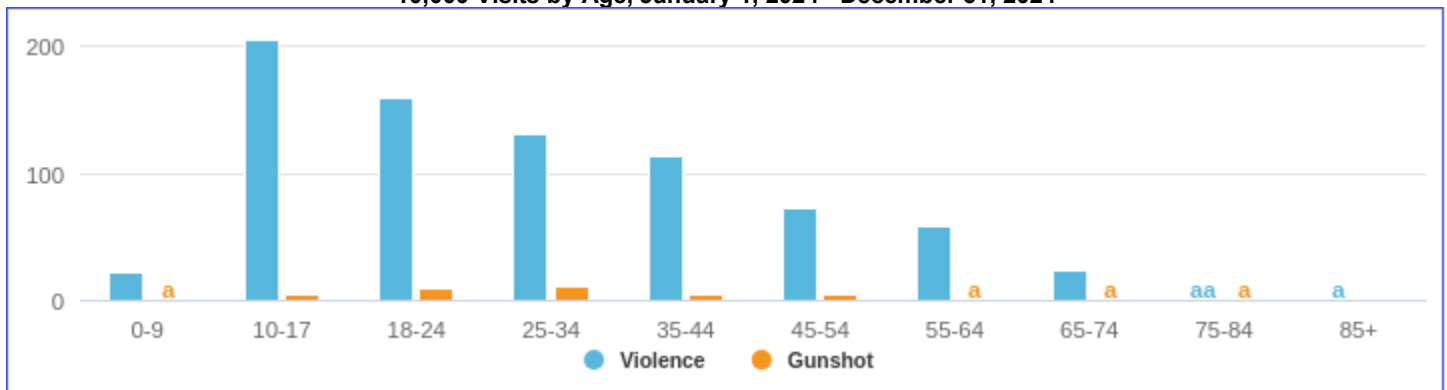

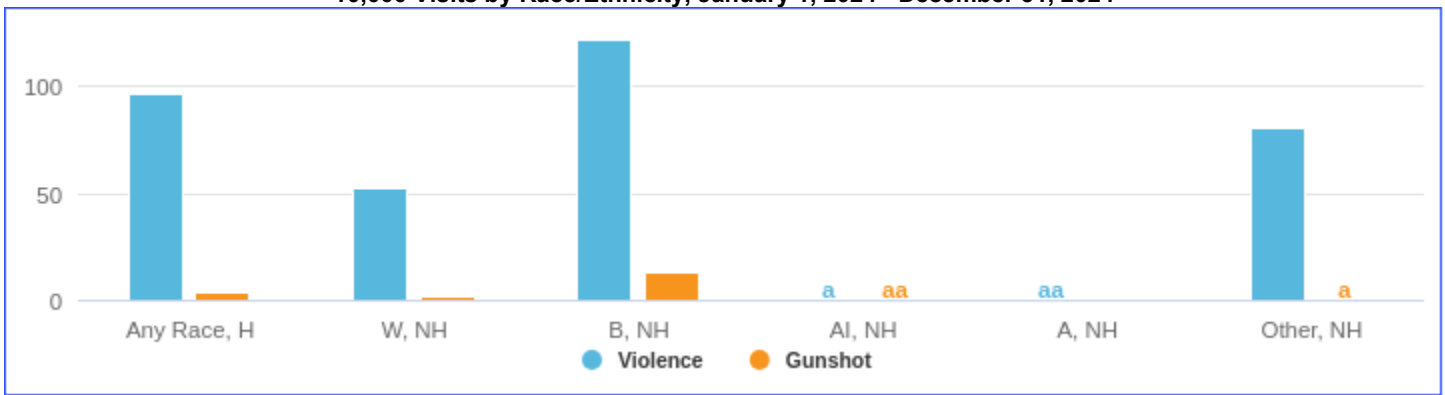

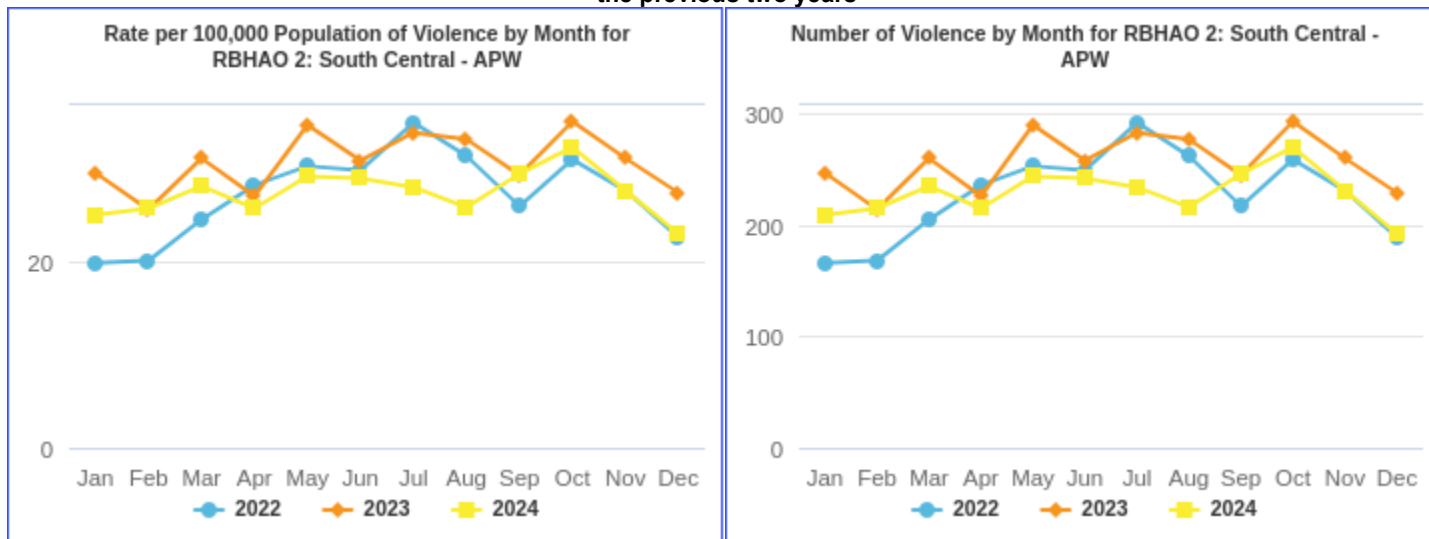

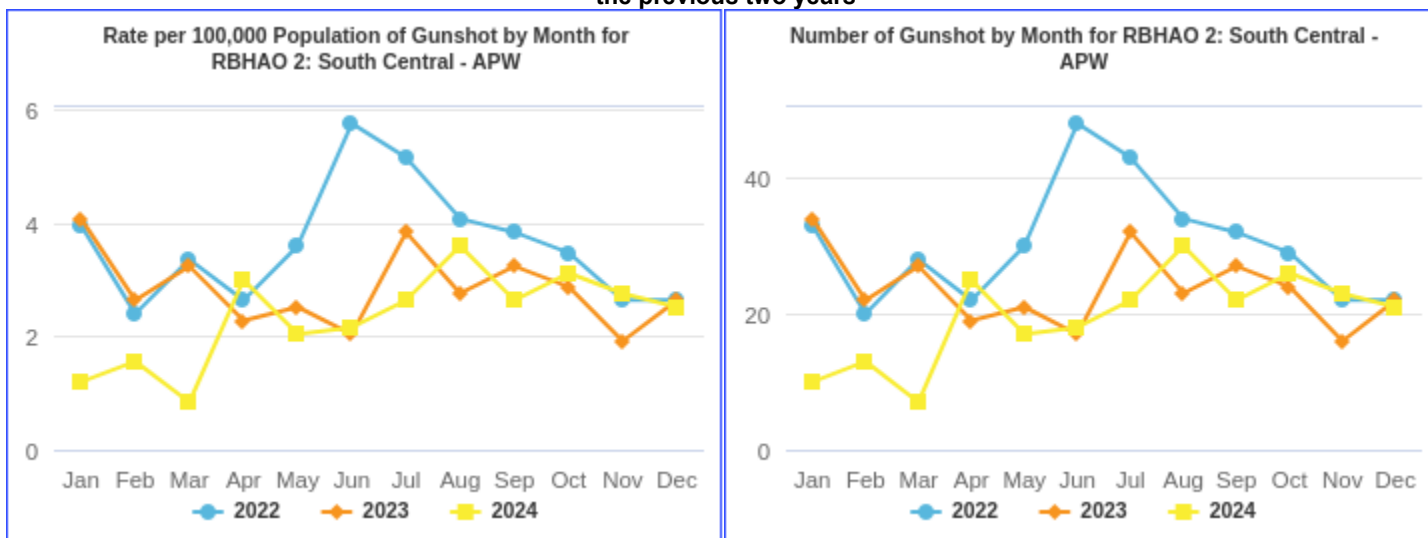

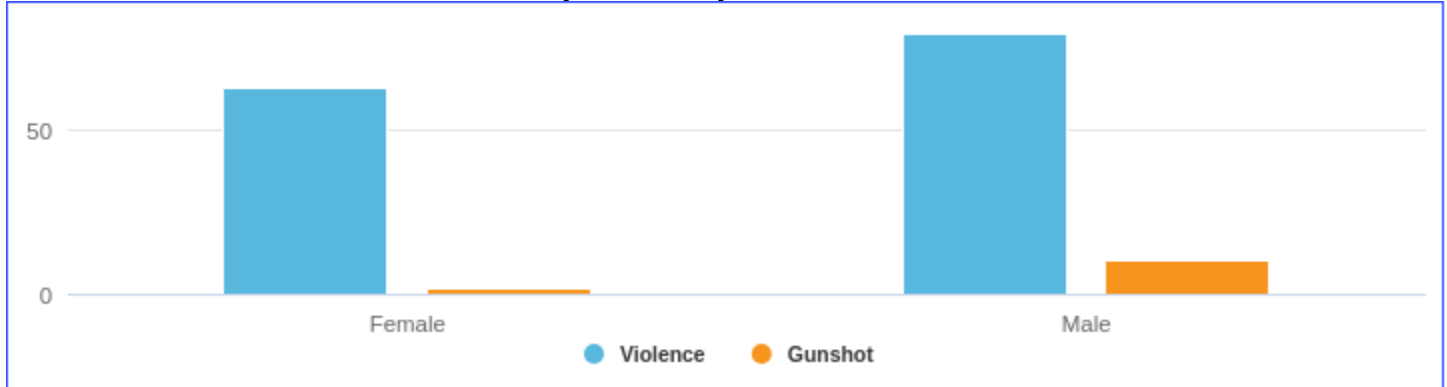

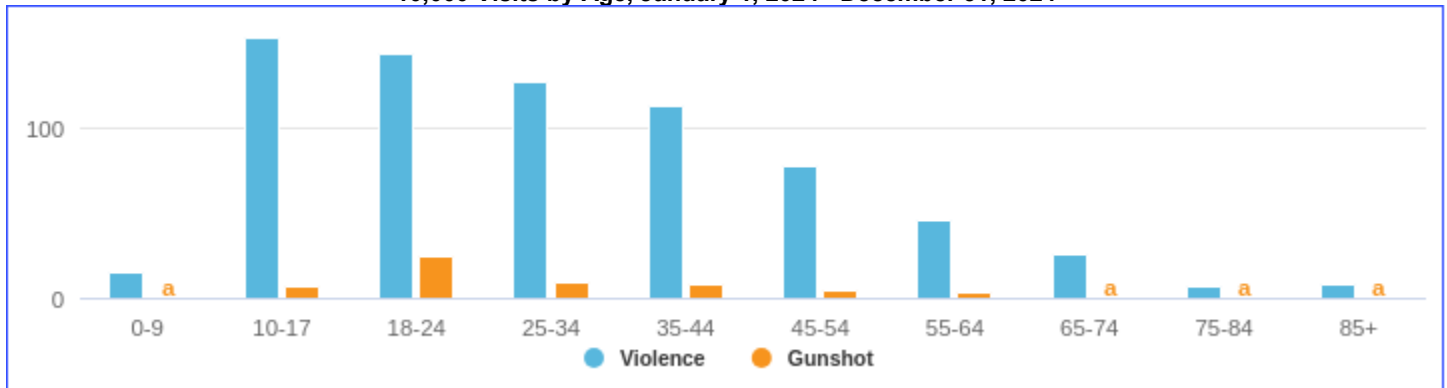

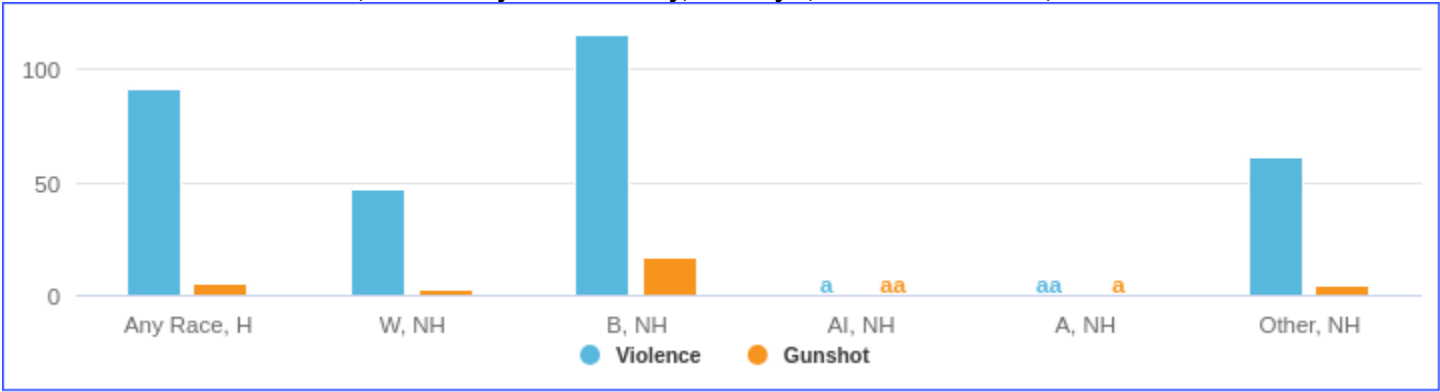

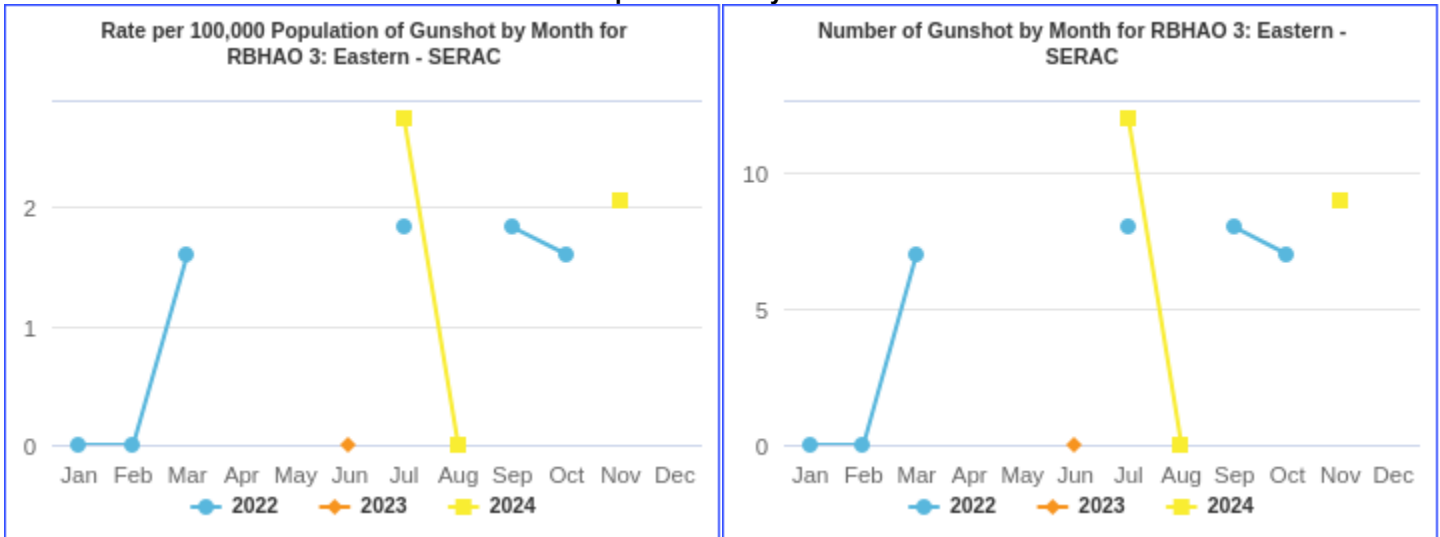

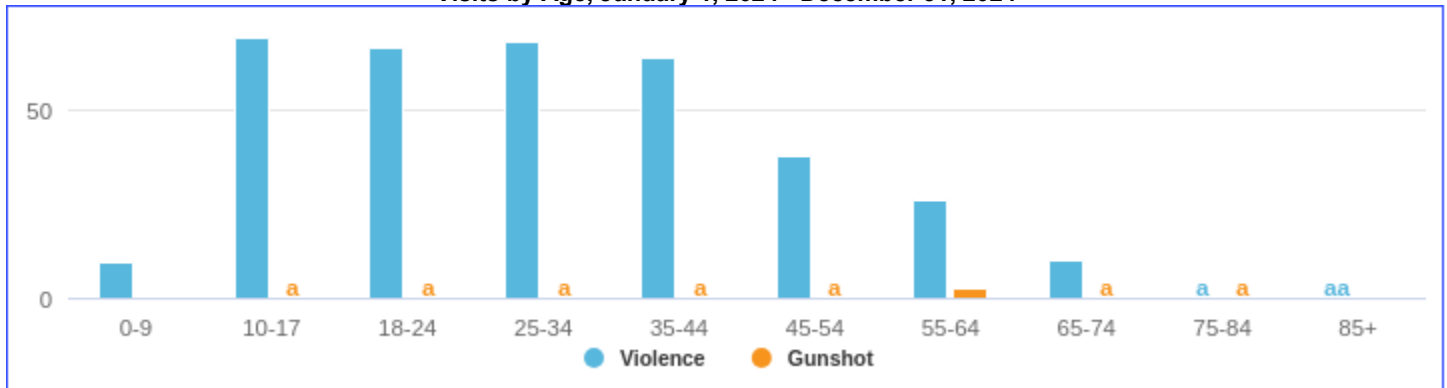

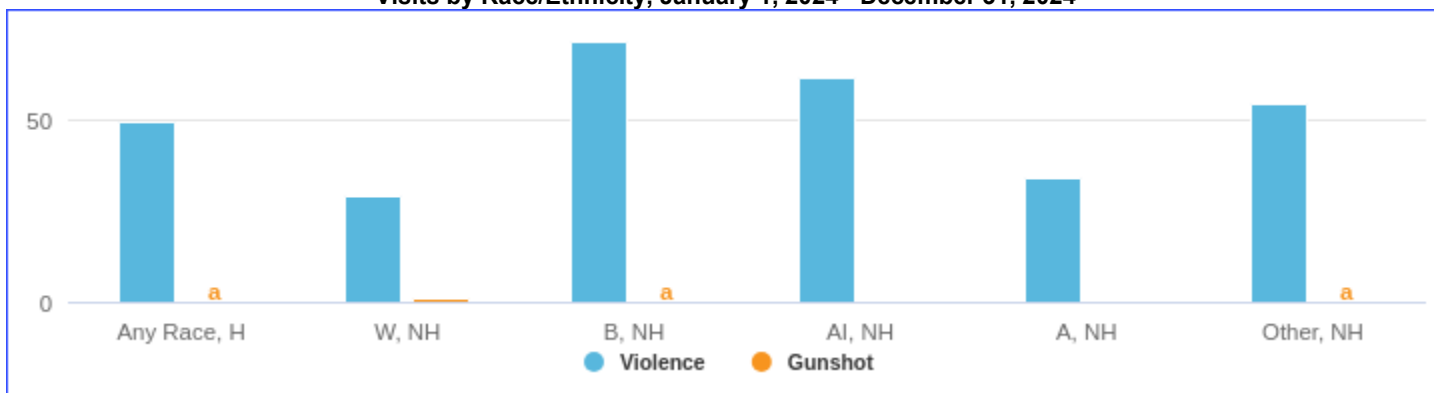

**Gunshot in RBHAO 4: North Central - Amplify, January 1, 2024 - December 31, 2024, compared to the corresponding months of the previous two years**

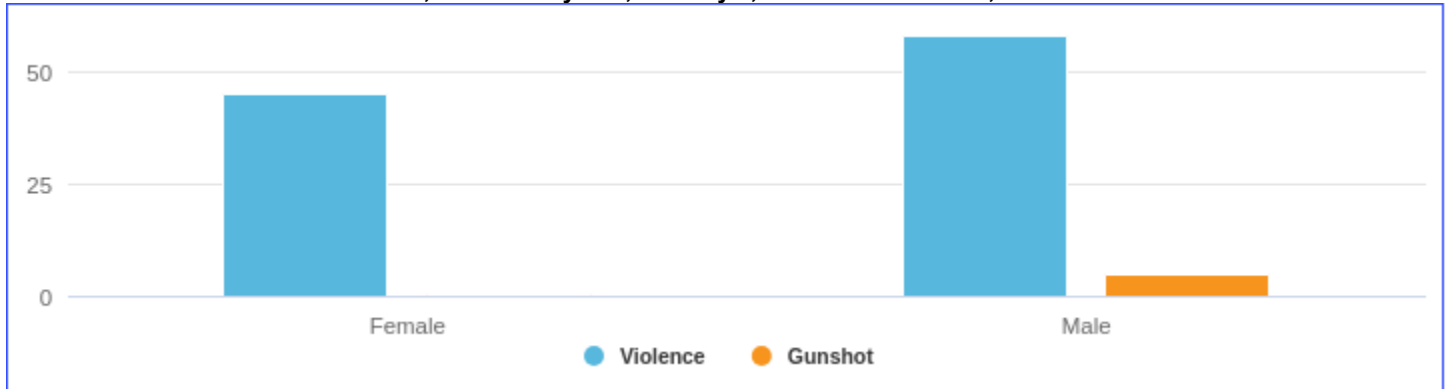

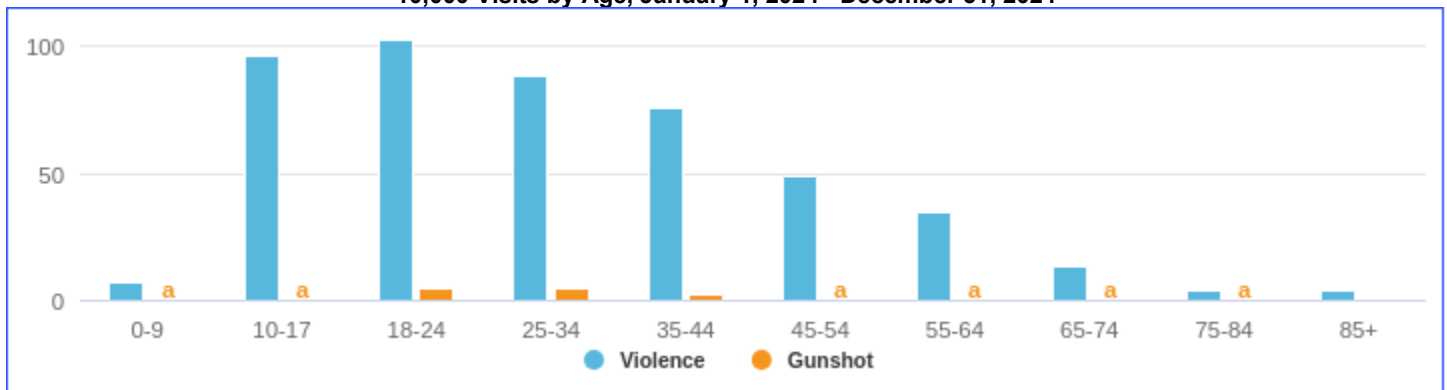

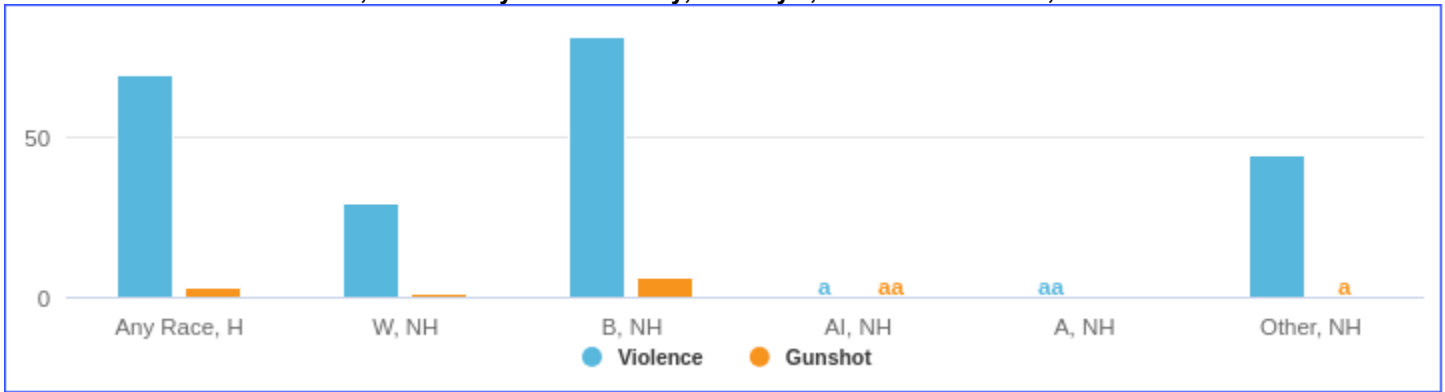

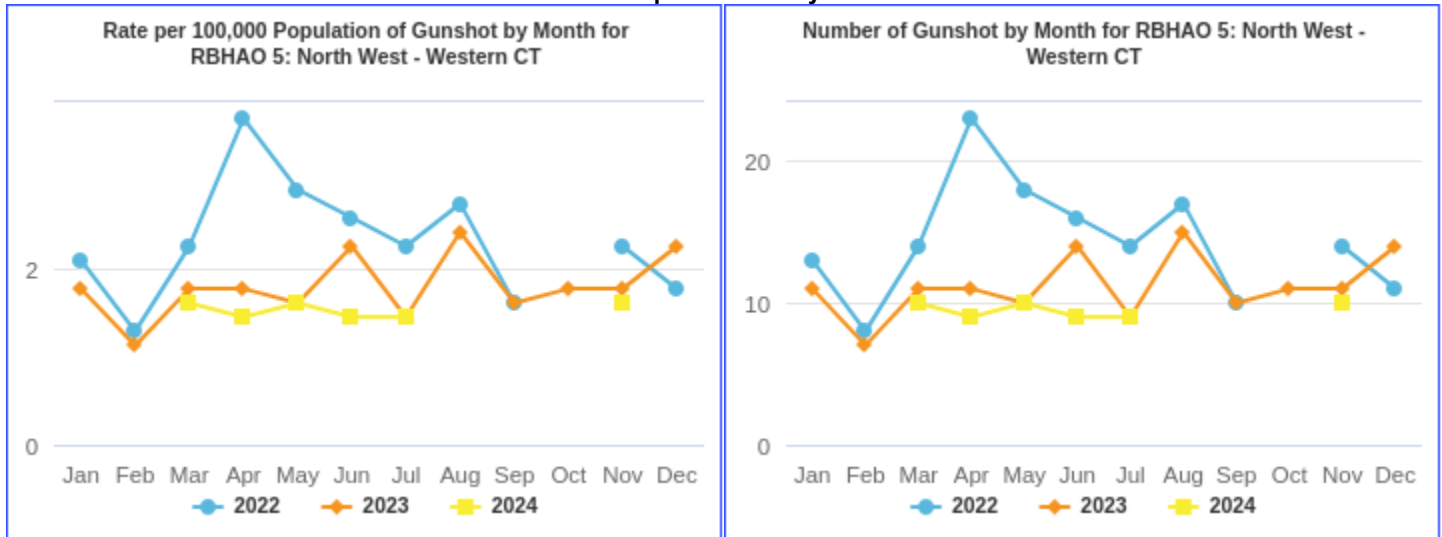

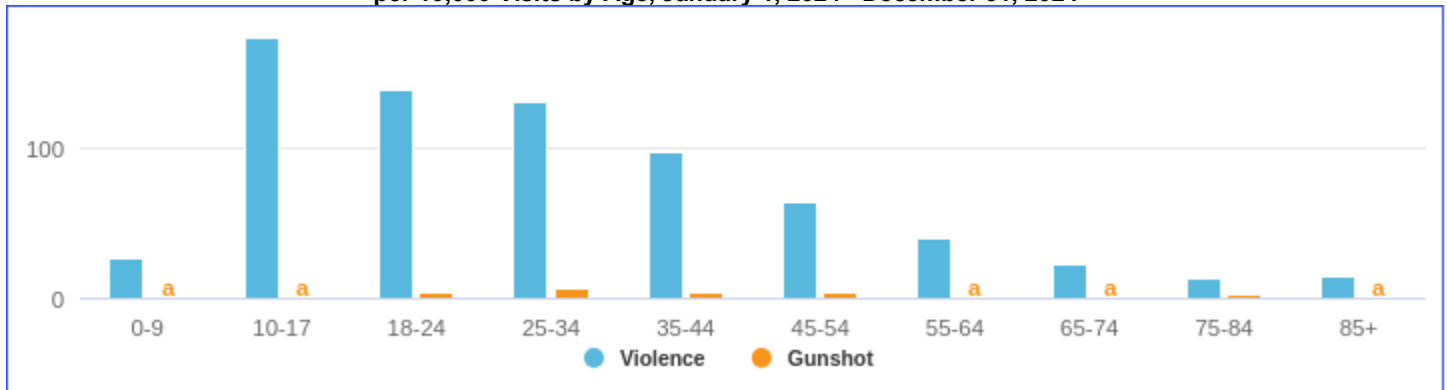

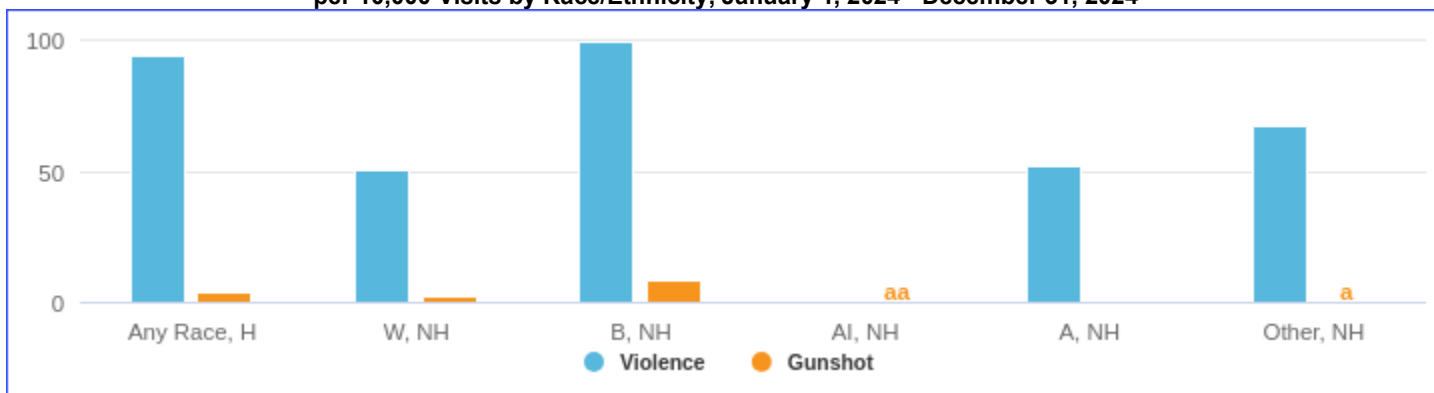

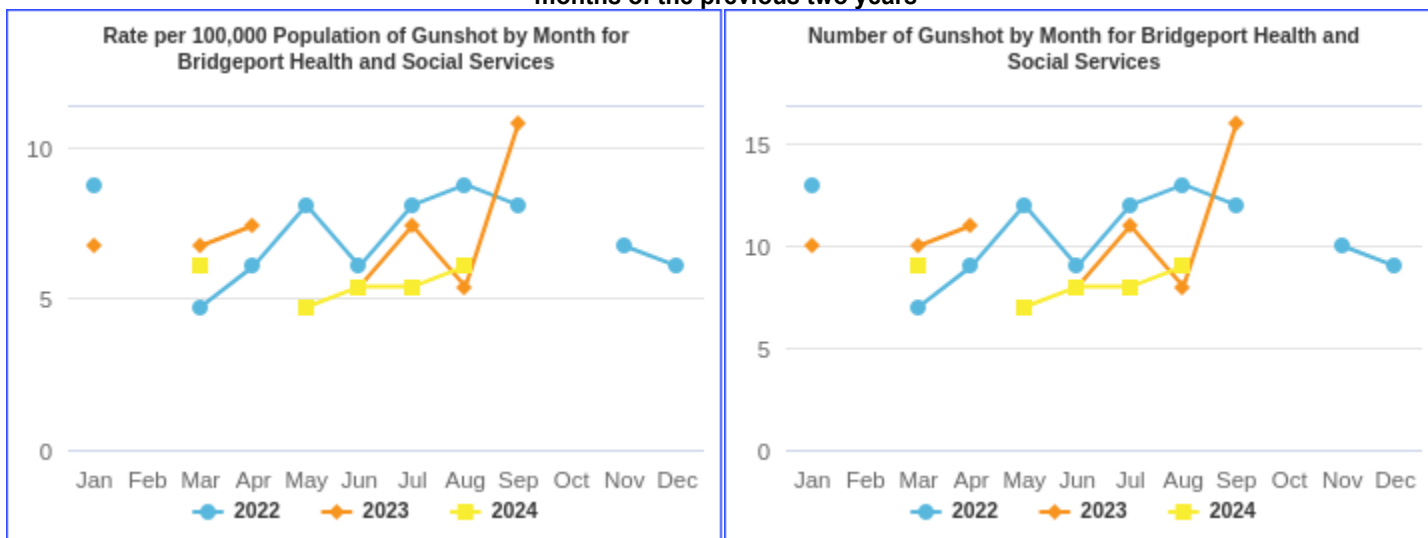

**Gunshot in Bridgeport Health and Social Services, January 1, 2024 - December 31, 2024, compared to the corresponding months of the previous two years**

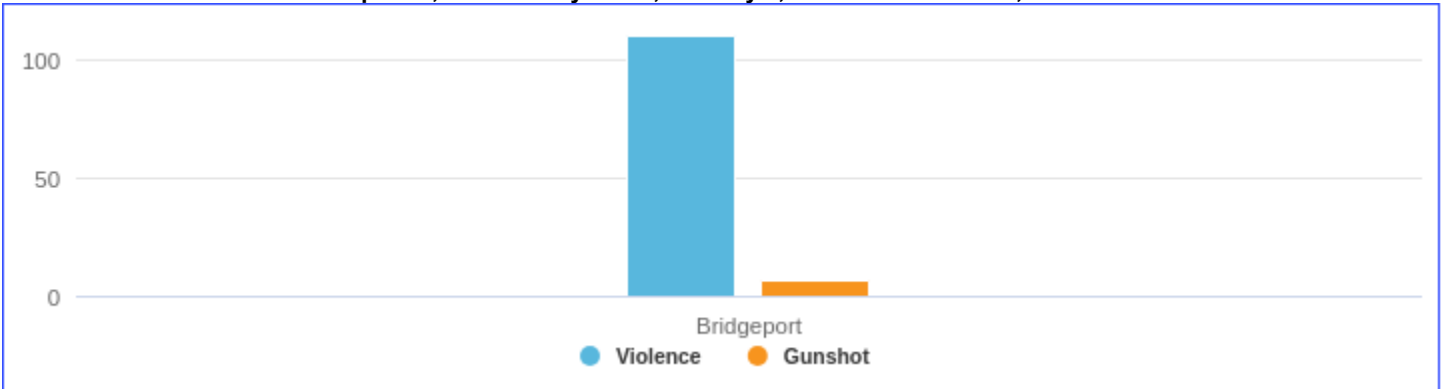

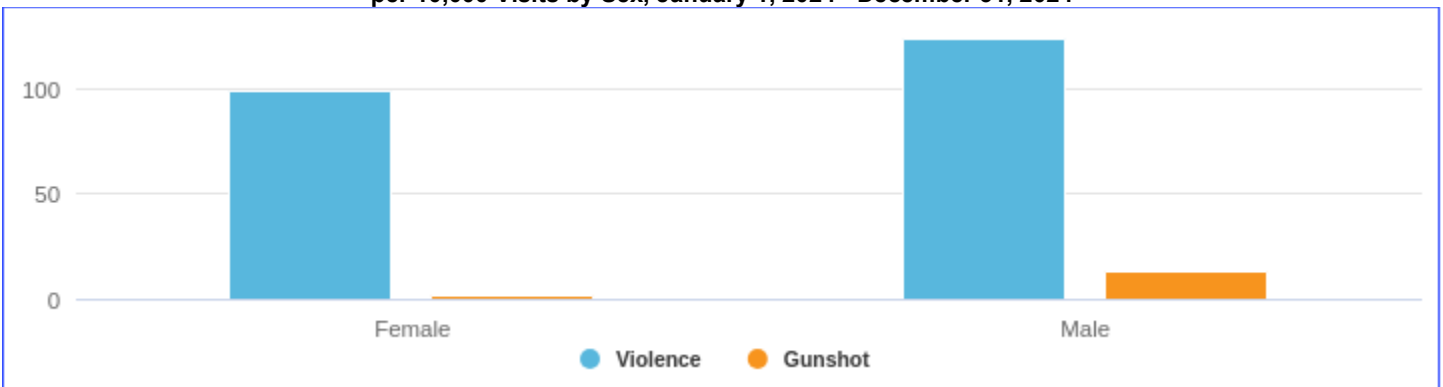

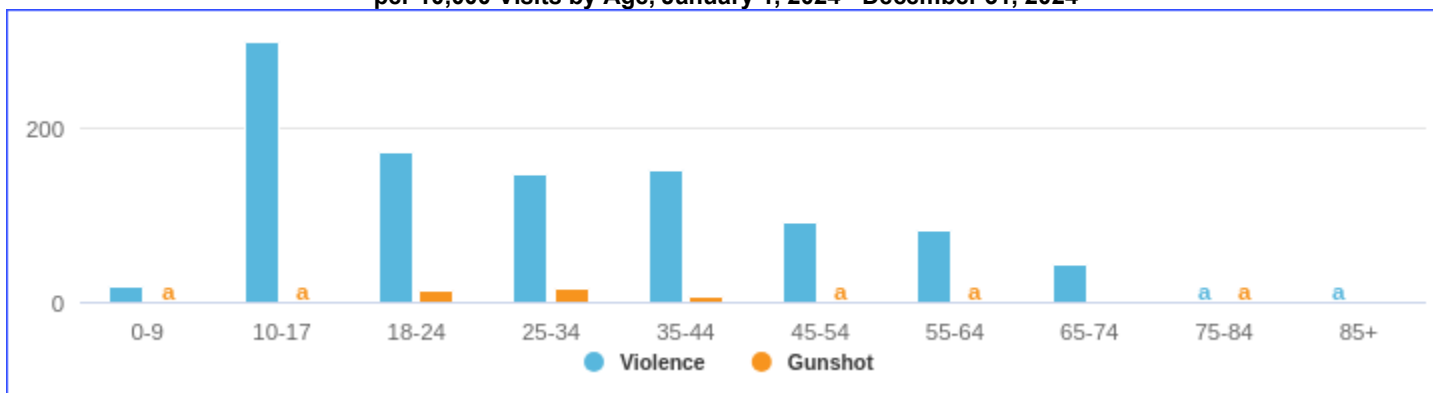

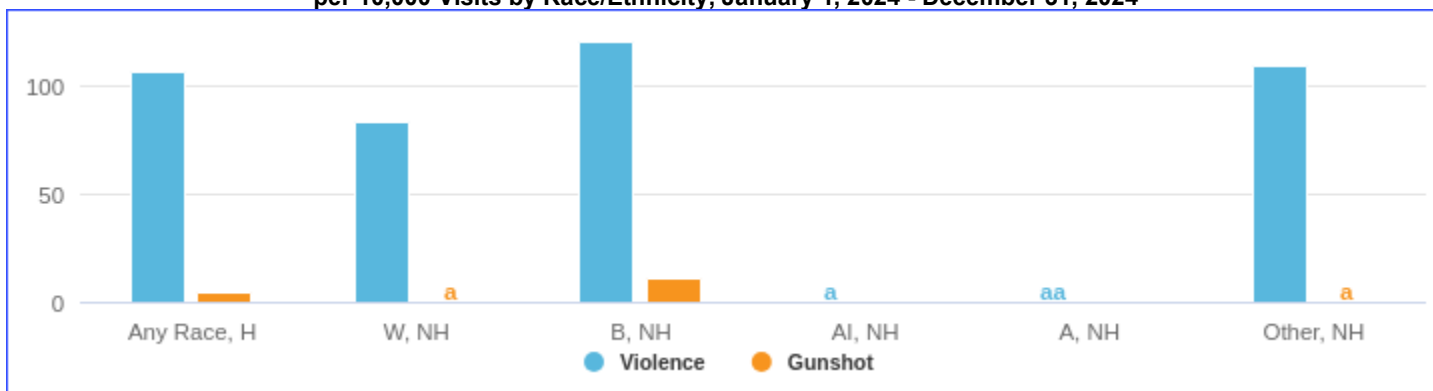

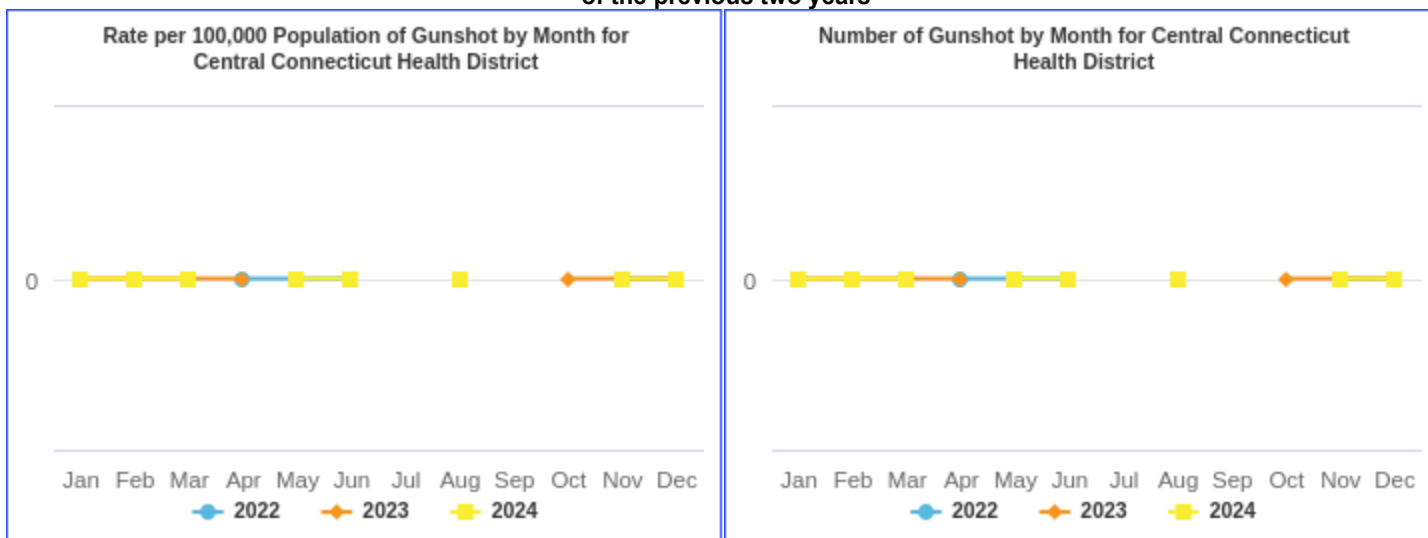

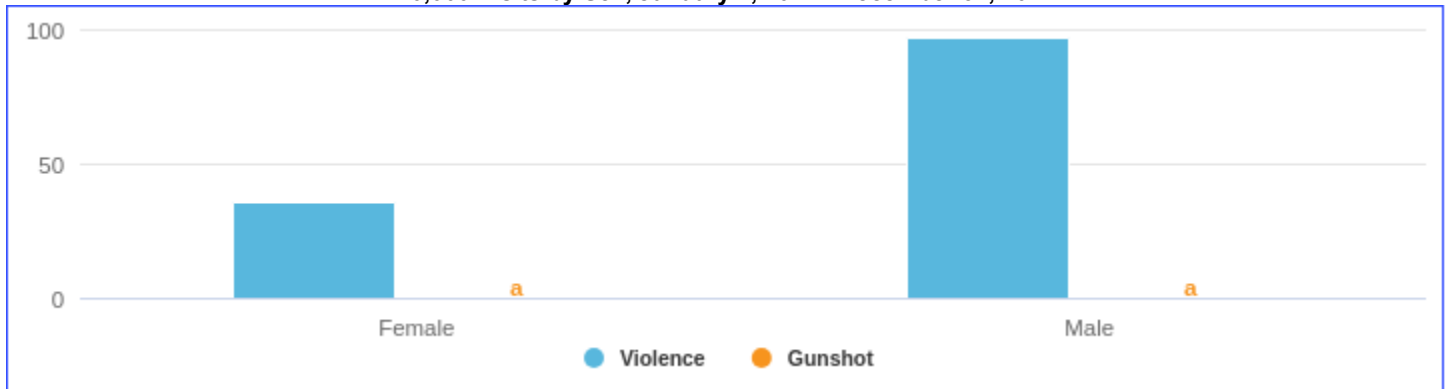

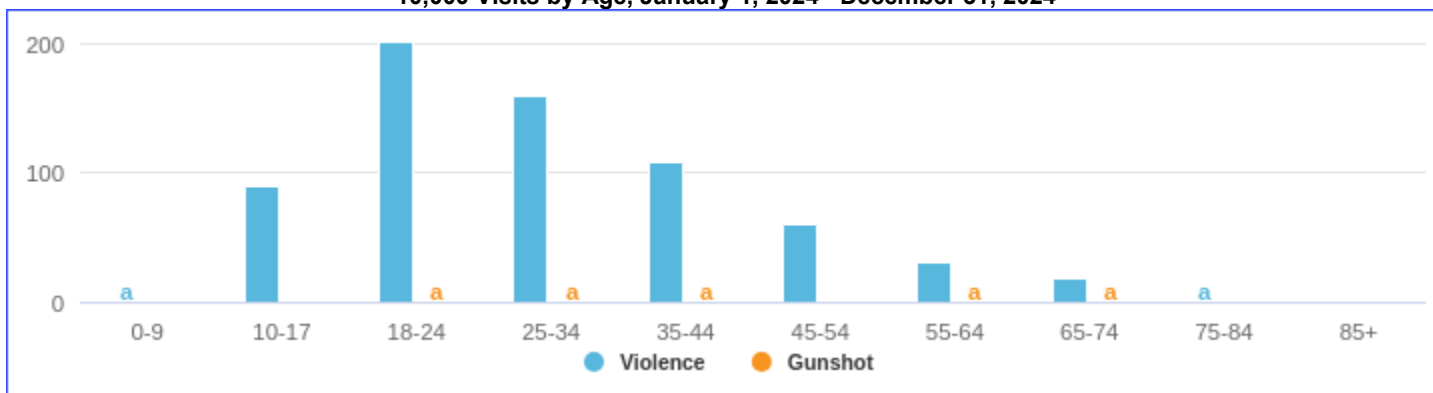

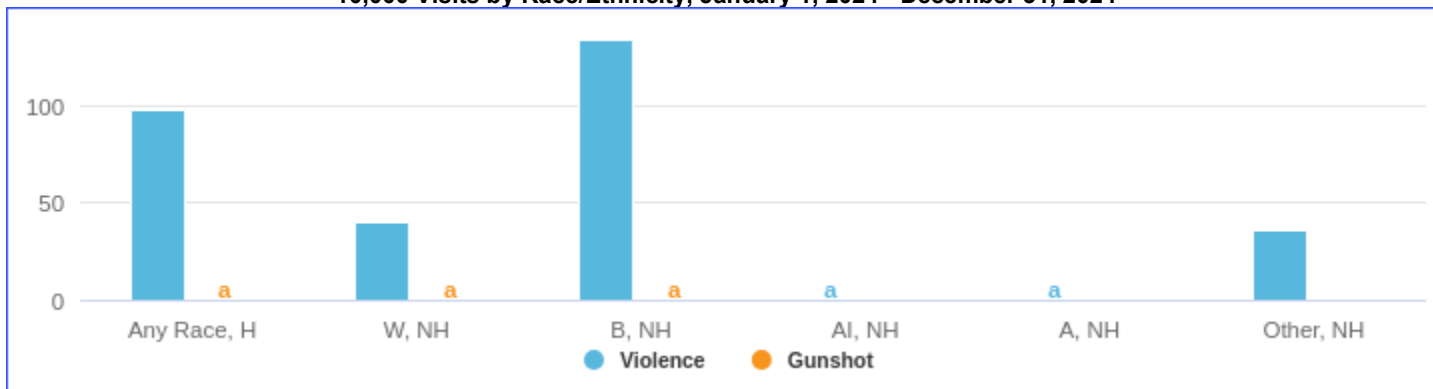

**Gunshot in Danbury Health and Human Services, January 1, 2024 - December 31, 2024, compared to the corresponding months of the previous two years**

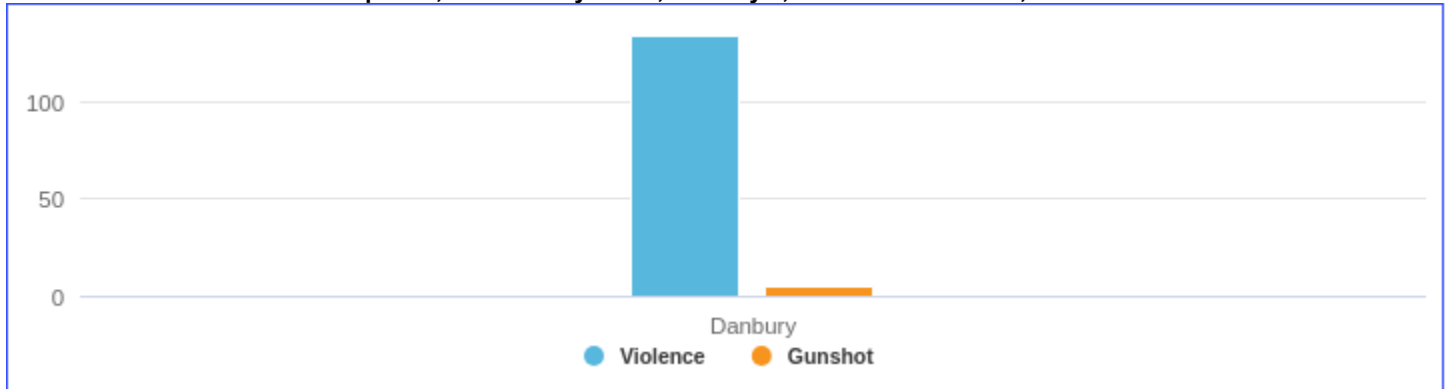

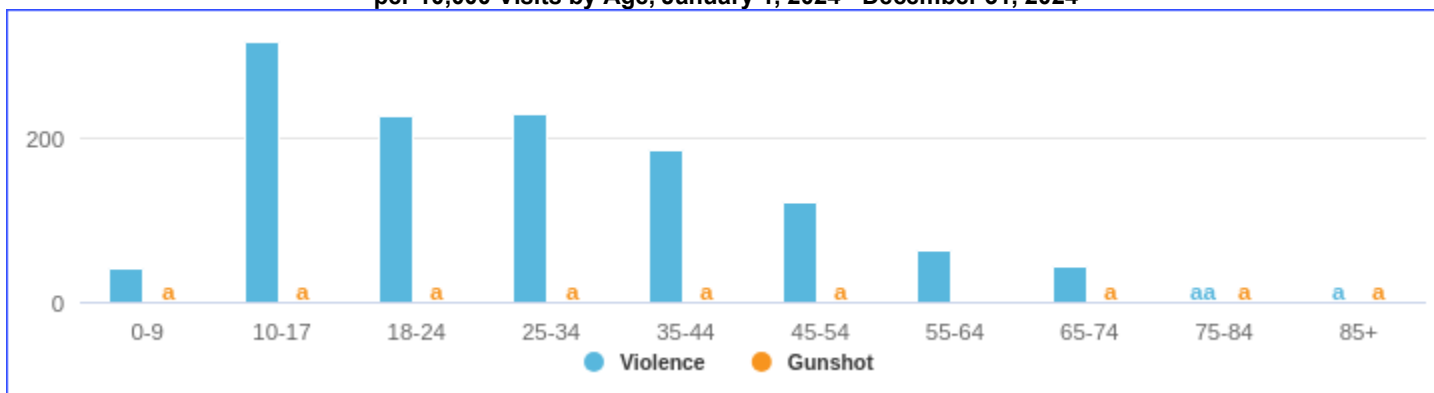

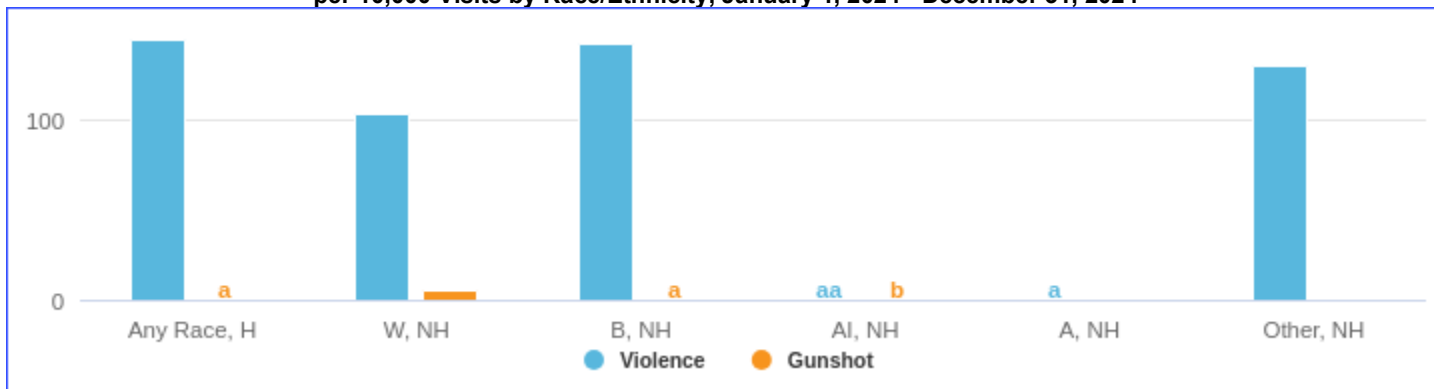

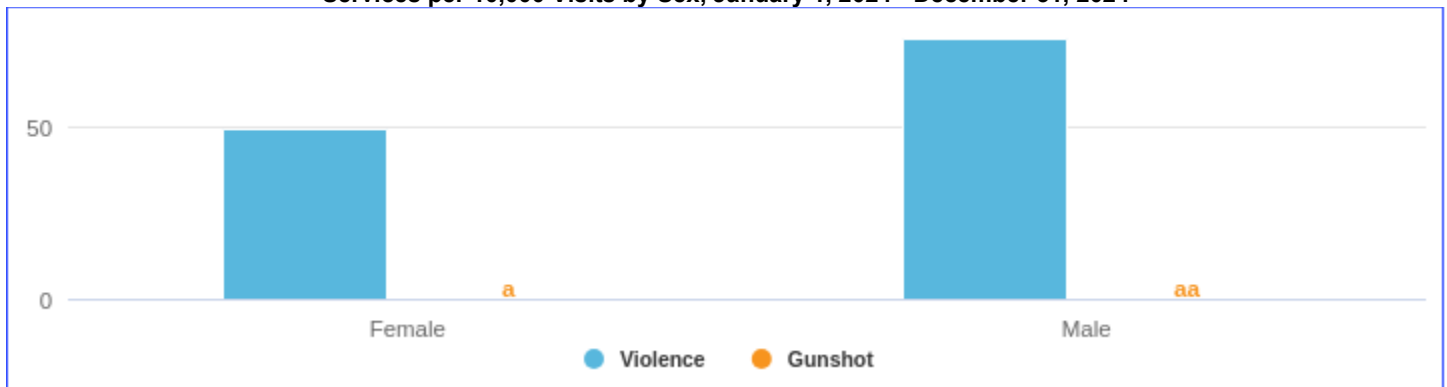

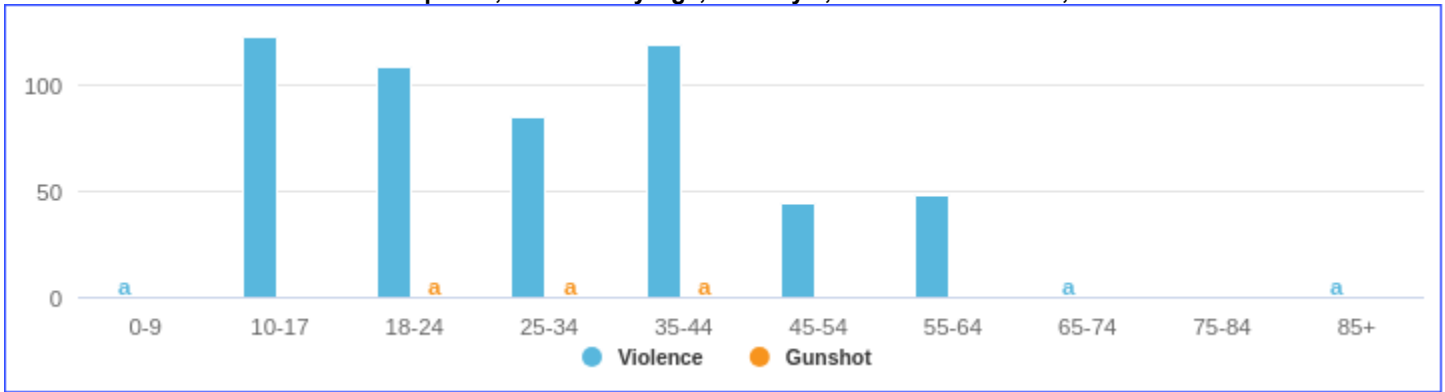

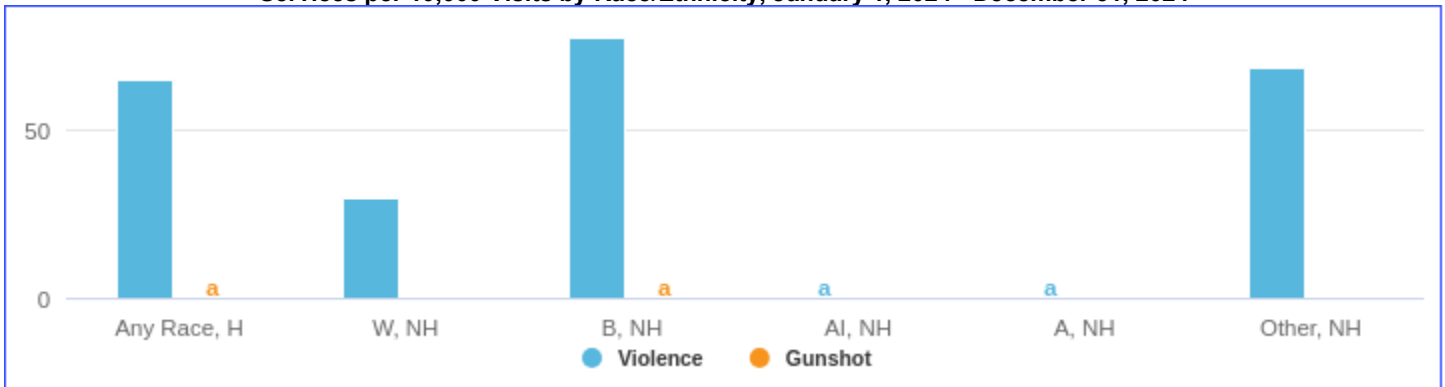

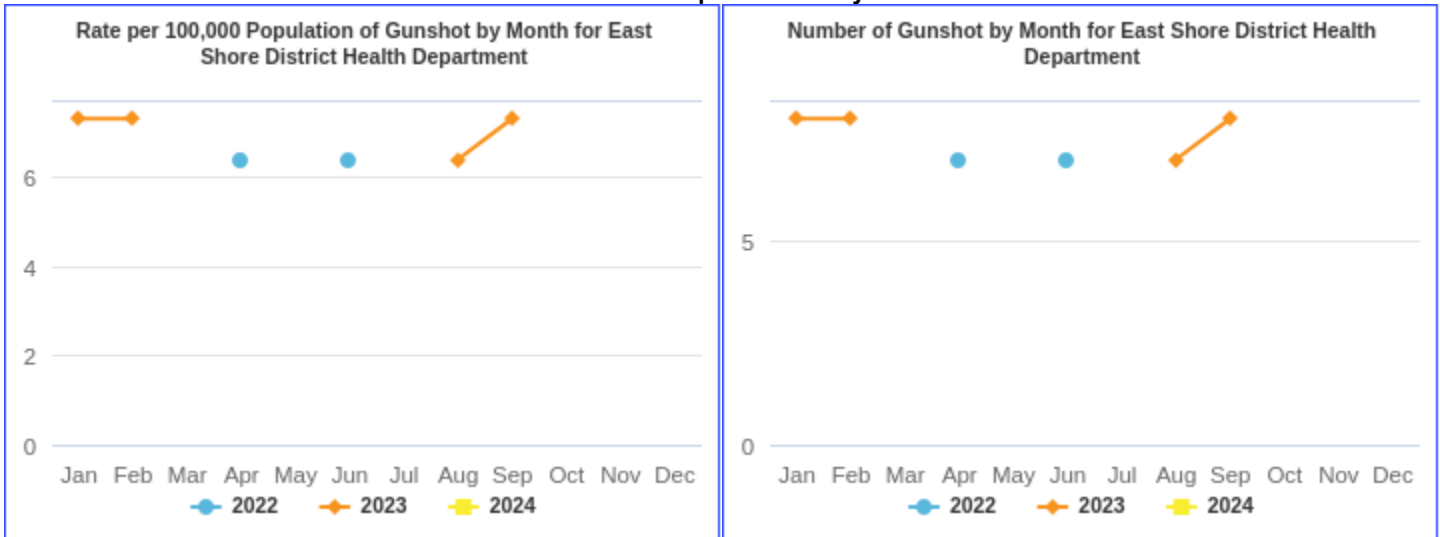

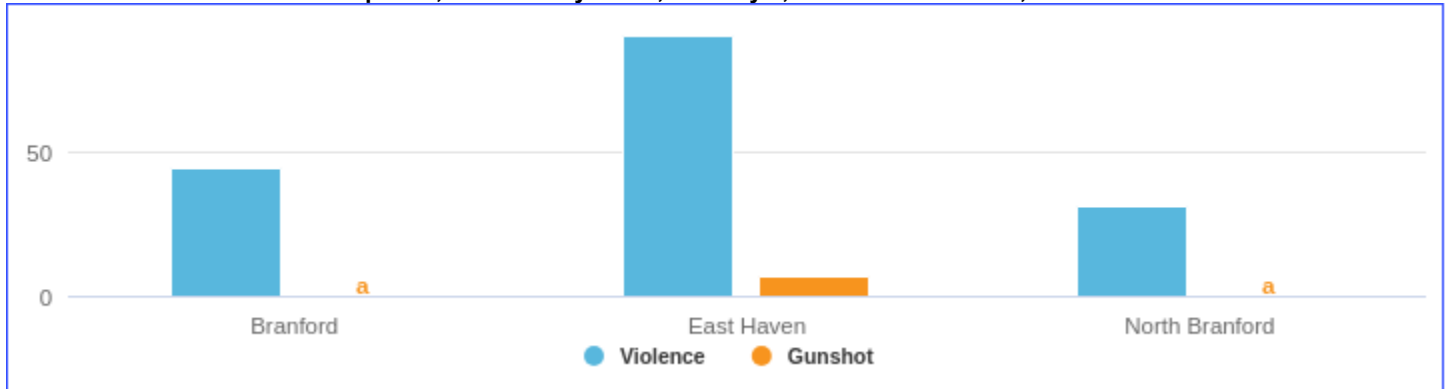

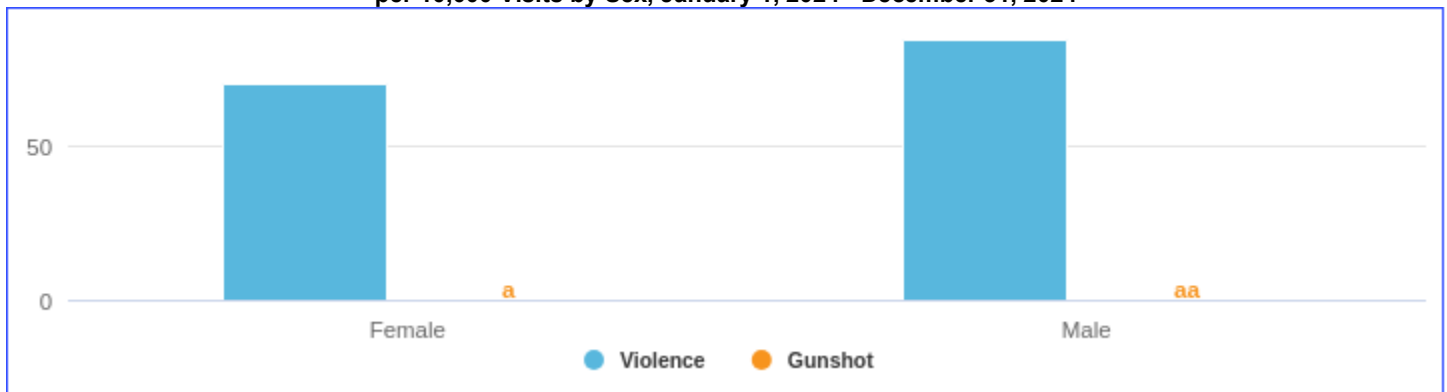

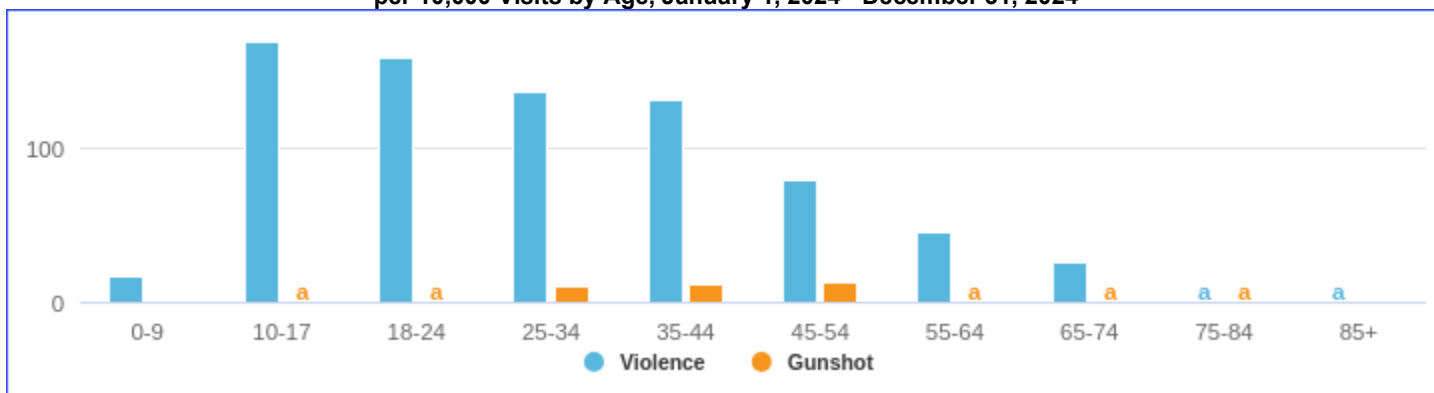

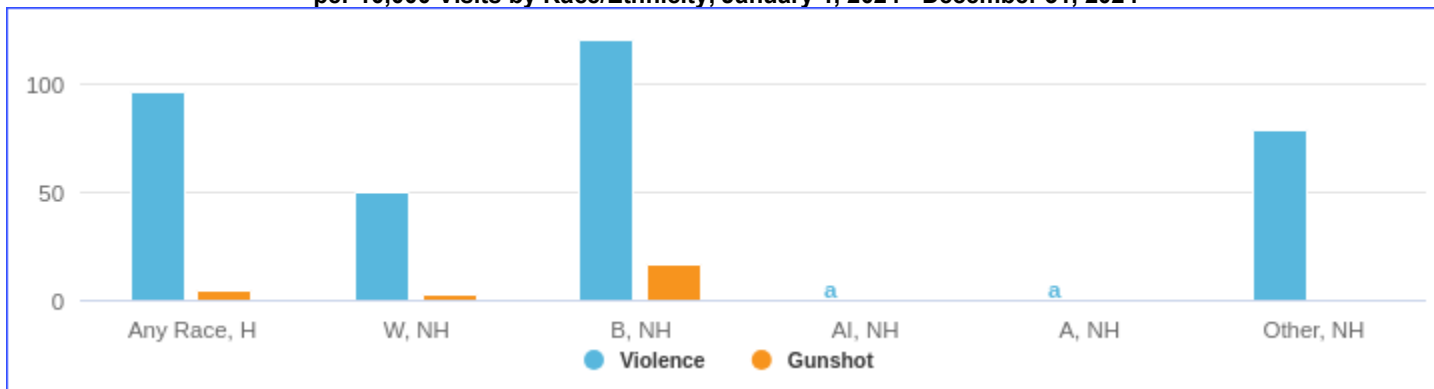

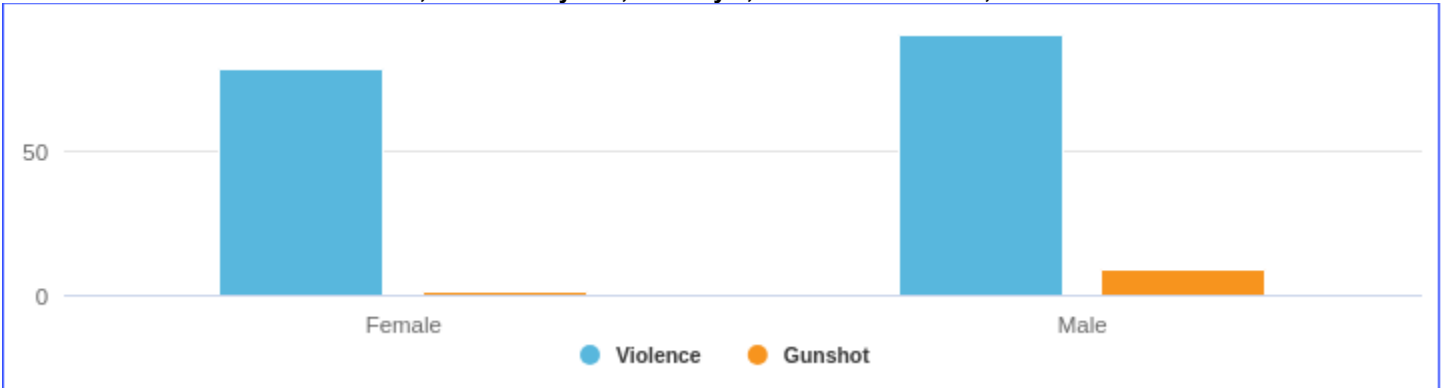

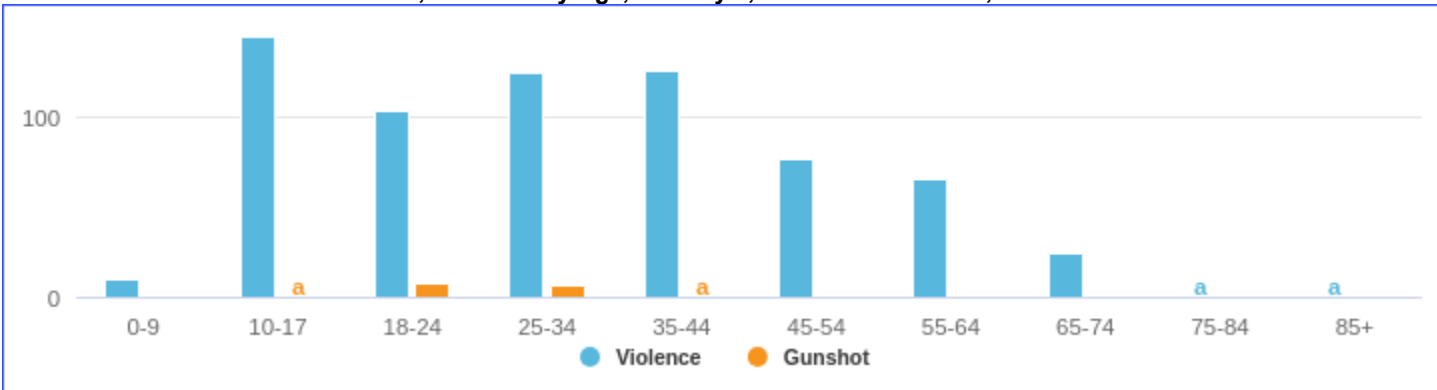

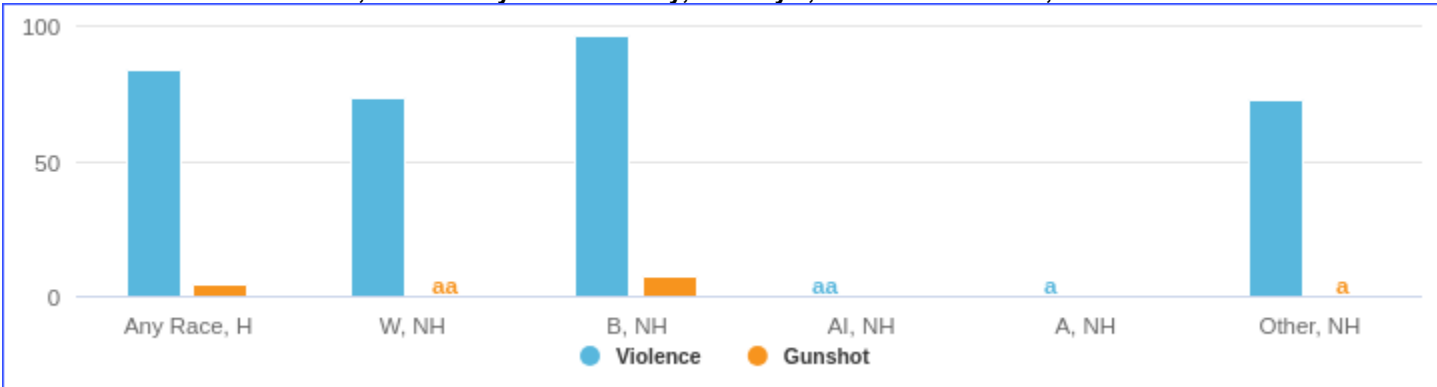

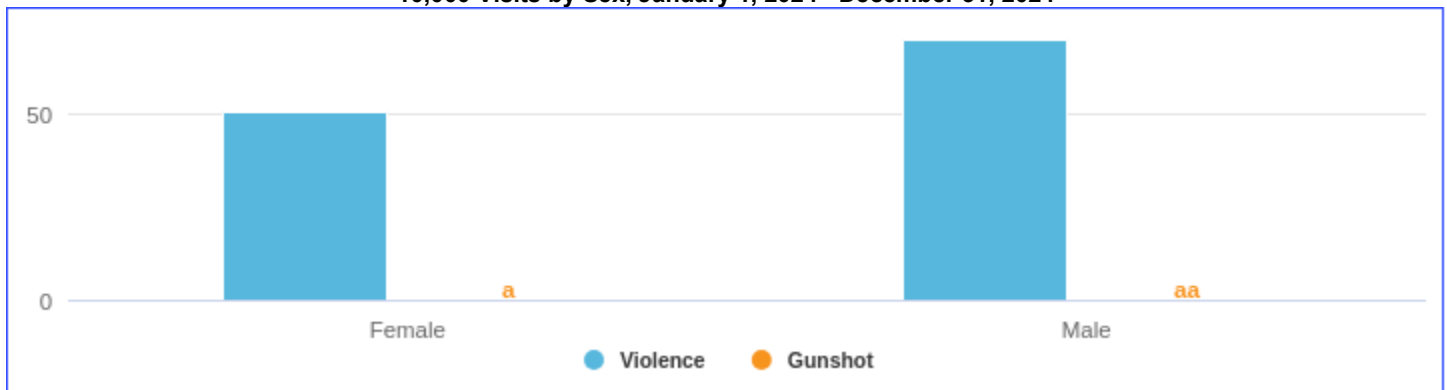

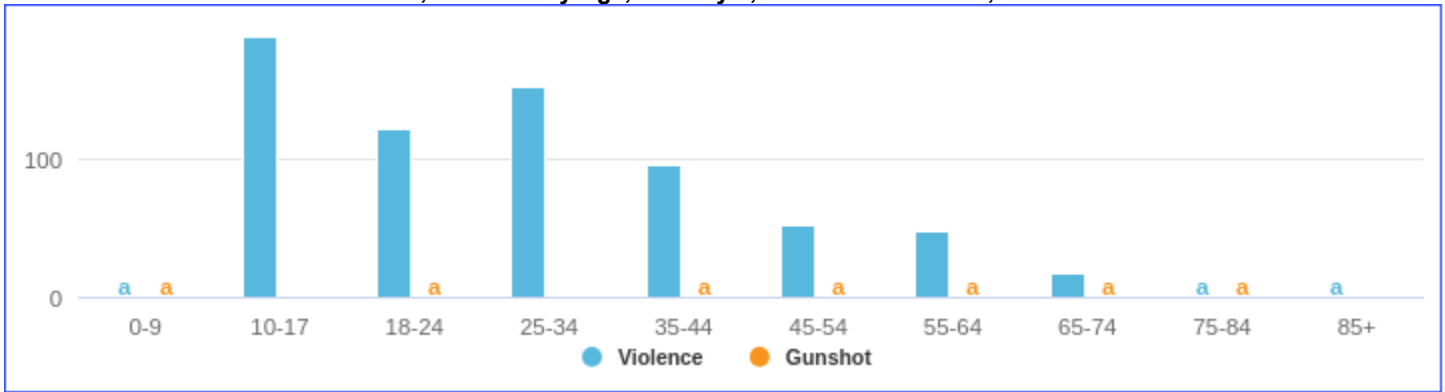

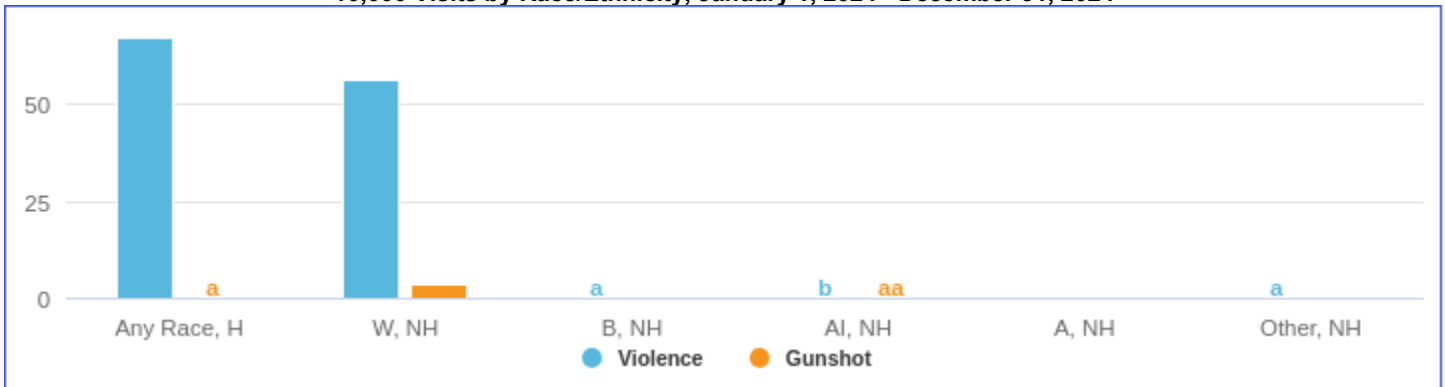

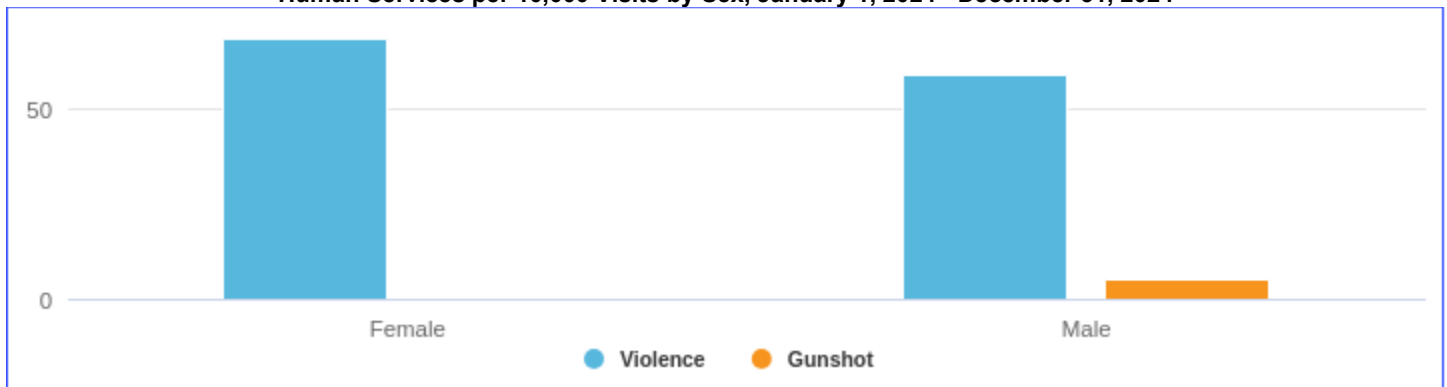

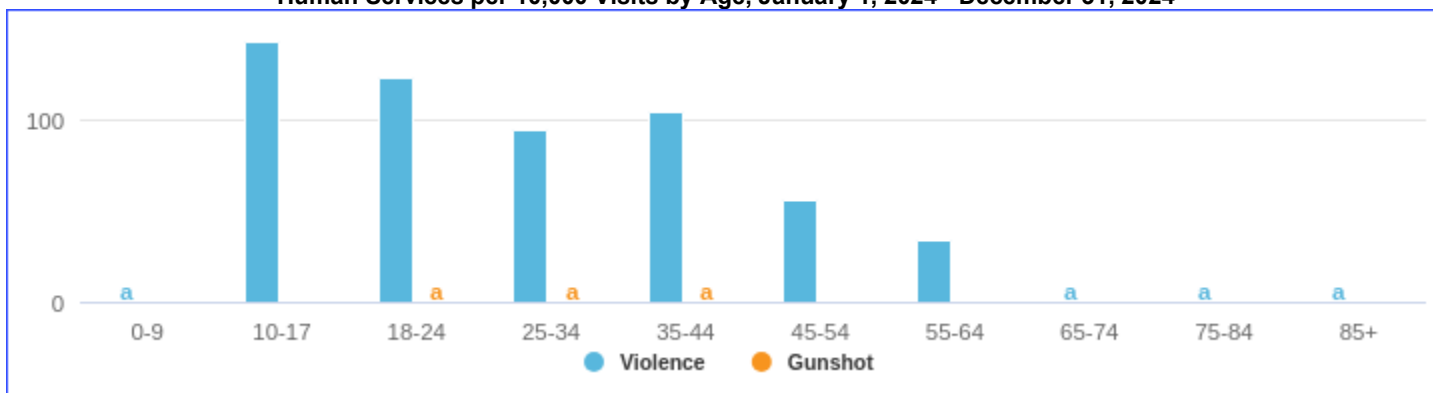

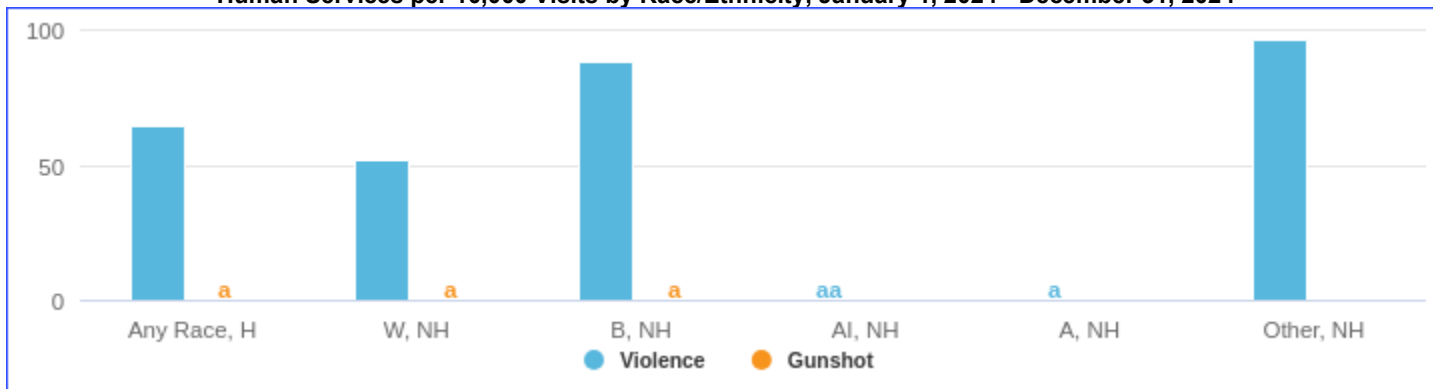

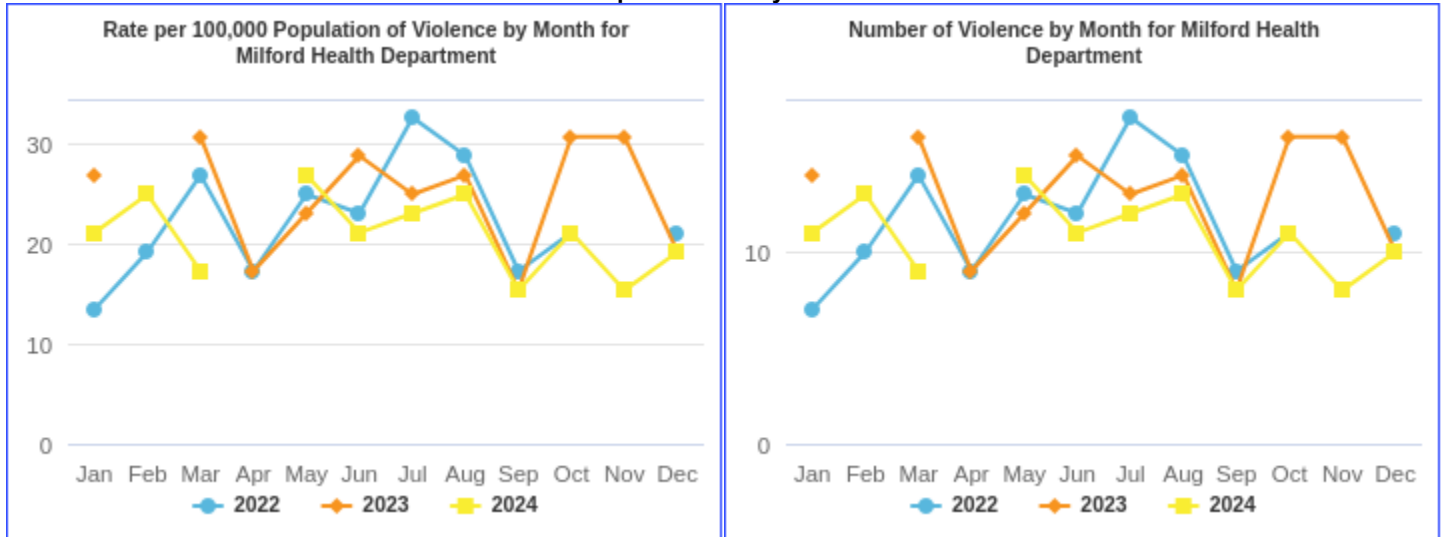

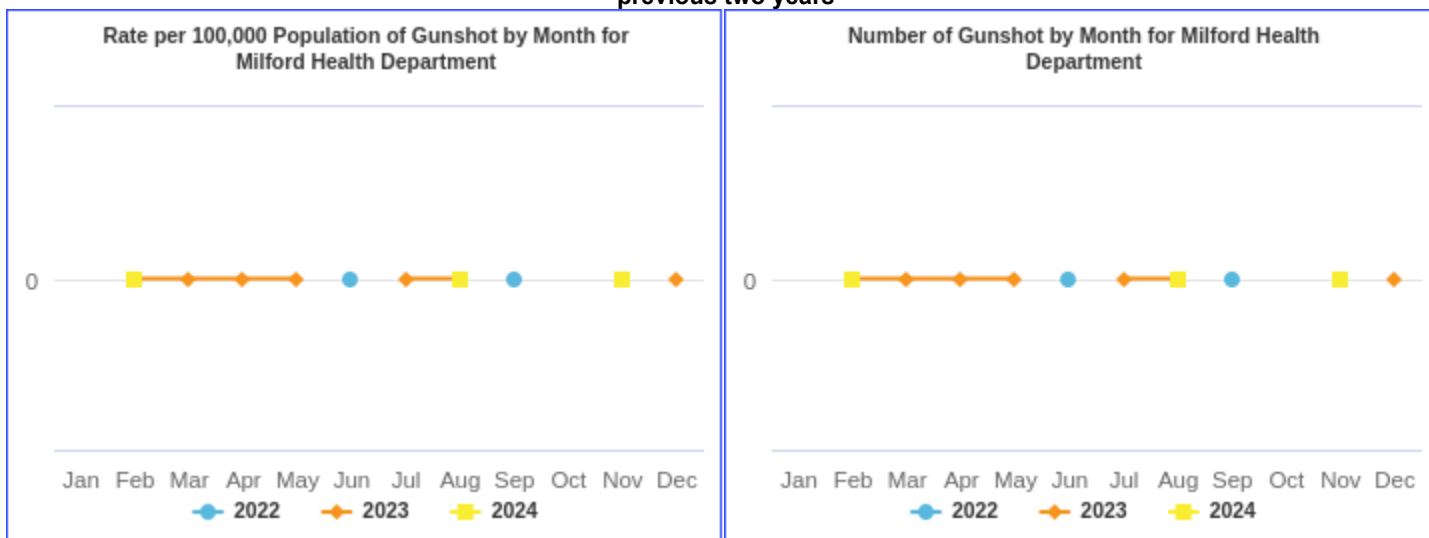

**Gunshot in Milford Health Department, January 1, 2024 - December 31, 2024, compared to the corresponding months of the previous two years**

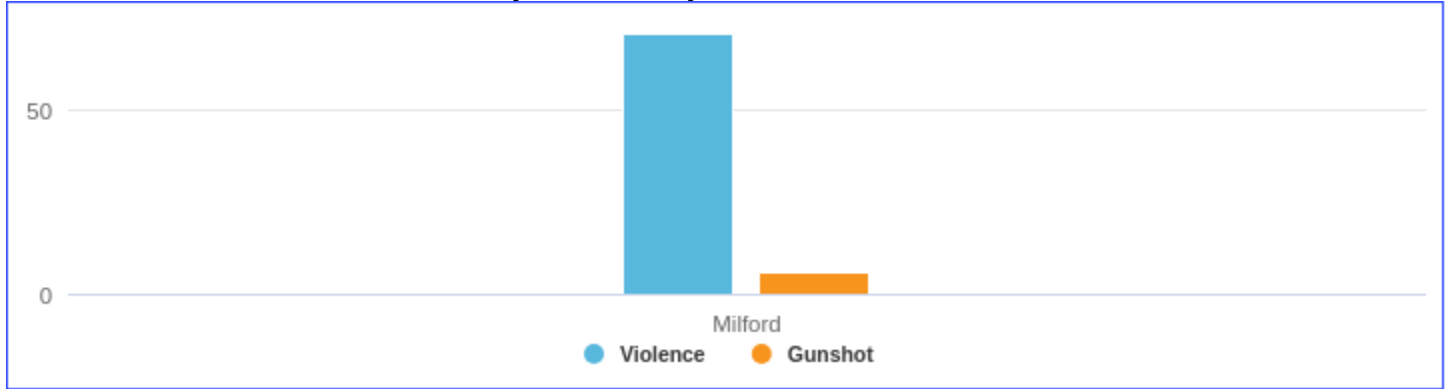

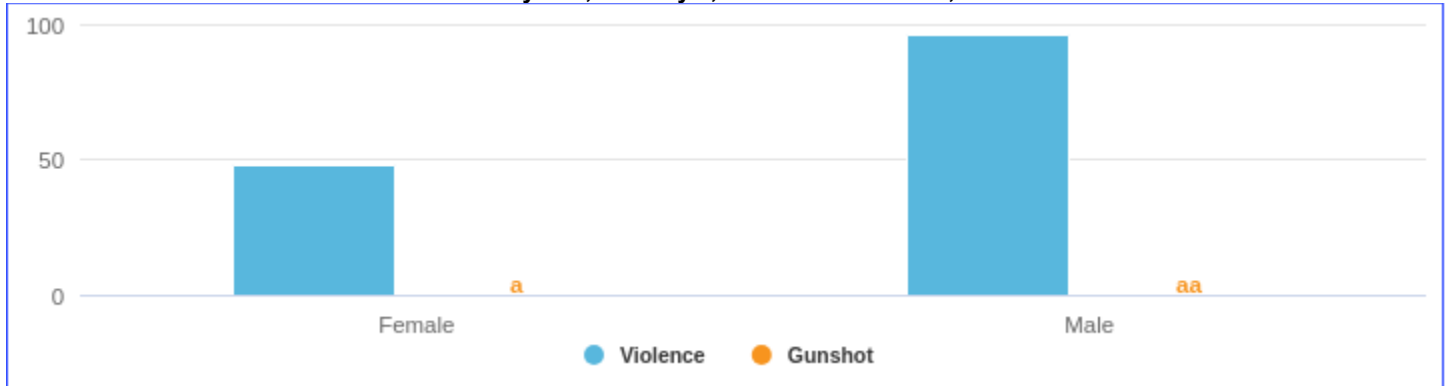

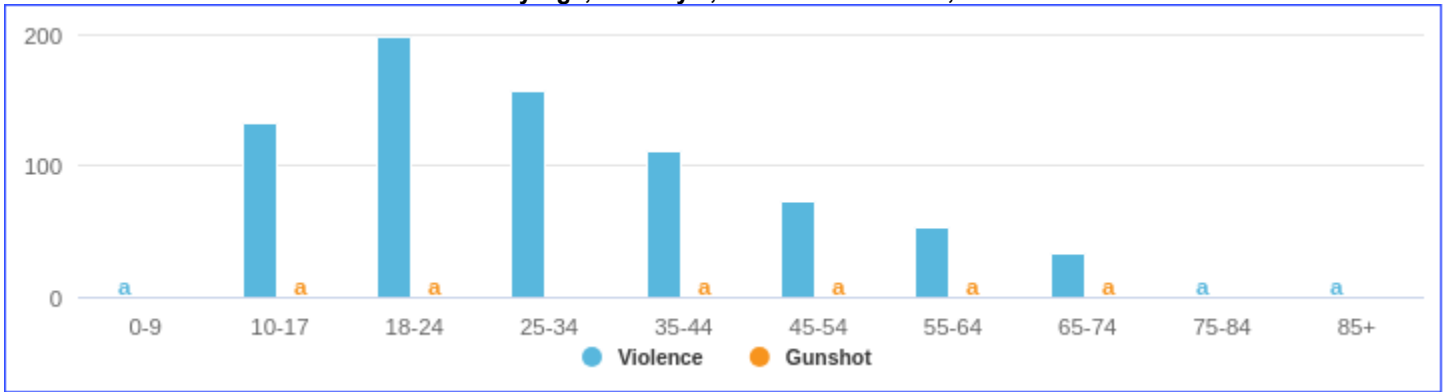

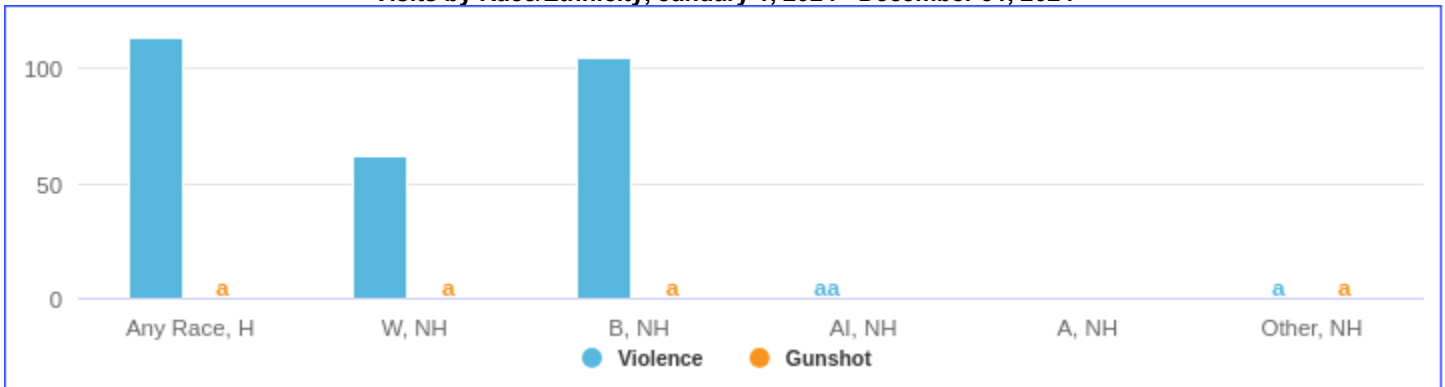

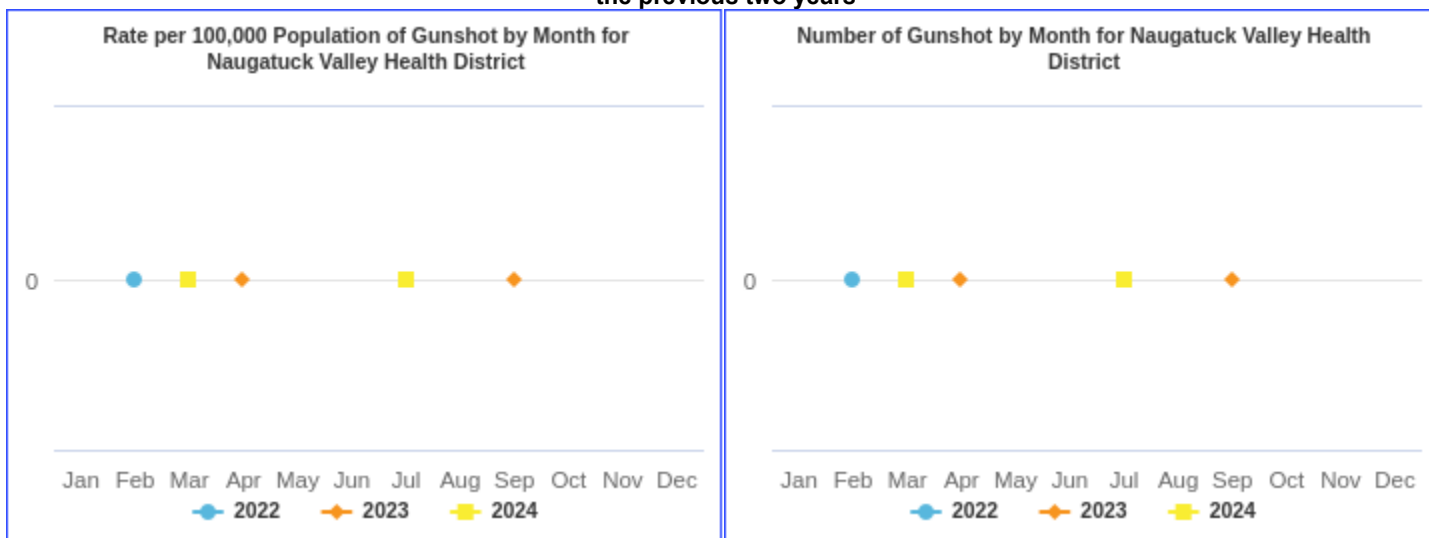

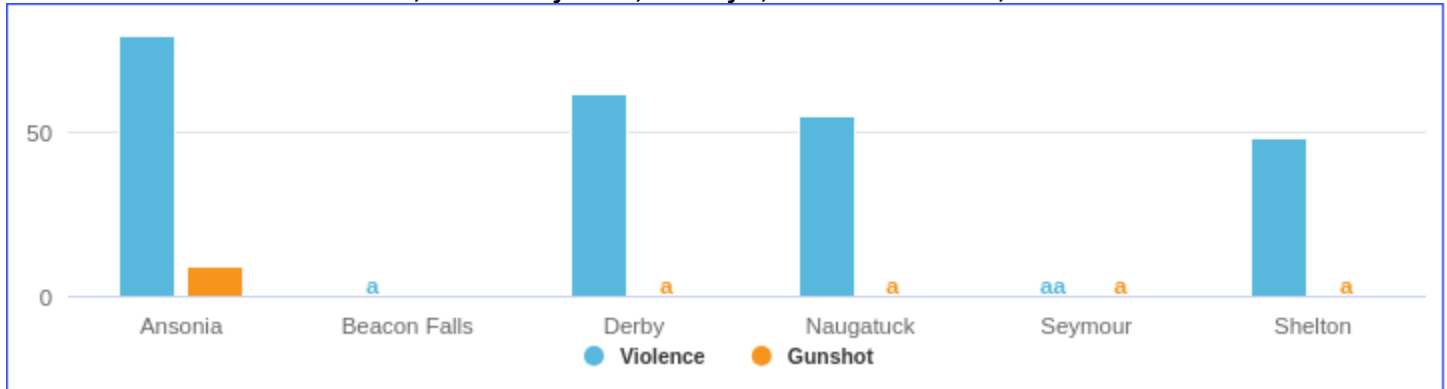

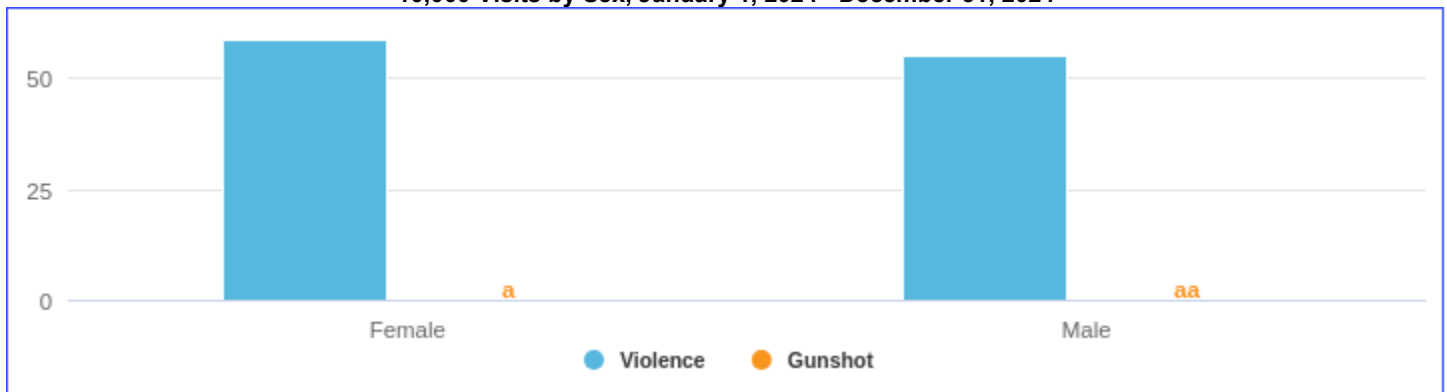

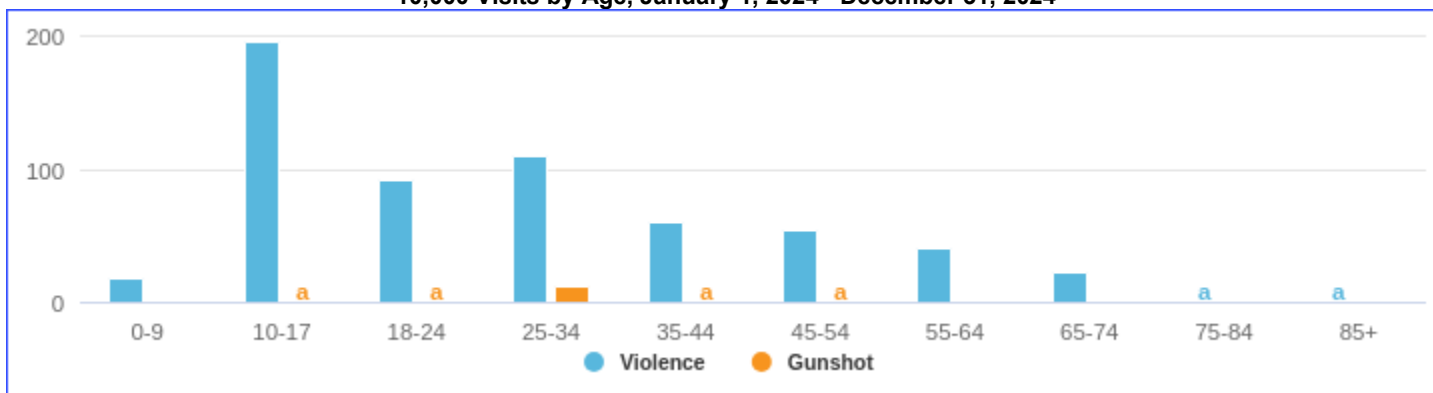

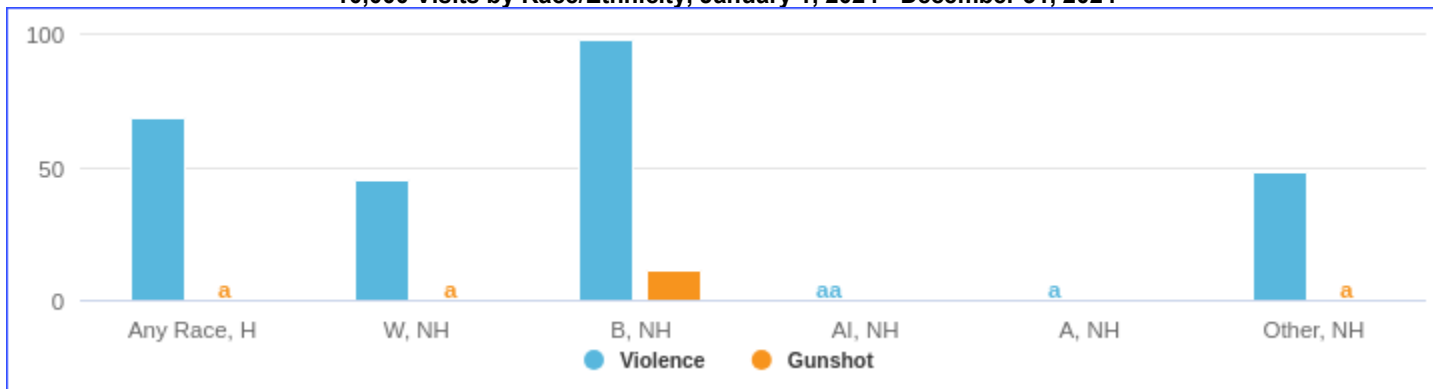

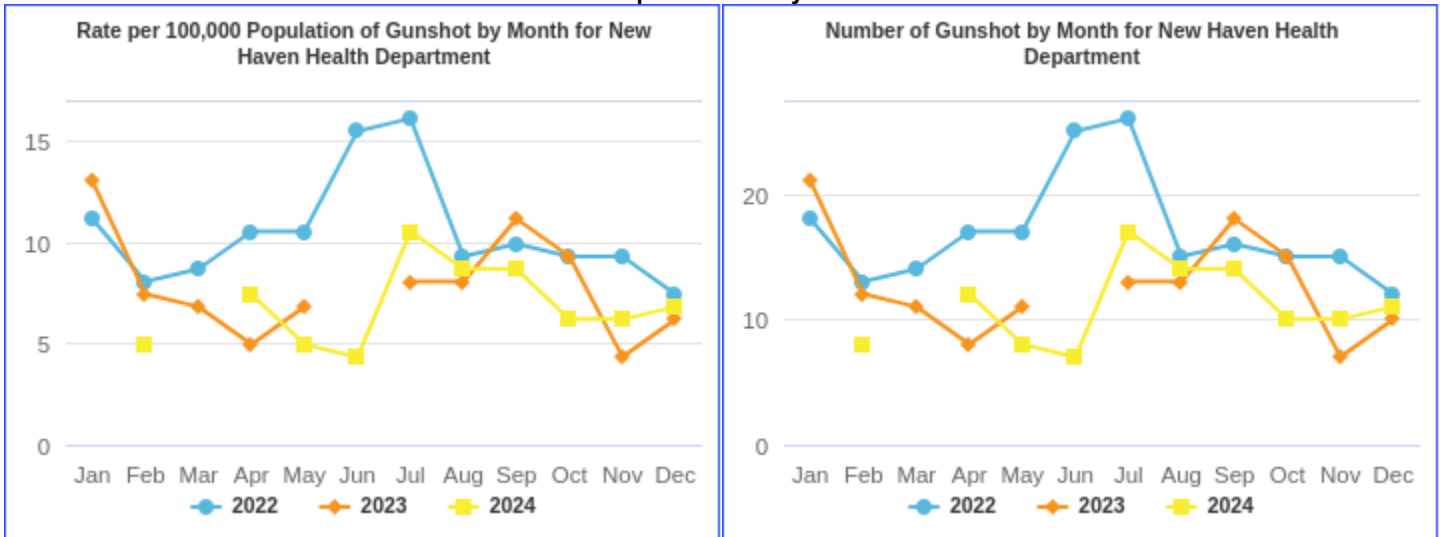

**Gunshot in New Haven Health Department, January 1, 2024 - December 31, 2024, compared to the corresponding months of the previous two years**

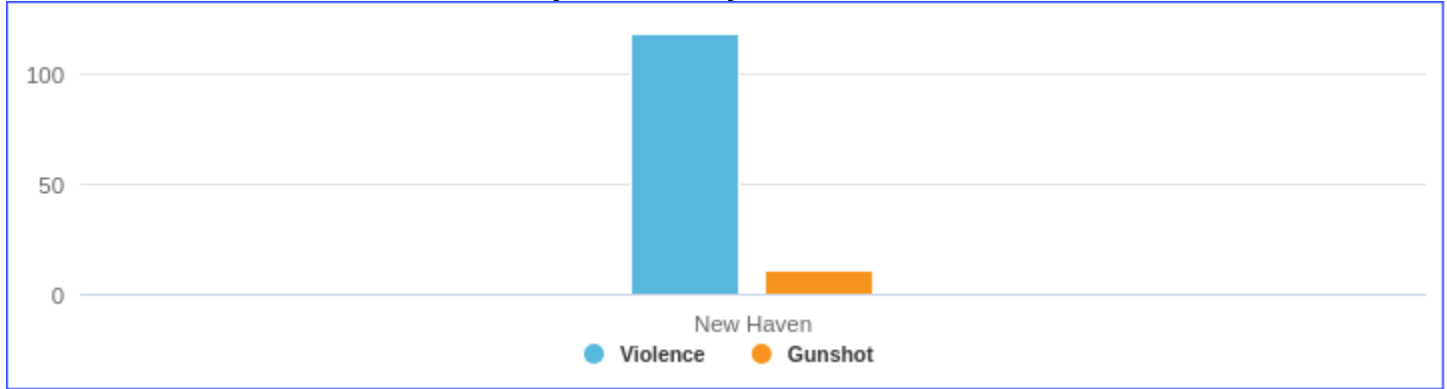

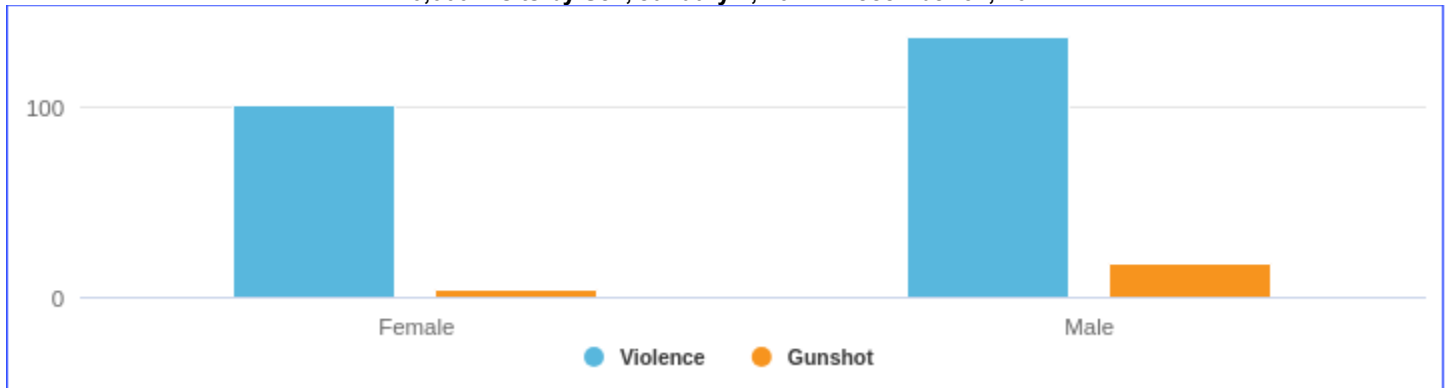

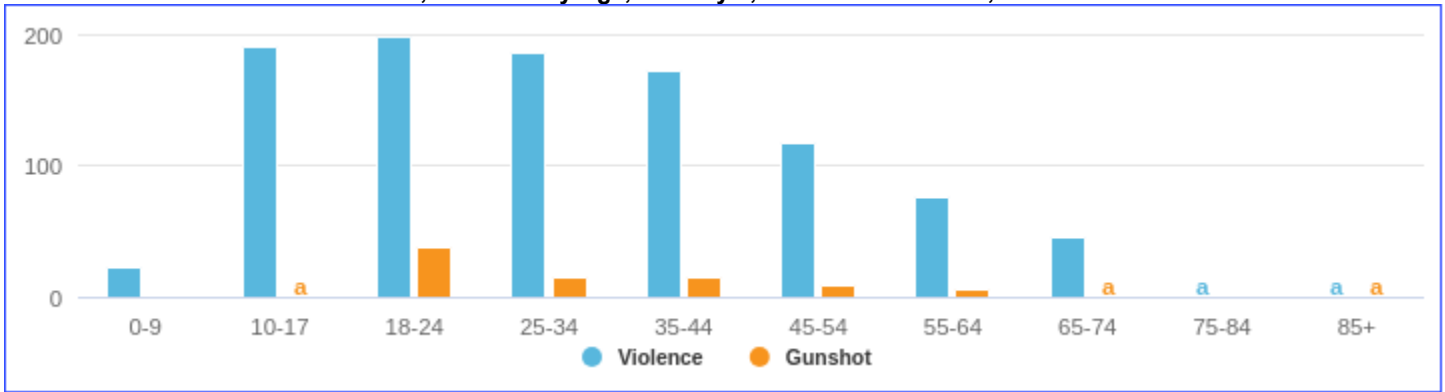

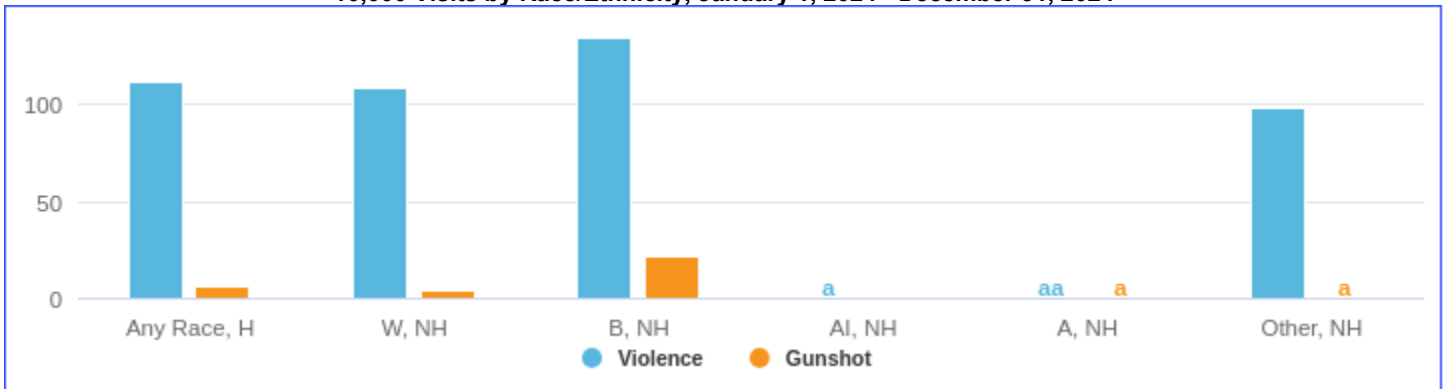

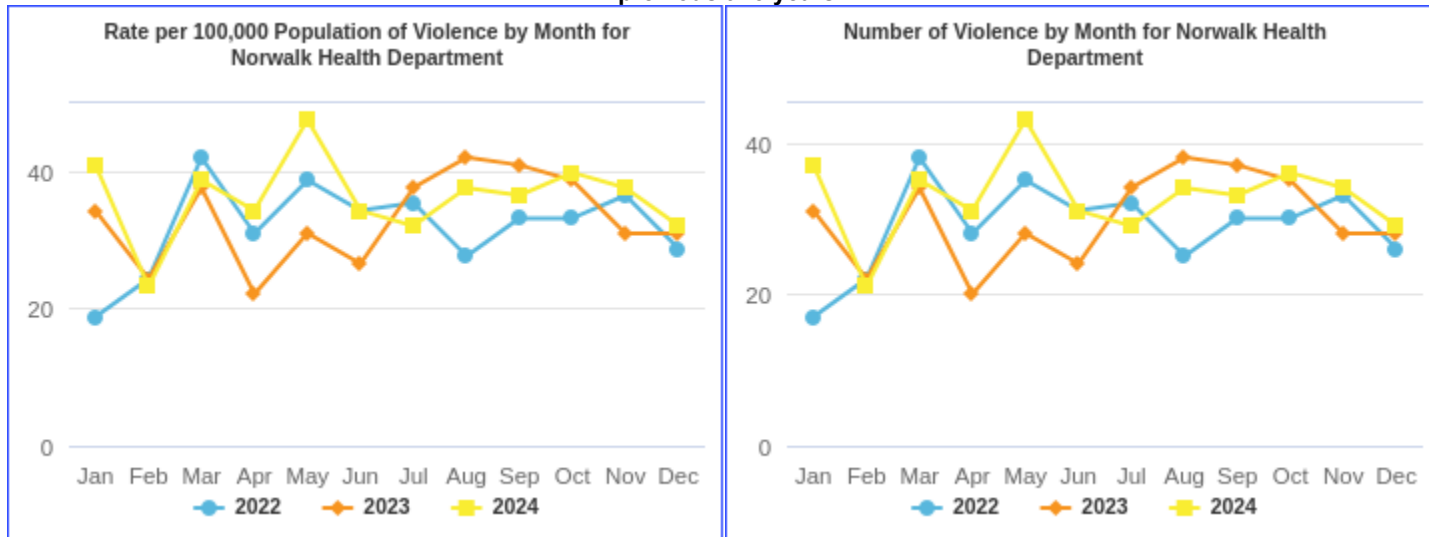

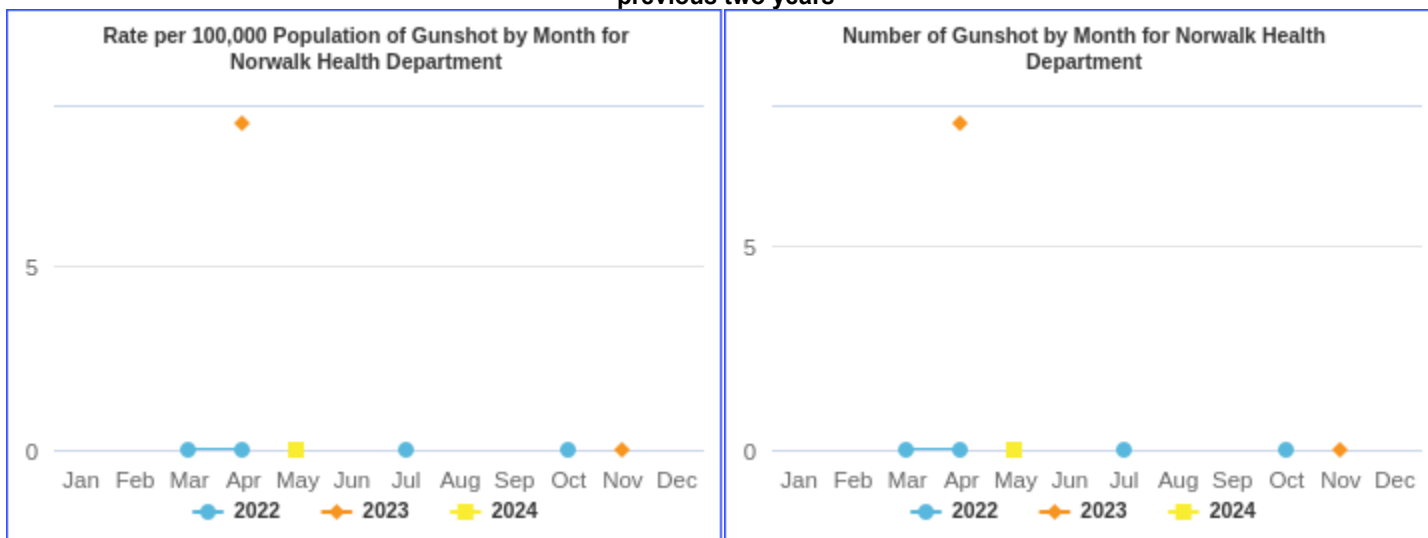

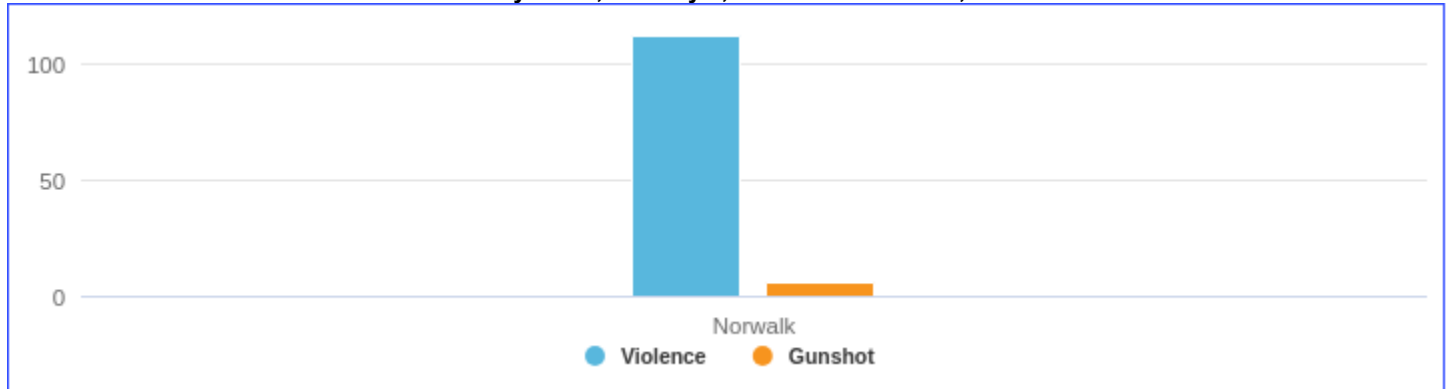

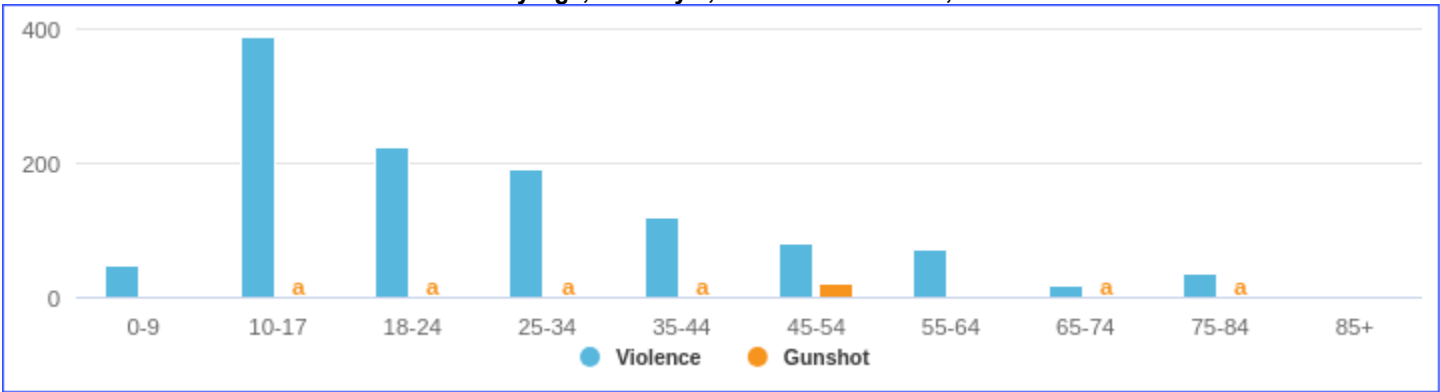

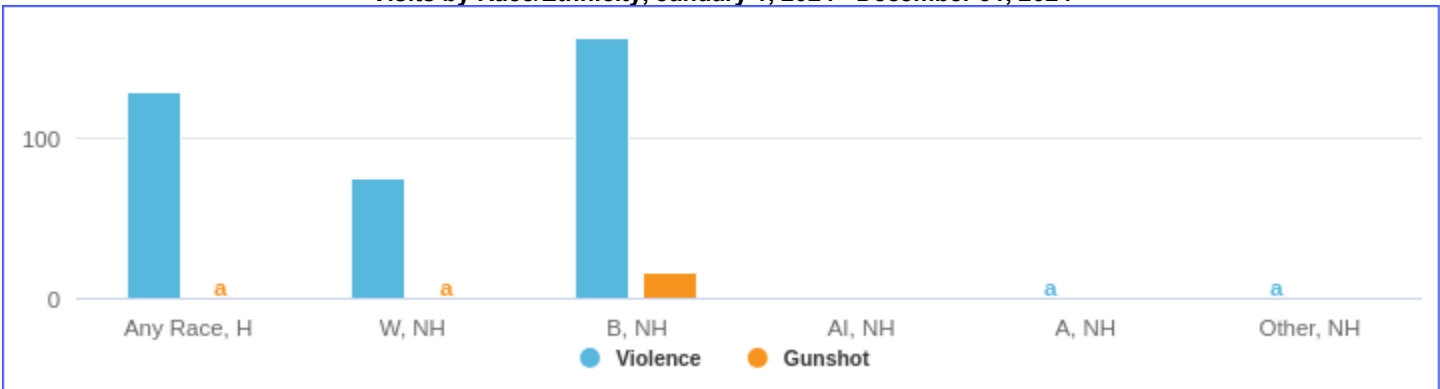

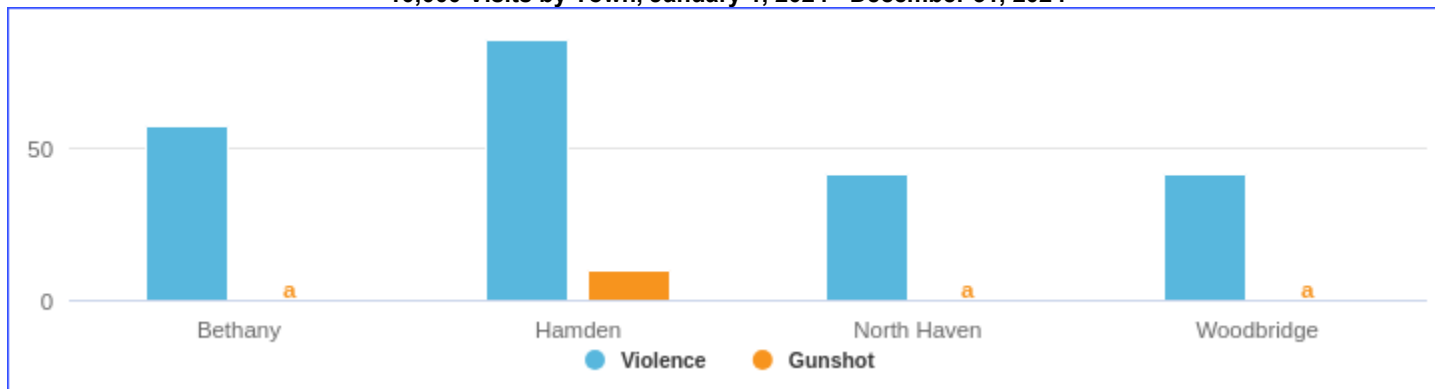

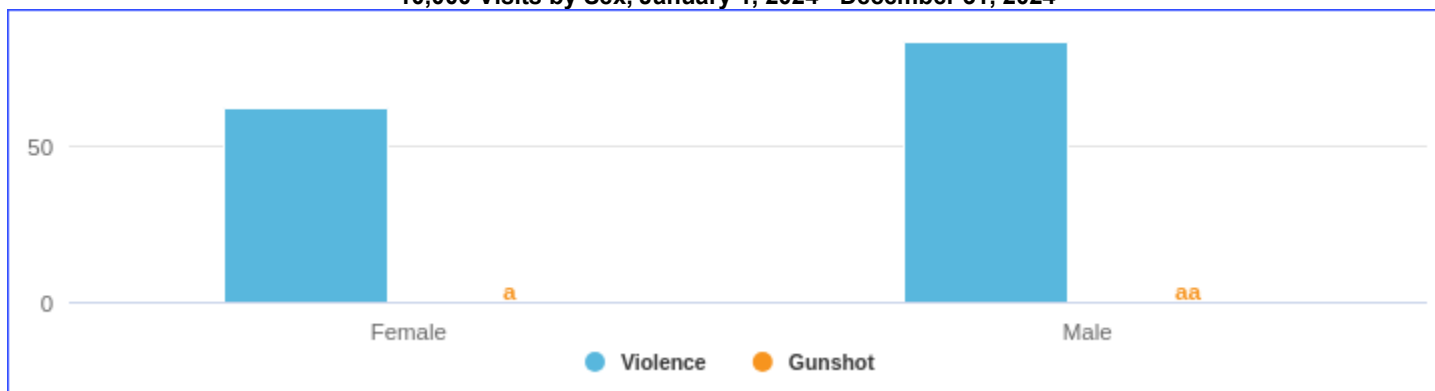

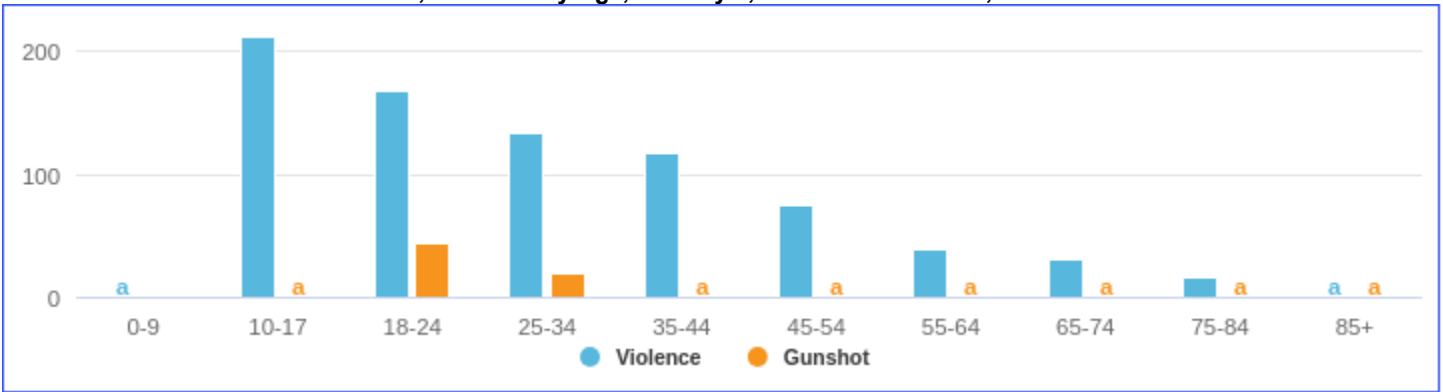

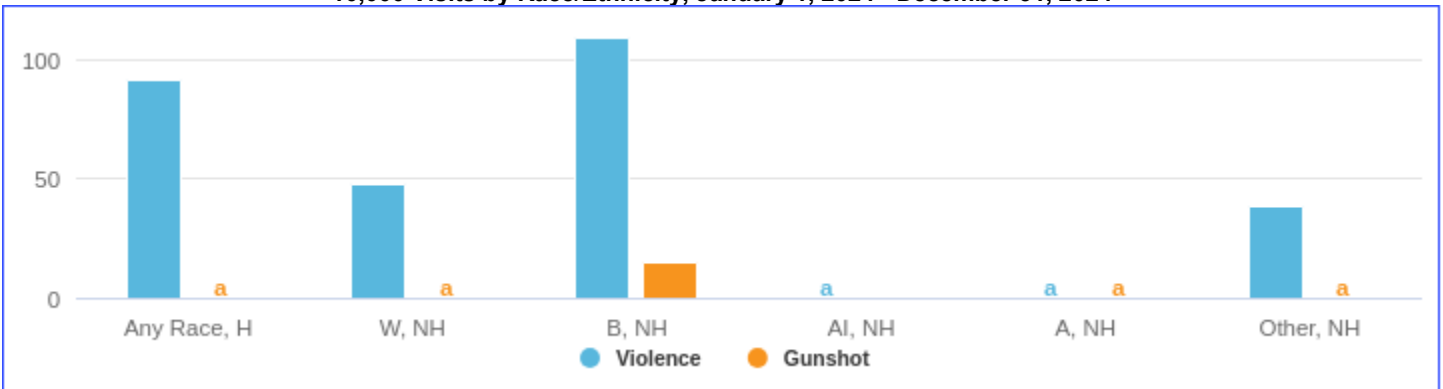

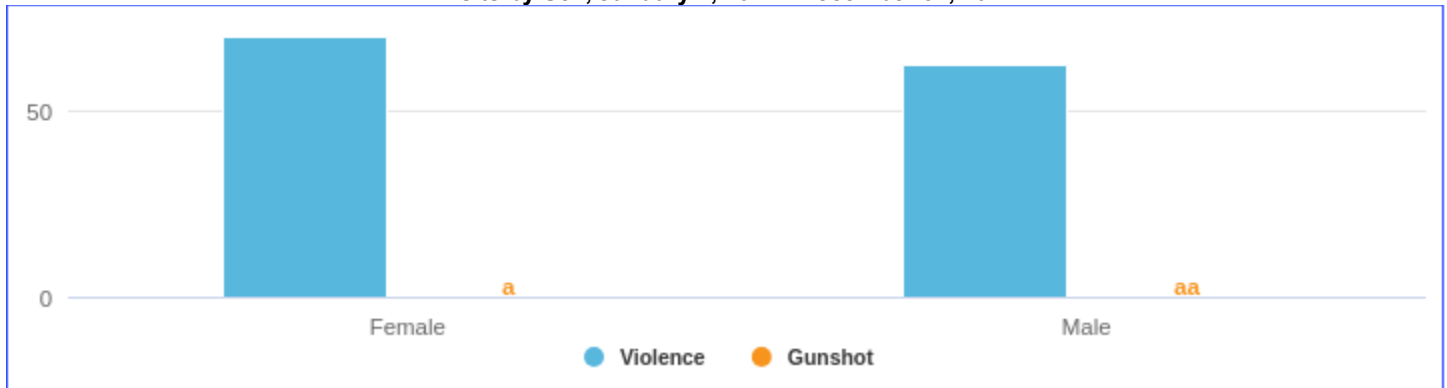

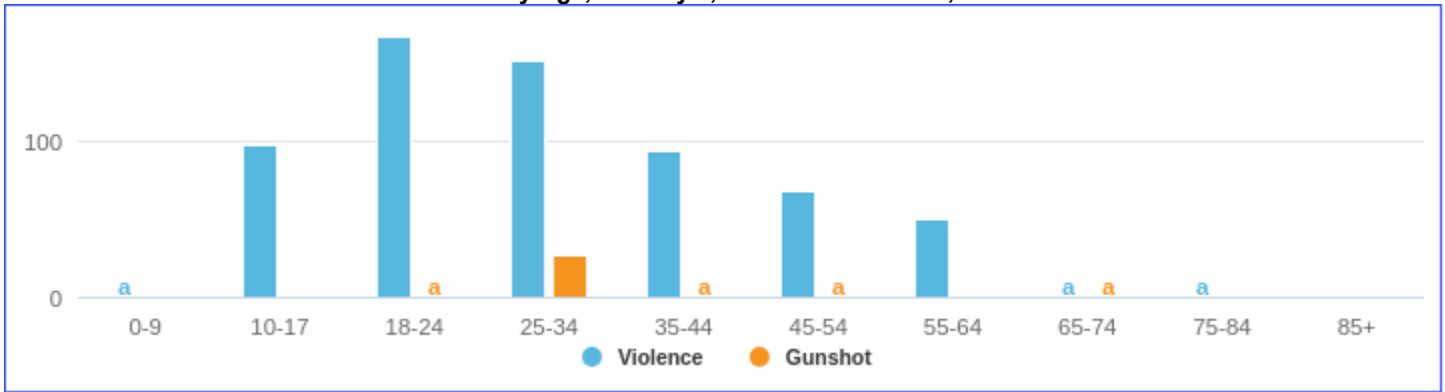

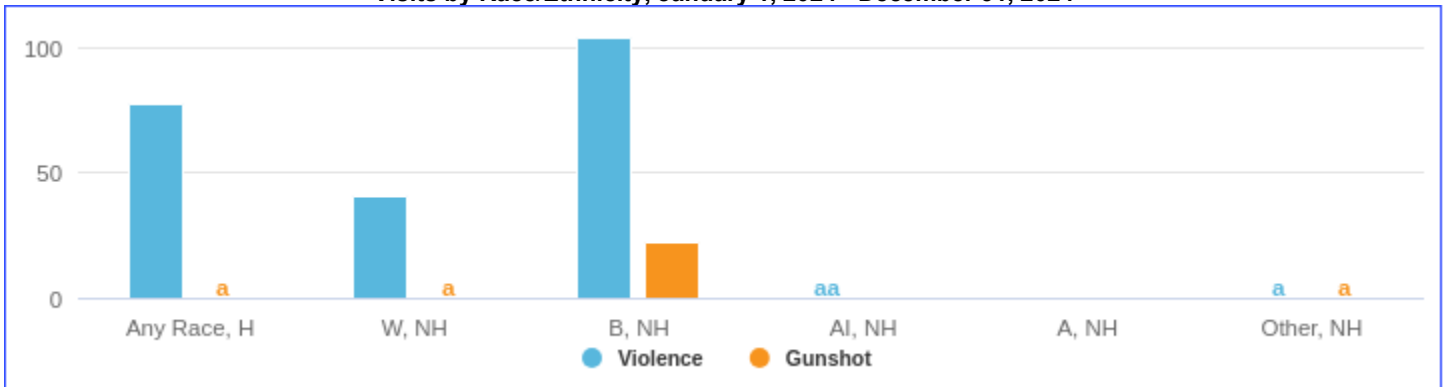

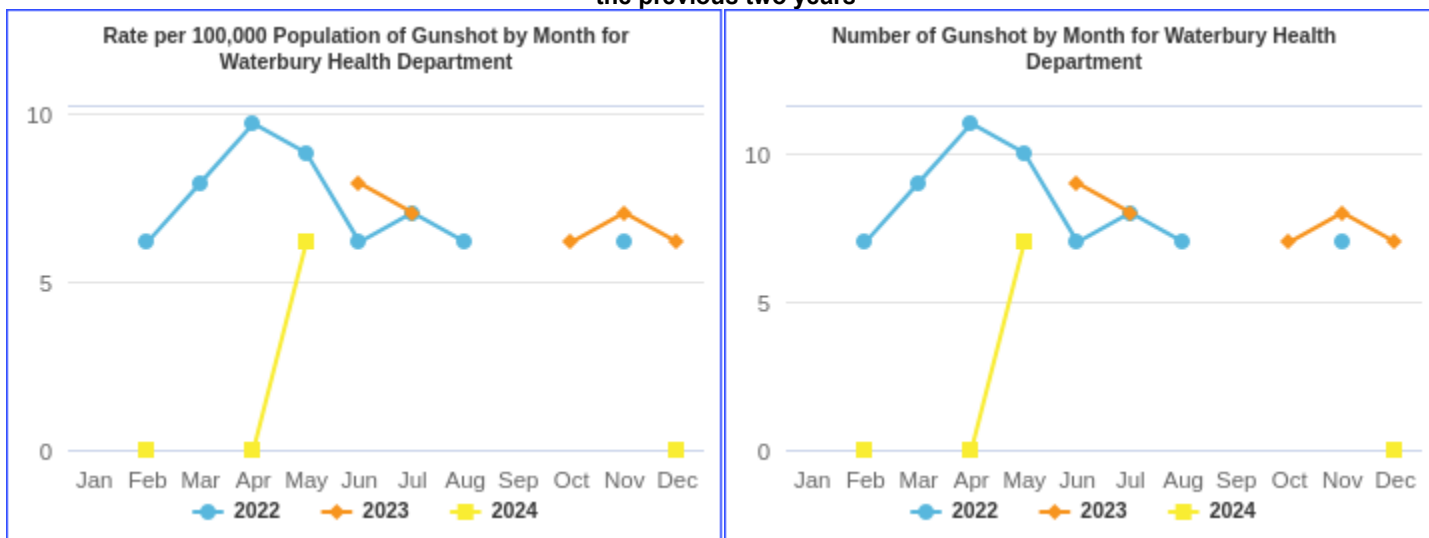

**Gunshot in Waterbury Health Department, January 1, 2024 - December 31, 2024, compared to the corresponding months of the previous two years**

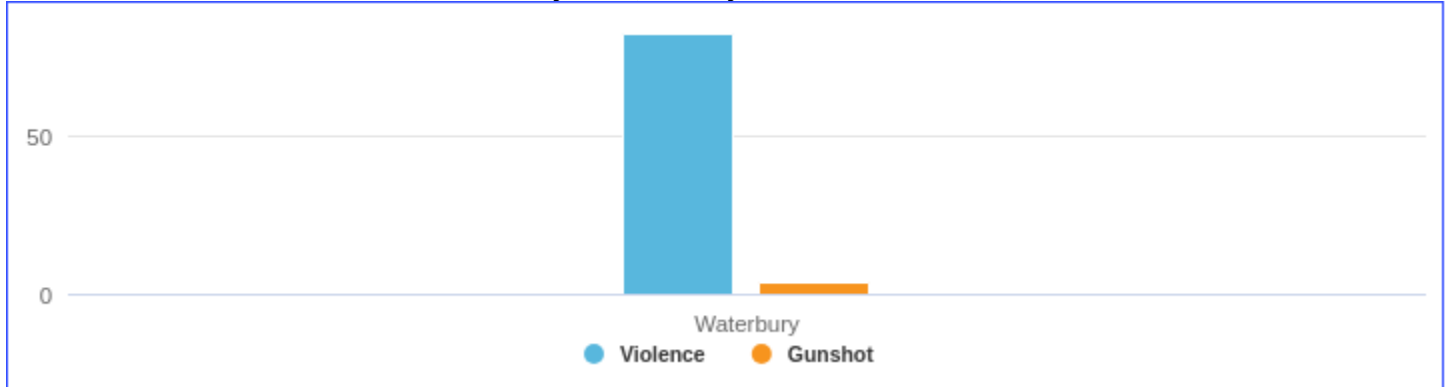

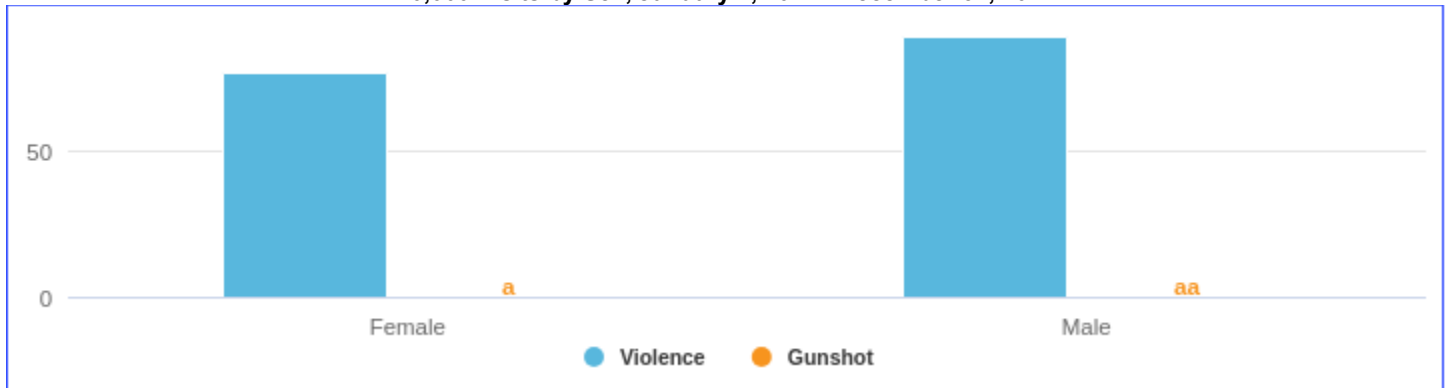

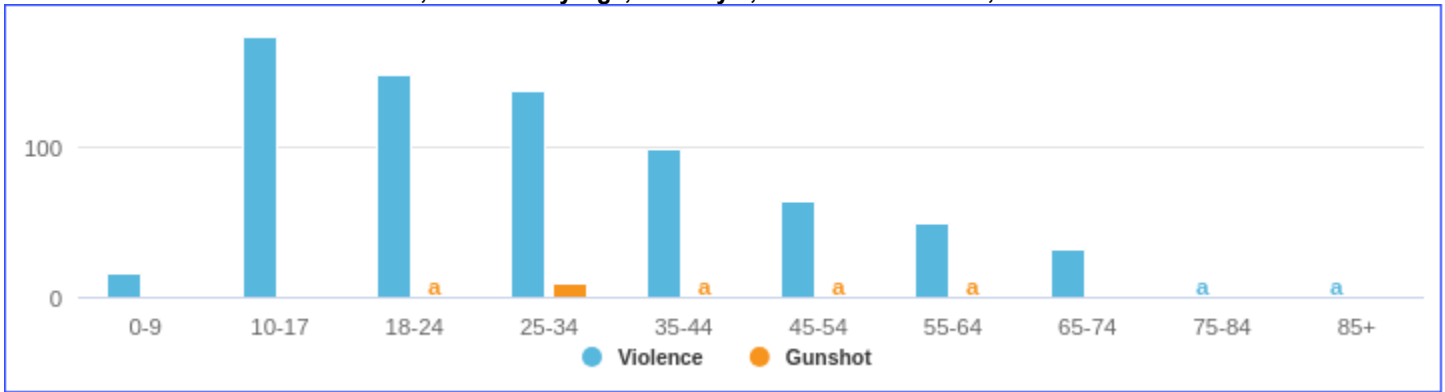

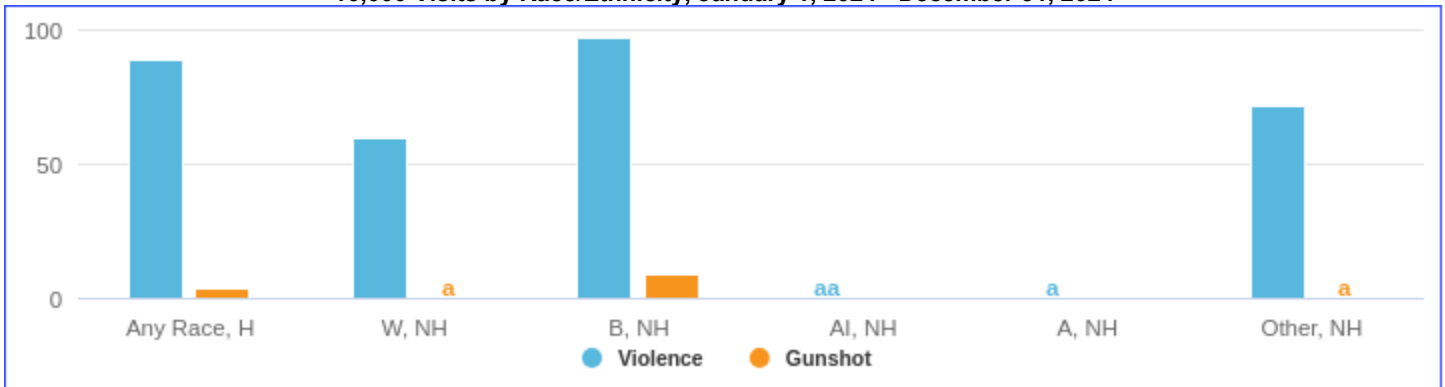

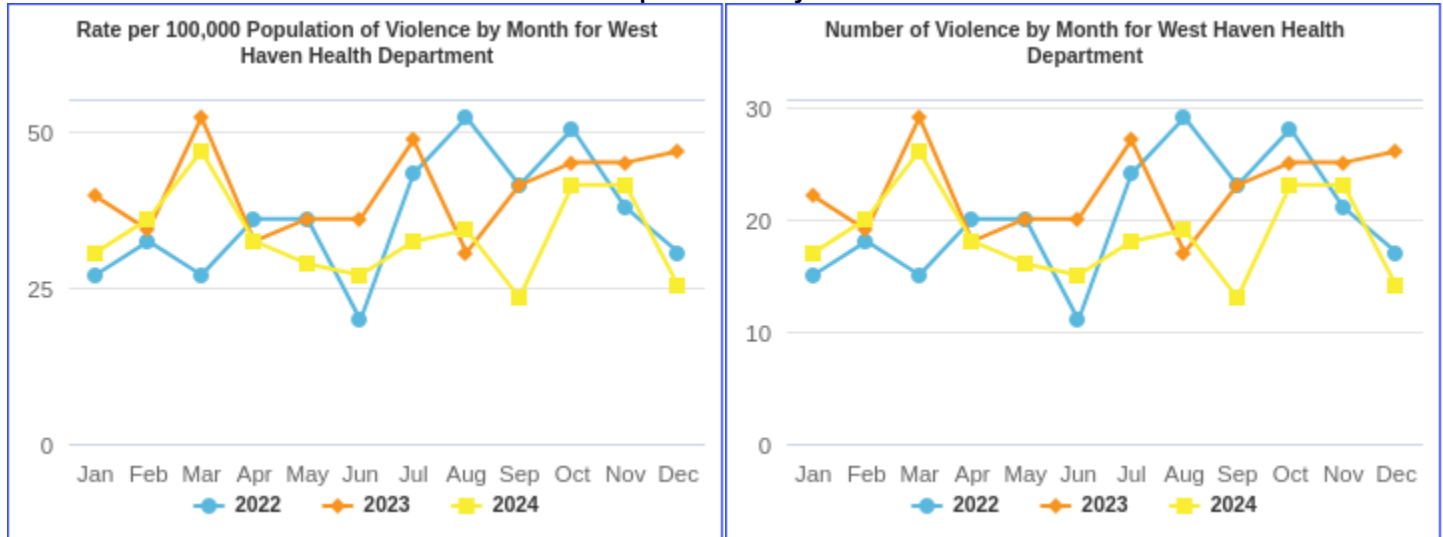

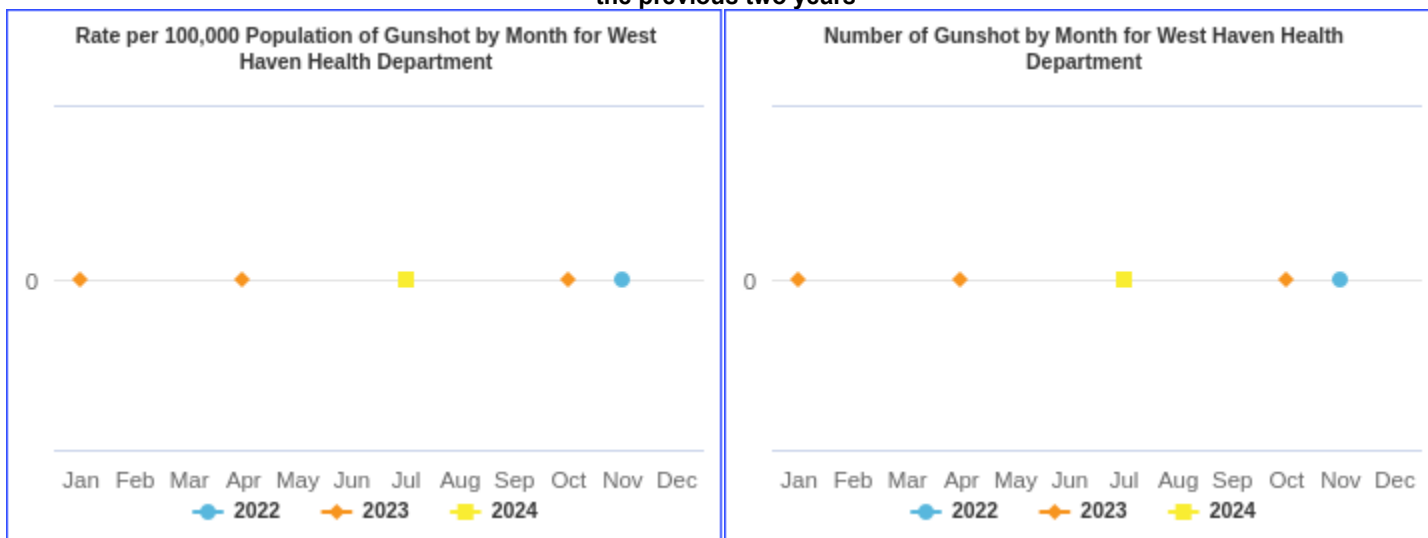

**Gunshot in West Haven Health Department, January 1, 2024 - December 31, 2024, compared to the corresponding months of the previous two years**

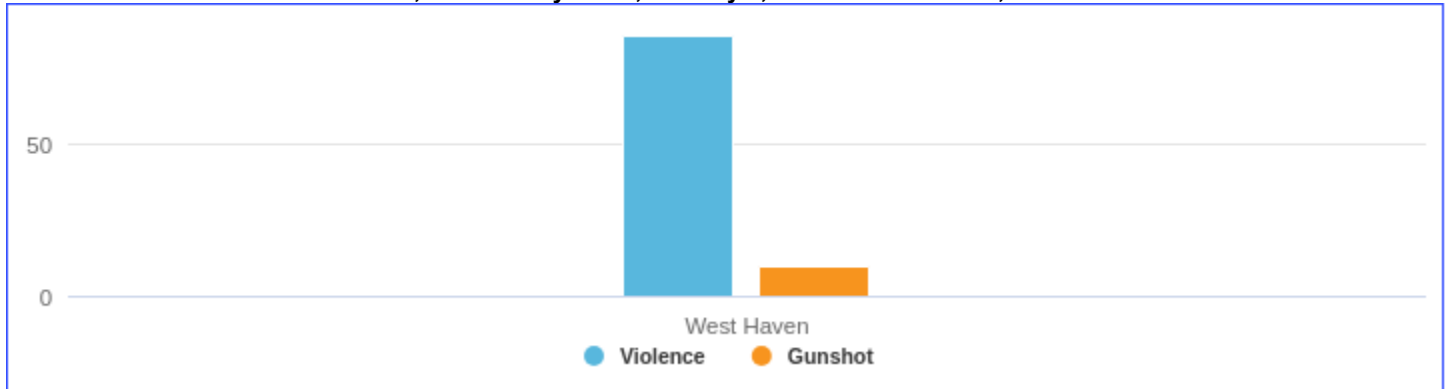

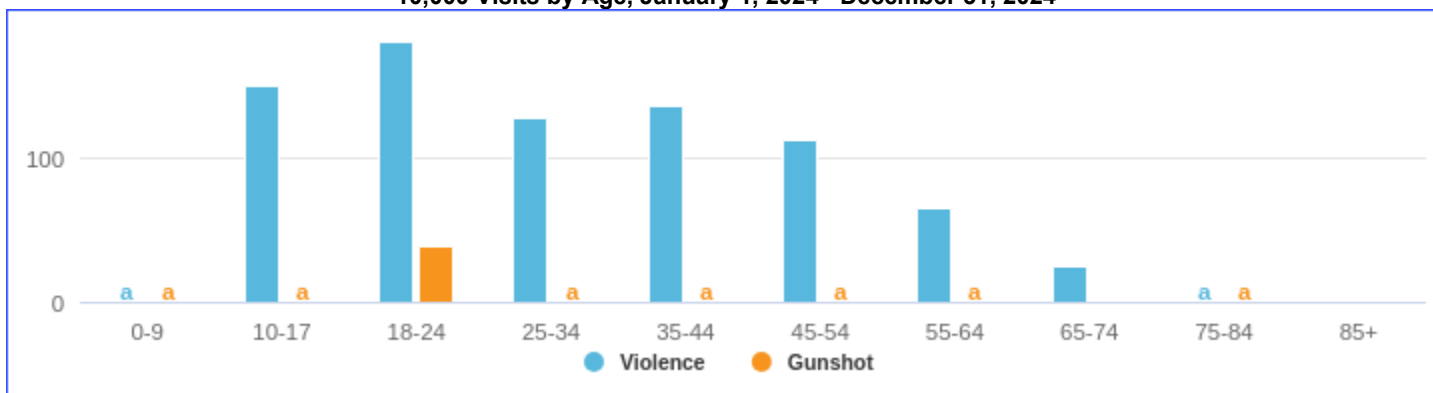

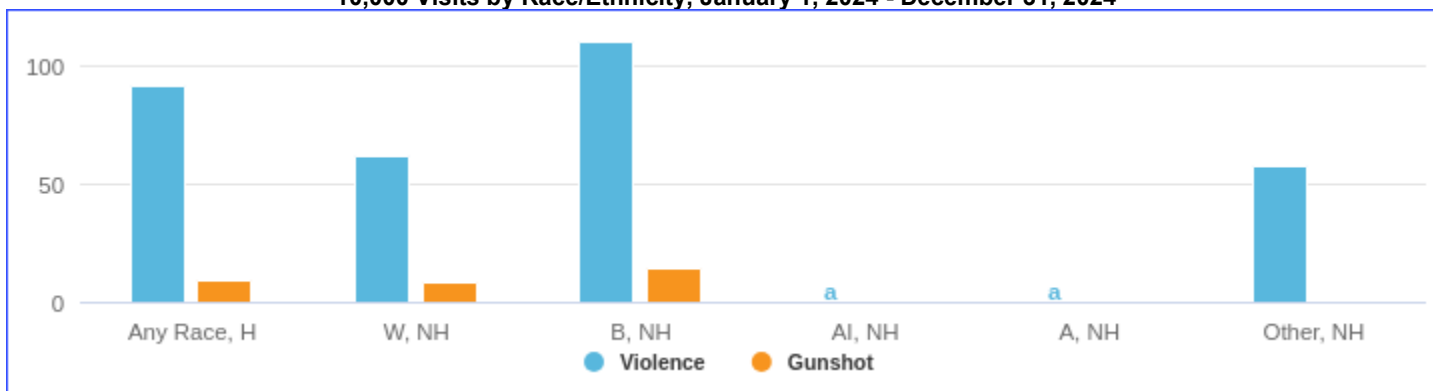
