Nursing staff across most Connecticut school districts provided several insights into the status of health services in Connecticut districts, as indicated by the quantitative survey results and qualitative comments' breadth. The CSDE and EdAdvance staff examined data resulting from the seventeenth year of survey administration. That examination resulted in the following conclusions regarding school health services in Connecticut:

- Reponses across all categories were significantly lower when compared to previous years. This was the result of the virtual and hybrid learning models used across the state for much of the 2020-2021 school year.
- The effects of the Covid pandemic made data reporting in 2020-2021 difficult. While there was a slight increase in the number of schools that completed the survey, any comparison to previous year's data should be made with this fact in mind.
- There were 1,526 diagnosed concussions in 2020-2021. This number was significantly lower than the previous year (3,975).

Girls and boys soccer accounted for the largest number of diagnosed concussions occurring in interscholastic sports
